

#### **Driver Training**

To safely operate a commercial motor vehicle a driver must possess core knowledge and skills, often referred to as competencies.

To ensure proper training and competency from drivers.

#### Periodic - All Driver Training (Safety Meetings)

Policies, procedures, and regulations changes throughout the year. Drivers can develop bad habits, which lead to unsafe driving or inadequate compliance with regulations. Drivers need periodic training throughout the year to ensure their knowledge and skills remain adequate. 
