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DEFINITIONS AS USED IN THIS ENDORSEMENT

Accident includes continuous or repeated exposure to conditions or which results in bodily injury, property damage, or environmental damage which the insured neither expected nor intended.

Motor Vehicle means a land vehicle, machine, truck, tractor, trailer, or semitrailer propelled or drawn by mechanical power and used on a highway for transporting property, or any combination thereof.

Bodily Injury means injury to the body, sickness, or disease to any person, including death resulting from any of these.

Property Damage means damage to or loss of use of tangible property.

Environmental Restoration means restitution for the loss, damage, or destruction of natural resources arising out of the accidental discharge, dispersal, release or escape into or upon the land, atmosphere, watercourse, or body of water, of any commodity transported by a motor carrier. This shall include the cost of removal and the cost of necessary measures taken to minimize or mitigate damage to human health, the natural environment, fish, shellfish, and wildlife.

Public Liability means liability for bodily injury, property damage, and environmental restoration.

The insurance policy to which this endorsement is attached provides automobile liability insurance and is amended to assure compliance by the insured, within the limits stated herein, as a motor carrier of property, with Sections 29 and 30 of the Motor Carrier Act of 1980 and the rules and regulations of the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration (FMCSA).

In consideration of the premium stated in the policy to which this endorsement is attached, the insurer (the company) agrees to pay, within the limits of liability described herein, any final judgment recovered against the insured for public liability resulting from negligence in the operation, maintenance or use of motor vehicles subject to the financial responsibility requirements of Sections 29 and 30 of the Motor Carrier Act of 1980 regardless of whether or not each motor vehicle is specifically described in the policy and whether or not such negligence occurs on any route or in any territory authorized to be served by the insured or elsewhere. Such insurance as is afforded, for public liability, does not apply to injury to or death of the insured's employees while engaged in the course of their employment, or property transported by the insured, designated as cargo. It is understood and agreed that no condition, provision, stipulation, or limitation contained in the policy, this endorsement, or any other endorsement thereon,

or violation thereof, shall relieve the company from liability or from the payment of any final judgment, within the limits of liability herein described, irrespective of the financial condition, insolvency or bankruptcy of the insured. However, all terms, conditions, and limitations in the policy to which the endorsement is attached shall remain in full force and effect as binding between the insured and the company. The insured agrees to reimburse the company for any payment made by the company on account of any accident, claim, or suit involving a breach of the terms of the policy, and for any payment that the company would not have been obligated to make under the provisions of the policy except for the agreement contained in this endorsement.

It is further understood and agreed that, upon failure of the company to pay any final judgment recovered against the insured as provided herein, the judgment creditor may maintain an action in any court of competent jurisdiction against the company to compel such payment.

The limits of the company's liability for the amounts prescribed in this endorsement apply separately to each accident and any payment under the policy because of anyone accident shall not operate to reduce the liability of the company for the payment of final judgments resulting from any other accident.

1. Overview of Training Program

Listed below is the training provided to employees at US Environmental. US Environmental, Inc. takes pride in our employees and believes training is an important part of our Company.

Operations and Transportation Personnel:

- **Employee Orientation** – Training consists of 32 hours of US Environmental specific Environmental, Health and Safety specific topics.
- **Basic Orientation Plus / Refresher (BOP/R)** – Is a safety awareness program for contract workers who work in or around petrochemical plants. This training program is offered through the Association of Reciprocal Safety Councils. Training is provided to our employees through third party training providers.
- **OSHA 40-Hour HazWoper Training (29 CFR §1910.120) and OSHA 8-Hour Annual Refresher Training (29 CFR § 1910.120)** – The training is conducted in-house by our Environmental Health and Safety Manager. Training may also be provided by third party qualified trainers as needed.
- **8 Hour Confined Space Entry (29 CFR § 1910.146(g))** – The training is conducted in-house by our Environmental Health and Safety Manager; this training is conducted at our facility and includes classroom instructions as well as hands on training. Annual refresher training is conducted.
- **8 Hour DOT HazMat General Awareness and Function Specific – Paperwork, Label/Marking & Placard Training (49 CFR § 172.701(a)(1)(2))** – The training is conducted in accordance with HM-181 / HM - 126F. This training is conducted in-house by our DOT Compliance Manager. Refresher training every 3 years.

- **2 Hour DOT Hazardous Waste Transportation Security Plan Training (49 CFR § 172.204)** – The training is conducted in-house by our DOT Compliance Manager.
- **2 Hour Vehicle & Equipment Training** – All US Environmental employees must complete our driver vehicle and equipment training program before operating any US Environmental equipment including pickup trucks. Our Driver Trainer(s) conducts all training in-house. Training is 6-8 weeks in length and includes on the road training.
- **2 (ongoing) Hour Spill Response and Reporting** – All Transportation employees are trained in spill response and reporting requirements in accordance with Federal, State, and Local laws.

Office Personnel & Management:

- **Employee Orientation** – Training consists 4 hours of US Environmental specific Environmental Health and Safety specific topics.
- **DOT HazMat General Awareness/Function Specific – Paperwork, Label/Marking & Placard Training (49 CFR § 172.701(a)(1)(2)** – The training is conducted in-house by our DOT Compliance Manager. Refresher training every 3 years.
- **DOT Hazardous Waste Transportation Security Plan Training (49 CFR § 172.204)** – The training is conducted in-house by our DOT Compliance Manager.
- **Drug & Alcohol Awareness Supervisory Training (49 CFR § 391(h) & 382.603)** – The training is conducted through Human Management Services (HMS) or through the Pennsylvania Motor Truck Association (PMTA) and provided is to management and employees involved with safety sensitive information.

2. Additional Training

Orientation Program:

- In addition to training requirements by department, US Environmental also provides a comprehensive orientation program.
- Our orientation program includes, but is not limited to: an overview of our company, a review of his/her job description, a review of the employee handbook, review of benefits information, and explanation of our safety program. In addition, we provide training on: lockout/tagout, PPE, security, sexual harassment, defensive driving, hours of service, security awareness, and accident/incident/injury reporting procedures.

On the Job Training:

- Every department provides job training. The first ninety (90) days of the employment with US Environmental is considered the training period. In this time, we teach employees about US Environmental policies and procedures. At the end of the ninety (90) day period employees are evaluated to see how you are progressing in the training program.
- In addition to the ninety (90) day training program we have supplemental programs for each department. For example, our Tanker Division has a six (6) Week driver-training program they must complete in order to drive without a driver trainer.

All training material and testing material used in the above cited programs were purchased or developed by US Environmental, Inc or was acquired from various vendors or sources such as the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration (FMCSA), Transportation Security Administration (TSA).
