Accident includes continuous or repeated exposure to conditions or which results in bodily injury, property damage, or environmental damage which the insured neither expected nor intended.

Motor Vehicle means a land vehicle, machine, truck, tractor, trailer, or semitrailer propelled or drawn by mechanical power and used on a highway for transporting property, or any combination thereof.

Bodily Injury means injury to the body, sickness, or disease to any person, including death resulting from any of these.

Property Damage means damage to or loss of use of tangible property.

The insurance policy to which this endorsement is attached provides automobile liability insurance and is amended to assure compliance by the insured, within the limits stated herein, as a motor carrier of property, with Sections 29 and 30 of the Motor Carrier Act of 1980 and the rules and regulations of the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration (FMCSA).

I. Emergency Action

In the event of an on the road spill or other emergency, the driver will adhere to the following procedures:

- 1. Remain with the unit and warn all pedestrians and motorists to stay away from the spill area, pointing out to them the danger involved and have someone call the police or fire department.
- 2. Upon arrival of the police or fire department, the driver will inform them of what kind of material has been spilled and request the area to be blocked off to prevent property damage or personal injury.
- 3. The driver will request the first responder, fire or police personnel to protect the area while the driver reports to the Emergency Response Coordinator listed in Section VI.
- 4. The Emergency Response Coordinator will gather the information outlined in the emergency reporting section and relay it to the Emergency Response Agencies listed in Section VII.

II. Specific Actions to be taken at the scene of the spill.

- 1. The primary concern is to prevent the escape of any hazardous substances into the ground or storm water or sanitary sewer. The driver should attempt the following procedures dependent upon the physical property of the waste:
 - a. Erect a barrier to prevent escape of spilled liquids. Put a bucket under any leaking pipe, valve or tank to catch leak. Clean up any spotting with absorbent and/or spill pillows. Create a vacuum in the tank trailer to keep material from leaking further.
 - b. Use tarp or plastic to contain solids in wet and windy conditions.
 - c. The source of the spill or leak in a drum should be located and controlled, e.g. a drum plugged or taped, turned upside down or over-packed.
- 2. In the event of a major spill and there is a possibility of fire or generation of toxic fumes, the personnel should be evacuated to a distance of at least one $\frac{1}{2}$ mile. If no fire threatens and no containers have ruptured, a distance of 50-100 feet should suffice.
- 3. Cleanup will be affected depending upon spill area. If the spill is on a paved surface, compatible absorbent material will be used. If the spillage has reached earth, all contaminated dirt will be collected. The extent of the contamination will be determined by laboratory analysis. All damaged drums will be over-packed to prevent further contamination. All contaminated material will be disposed of at an EPA approved disposal facility.

III. Decontamination.

- 1. All vehicles will be decontaminated at the site, and then transported to an authorized facility for further decontamination.
- 2. Each item of equipment will be placed in an open head container and thoroughly rinsed with a compatible solvent or cleaning compound. The residue will then be drained into a tight head container, sealed and disposed of in accordance with Federal and State Regulations.
- All contaminated clothing will be placed with the residue and disposed of accordingly. If clothing is reusable, then it will be decontaminated properly and the residue added to the other waste.

IV. Emergency Reporting.

In the event of an emergency or a hazardous waste spill during transportation, the transporter's Emergency Response Coordinator will immediately notify the Environmental Protection Agency for the state where the incident occurs and the National Response Center with the following information:

- 1. Name of person reporting the incident;
- 2. Transporter's name, address and the EPA identification number:

- 4. Date, time and location of the incident;
- 5. Mode of transportation and type of transport vehicle-(liquid tank truck, dump truck, box truck, etc.);
- 6. A brief description of the incident, including the type of incident;
- 7. For each waste involved in a spill, the following information is required:
 - a. The name and EPA ID# of the generator of the waste.
 - b. D.O.T. shipping name, hazardous class and UN number of the waste.
 - c. Estimated quantity of the waste spilled.
 - d. The extent of the contamination of the land and/or water and/or air.
- 8. Shipping name, hazard class and the UN or N.A. number of any other material carried (this concerns mixed shipments of drums).
- 9. Extent of any injuries, if any.

50 ppm acid

10 ppm chloride

100 ppm ammonia

- e. First Aid kit for minor injuries. All else handled by qualified medical personnel at the scene.
- f. Emergency reflectors for the driver's protection and highway safety.

All equipment is tested and maintained as necessary to assure its proper operation in time of an emergency. After emergency, all equipment shall be decontaminated, cleaned and fit for its intended use before normal operations resume.

IX. External Communications

- 1. All company owned vehicles are equipped with Nextel cell phones.
- 2. The public telephone system will be used in the event the cell phones are not in service range.

X. Routine Decontamination Procedures

- 1. Trailers are rinsed daily with high pressure hoses after each unit is emptied. Special cleaning, such as steam cleaning, is available when determined by the safety coordinator because of incompatible material.
- 2. All contaminated waste water, waste solutions or residues will be treated and disposed of as a hazardous waste in compliance with all applicable laws and regulations.

1.0 Purpose

1.1 The purpose of this policy is to ensure that Clean Earth has competent and qualified drivers operating our vehicles and representing Clean Earth to our customers and the public. This allows Clean Earth to minimize accidents and incidents through the hiring of appropriately qualified team members.

2.0 Scope

2.1 This policy applies to all Clean Earth activities, facilities and team members.

3.0 Definitions

- 3.1 The following are required fields to review on a driver's motor vehicle record (MVR) to verify they are qualified to operate a commercial motor vehicle (CMV) for Clean Earth:
- 3.1.1 Standard MVR (Samba Safety)- sections to review
- 3.1.1.1 Do not clear a driver off the Disposition statement Meet Company Standards as that is not Clean Earth's standards.
- 3.1.1.2 Any questions on reviewing an MVR please reach out to DOT Compliance
- 3.1.1.3 License Number [A] verify class of license and status says VALID
- 3.1.1.3.1 If the class of license doesn't match the vehicle the driver is operating, or the status says EXPIRED, SUSPENDED or TERMINATED the driver must be immediately parked and cannot operate a CMV. The driver must go to their State DMV to resolve the issue before operating a CMV for Clean Earth.
- 3.1.1.4 License Type [B] verify the type says commercial, class description typically A or B, status is VALID, review an restrictions such as corrective lenses, no air brake or automatic transmission only, endorsements for hazardous material (HM) and tanker is applicable, and many MVRs will notate the hazardous materials endorsement.
- 3.1.1.4.1 If the class of license doesn't match the vehicle the driver is operating, or the status says EXPIRED, SUSPENDED or TERMINATED the driver must be immediately parked and cannot operate a CMV. The driver must go to their State DMV to resolve the issue before operating a CMV for Clean Earth.
- 3.1.1.4.2 Under restrictions, if notated Intrastate Only likely indicates the driver self-certified incorrectly with their State. First, verify the driver's medical certification (MEC) for any notated they are not qualified to operate interstate. A driver with an intrastate restriction cannot leave the State they are licensed in and cannot transport any material related to interstate commerce. The driver must be immediately parked and cannot operate a CMV. The driver must go to their State DMV to resolve the issue before operating a CMV for Clean Earth.
- 3.1.1.4.3 If no HM endorsement notated per Clean Earth company policy a driver cannot haul HM without this valid endorsement. For the HM endorsement policy please reference the Clean Earth

- 6. A brief description of the incident, including the type of incident;
- 7. For each waste involved in a spill, the following information is required:
 - a. The name and EPA ID# of the generator of the waste.
 - b. D.O.T. shipping name, hazardous class and UN number of the waste.
 - c. Estimated quantity of the waste spilled.
 - d. The extent of the contamination of the land and/or water and/or air.
- 8. Shipping name, hazard class and the UN or N.A. number of any other material carried (this concerns mixed shipments of drums).
