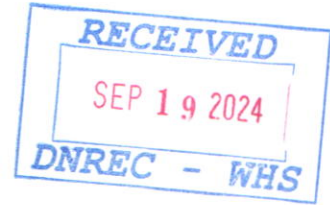

DEFINITIONS AS USED IN THIS ENDORSEMENT

Accident includes continuous or repeated exposure to conditions or which results in bodily injury, property damage, or environmental damage which the insured neither expected nor intended.

Motor Vehicle means a land vehicle, machine, truck, tractor, trailer, or semitrailer propelled or drawn by mechanical power and used on a highway for transporting property, or any combination thereof.

Bodily Injury means injury to the body, sickness, or disease to any person, including death resulting from any of these.

Property Damage means damage to or loss of use of tangible property.

Environmental Restoration means restitution for the loss, damage, or destruction of natural resources arising out of the accidental discharge, dispersal, release or escape into or upon the land, atmosphere, watercourse, or body of water, of any commodity transported by a motor carrier. This shall include the cost of removal and the cost of necessary measures taken to minimize or mitigate damage to human health, the natural environment, fish, shellfish, and wildlife.

Public Liability means liability for bodily injury, property damage, and environmental restoration.

The insurance policy to which this endorsement is attached provides automobile liability insurance and is amended to assure compliance by the insured, within the limits stated herein, as a motor carrier of property, with Sections 29 and 30 of the Motor Carrier Act of 1980 and the rules and regulations of the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration (FMCSA).

In consideration of the premium stated in the policy to which this endorsement is attached, the insurer (the company) agrees to pay, within the limits of liability described herein, any final judgment recovered against the insured for public liability resulting from negligence in the operation, maintenance or use of motor vehicles subject to the financial responsibility requirements of Sections 29 and 30 of the Motor Carrier Act of 1980 regardless of whether or not each motor vehicle is specifically described in the policy and whether or not such negligence occurs on any route or in any territory authorized to be served by the insured or elsewhere. Such insurance as is afforded, for public liability, does not apply to injury to or death of the insured's employees while engaged in the course of their employment, or property transported by the insured, designated as cargo. It is understood and agreed that no condition, provision, stipulation, or limitation contained in the policy, this endorsement, or any other endorsement thereon,

or violation thereof, shall relieve the company from liability or from the payment of any final judgment, within the limits of liability herein described, irrespective of the financial condition, insolvency or bankruptcy of the insured. However, all terms, conditions, and limitations in the policy to which the endorsement is attached shall remain in full force and effect as binding between the insured and the company. The insured agrees to reimburse the company for any payment made by the company on account of any accident, claim, or suit involving a breach of the terms of the policy, and for any payment that the company would not have been obligated to make under the provisions of the policy except for the agreement contained in this endorsement.

It is further understood and agreed that, upon failure of the company to pay any final judgment recovered against the insured as provided herein, the judgment creditor may maintain an action in any court of competent jurisdiction against the company to compel such payment.

The limits of the company's liability for the amounts prescribed in this endorsement apply separately to each accident and any payment under the policy because of anyone accident shall not operate to reduce the liability of the company for the payment of final judgments resulting from any other accident.

 - ii. Keep other personnel in the area out of the spill and upwind of the spill area.
 - iii. Secure operations that may be contributing to the spill
 - iv. Use available materials to contain the waste if such action can be taken without self contamination or immediate danger
 - b. Office
 - i. Notify the Emergency Coordinator on Duty or the Health and Safety Manager
 - ii. Alert other plant employees
2. Follow Up Action
 - a. Follow up action will be directed to:
 - i. Minimize the area affected by the spill
 - ii. Minimize the time hazardous or non hazardous wastes are exposed
 - iii. Cleanup contaminated equipment
 - iv. Minimize the exposure of personnel
 - b. Emergency Coordinator
 - i. Direct the assembling of required emergency equipment and personnel at the scene
 - ii. Direct the containment and cleanup of the spill material. Ensure the all cleanup material is properly packaged for disposal
 - iii. Evaluate the extent of environmental contamination and initiate cleanup action.
 - iv. If a Reportable Quantity has been released, direct that the National Response Center be notified.
 - v. Evaluate the need for chemical analysis to confirm that the spill has been cleaned up, obtain as required.
 - vi. Evaluate the need for local authority assistance, if needed request via office.
 - vii. Following cleanup, direct the restoration of emergency equipment.
 - viii. Following cleanup, prepare any required reports, for internal and external distribution
 - ix. Following cleanup prepare the generated waste for off site disposal.
 - c. Office
 - i. Provide communication link to local authorities as directed by Emergency Coordinator.
 - ii. Maintain records of all actions taken.
 - d. Employees
 - i. Begin gathering the emergency equipment as assigned or as directed by the Emergency Coordinator.
 - ii. Cleanup spill as directed by the Emergency Coordinator
 - iii. Restore Emergency equipment as directed by the Emergency Coordinator

EMERGENCY PROCEDURE PART C: TRANSPORTATION

EMERGENCY PERSONNEL: If this vehicle is involved in an accident while carrying hazardous chemicals or non-hazardous residual waste, call VLS at (717)393-2627 to notify them of the accident and to obtain assistance in dealing with the spilled materials and information on the contents of its load. If the load is involved in a fire or spill notify the Department of Environmental Protection at (717)787-4343 day or night. If spill is in Delaware please call Delaware Emergency Reporting at (800) 662-8802 or (302) 739-9401.

This enclosure is divided into two sections: Driver Actions and Plant Action. This procedure is unique in that there is no Immediate Action or Follow-up Action in the classical sense. Notification of a traffic accident or hazardous waste problem involving a company truck will probably come in by phone call from a police department or by the driver. The driver may or may not be in a condition to assist either responding emergency personnel or the Emergency Coordinator. The Emergency Coordinator may not be able to arrive at the scene for a long period of time and once there, may or may not be allowed by the emergency personnel to assist in containing or cleaning up any hazardous chemical spill or non-hazardous residual waste spill.

A copy of this procedure shall be carried in the cab of all company trucks transporting hazardous chemicals or non-hazardous residual waste.

DRIVER ACTIONS

1. The driver of a truck involved in a traffic accident causing an emergency while transporting a hazardous chemical or non-hazardous residual waste shall, if possible, take the following immediate actions:
 - A. Direct a bystander to call the police, and if fire is a possibility, the Fire Department. Tell the person calling to inform the emergency agencies of what type of materials are involved.
 - B. Evaluate the condition of the load. Use on-board emergency equipment to contain leaks or fight fires.
 - C. Caution: Smoke \ fume inhalation can be as dangerous as the flames of a fire. If the fire cannot be fought without exposure to smoke and fumes, do not attempt to fight it, but instead pull back to a safe distance until proper equipment is at the scene.
 - D. Warn bystanders to remain clear of the accident.
 - E. Ask a bystander to notify the Plant Manager at VLS.
 - F. Assist injured personnel if possible.
2. Upon arrival of the emergency response personnel, the driver shall, if possible:
 - A. Notify them of the nature of the load and actions needed to mitigate dangers.
 - B. Ask them to confirm that the plant has been notified of the accident.
 - C. If a fire or spill is involved, recommend that the local Environmental Agency be notified.
 - D. Assist them, with their agreement, in their actions to contain and control any fire or leak.
 - E. Assist them in their investigation of the accident.
 - F. Write down pertinent facts (who, what, where, when and why) to assist in preparing required reports.

PLANT ACTIONS

1. Upon receiving notification of the traffic accident resulting in a hazardous chemical or non-hazardous waste emergency involving a company truck the person taking the call shall:
 - A. If at the plant, assemble and load a truck with additional spill containment equipment and supplies such as absorbent materials, empty open-head drums, hand operated transfer pumps and hoses, drum truck, bung wrench, protective clothing, shovels and booms.
 - B. Proceed to the accident scene with at least one employee trained in emergency procedures.
 - C. At the scene the Emergency Coordinator identifies him \ herself to the senior emergency person present and offers assistance.
 - (1) Identify, contain and remove the waste and materials.
 - (2) Evaluate the actions needed to moderate the effects of the accident.
 - (3) Determine the extent of contamination and the success of cleanup operations.
 - D. With the approval of the official in charge, load the second truck with undamaged drums, drums containing accumulated wastes and wet absorbent material for return to the plant.
 - E. Verify that local Environmental Authority has been notified, if there has been a spill or fire involving the truck's load.
 - F. If requested by controlling official, obtain services of commercial emergency response contractor to assist in containing and cleaning up the spilled materials.
 - G. Obtain information (who, what, where, when and why) for purpose of preparing incident and insurance reports. If a camera is available, take pictures of the accident scene. Find out if any coverage by TV stations or newspapers could be a source of pictures to aid in writing reports.
2. Following cleanup of the incident the Environmental Health and Safety Manager shall do the following:
 - A. Notify company insurance agents.
 - B. Direct the performance of a receipt inspection on all returned material. Disposition of material shall be based on the results of the receipt inspection.
 - C. Direct the restoration of emergency equipment to operating condition and inventory quantity.
 - D. Prepare written reports as required, for internal and external distribution.

Internal and External Communications

VLS maintains an intercom system for all communication within the facility. As a backup two way radios are standard for over half of employees.

A fire alarm is hard wired and directly contacts our security company in the event of a fire. They have the ability to contact local emergency help in the event of an incident.

EVACUATION PLAN

1. The evacuation plan described is applicable to all plant emergencies requiring evacuation.
2. Evacuation may be ordered by the EC, the senior company official on the scene, or the senior local authority combating the emergency.
3. Evacuation is signaled by verbal instructions from supervisory personnel. Employees shall evacuate by the most direct route. Following evacuation, all personnel will assemble at the must location designated for wind conditions. Personnel will be accounted for by the supervisors and the results reported to the EC.
4. Should a large scale fire involving hazardous chemicals result in the release of smoke or gases that might endanger surrounding areas, the EC will recommend to the local authorities that evacuation of the areas be considered.

Emergency Equipment Available

In the event of an emergency VLS maintains on site or in our storage building, large quantities of sawdust and speedi dry for spill remediation. Also VLS sites maintain a fleet of vacuum trucks for vacuuming up larger quantities of spilled liquids. All hazardous materials are contained in diked areas that are able to contain 110% of the tank capacity.

VLS also maintains sufficient quantities of tyvek suits, rubber boots, safety glasses, shovels, brooms and squeegees to remediate and residual and hazardous waste spills which occur. Equipment such as fire extinguishers and multi gas meters are also available for use depending on the circumstances and needs. VLS also maintains several pressure washers on site to decontaminate macadam and emergency response equipment.

All material from residual waste responses will either be decontaminated or trashed depending on the appearance of the equipment. Any contaminated debris from hazardous spills will be treated as a waste and will be disposed of at a licensed hazardous waste facility.

Prior to a newly hired driver being released to service customers by themselves the following criteria must be met:

- 1.) The driver must receive training on all forms and records required by the Department of Transportation (DOT) as well as internal company paperwork. This includes the driver's daily log, driver vehicle inspection report, individual vehicle mileage record and daily sheets.
- 2.) A Road test must be administered by a qualified company trainer and a Certificate of Road Test must be issued.

- 6.) A new driver must ride along with a company trained driver for at least one week prior to being released on their own.

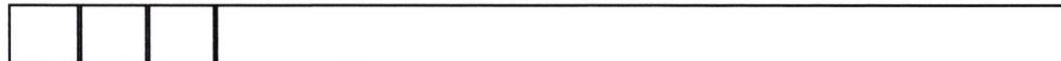
