



#4 Spill Control and Safety Plan:

SPILL CONTROL PLAN FOR SOLID WASTE HAULERS

- (1) Spill control and safety equipment carried in each vehicle:
 - a. Reflectors and/or flares
 - b. Fire extinguisher
 - c. First aid kit
 - d. Heavy-duty gloves, hard hat, reflective vest
 - e. Flashlight

- (2) All loads will be enclosed, covered, or tarped to prevent accidental discharge of the waste during transport to the disposal facility.

- (3) The driver will perform the following pre-trip inspections:
 - a. Driver will check the Truck per their Pre-inspection vehicle list to ensure that truck is in a safe condition for travel
 - b. Driver will ensure that they are loaded with the state-wide permitted weight and that the load is evenly distributed throughout the bed of the truck
 - c. Driver will ensure that tarp is correctly placed over the loads
 - d. Driver will ensure that the turnbuckles on the back of the truck are securely fastened

- (4) If there is an accident or other emergency which causes a portion of the load to be spilled, the driver, if uninjured, will contact the following designated company coordinator:

 2. Name: Gressia Cruz; Phone: 781-922-0739

- (5) The designated coordinator will contact the state and municipal authorities where the accident occurred. If the accident or spill has the potential to cause environmental damage, (either due to the nature of the waste, location of the accident, or additional factors such as leaking oil, gasoline, or hydraulic fluid) the person contacted will notify the state emergency response team, by calling one of the following numbers:

#4 Spill Control and Safety Plan:

SPILL CONTROL PLAN FOR SOLID WASTE HAULERS

- (1) Spill control and safety equipment carried in each vehicle:
 - a. Reflectors and/or flares
 - b. Fire extinguisher
 - c. First aid kit
 - d. Heavy-duty gloves, hard hat, reflective vest
 - e. Flashlight

- (2) All loads will be enclosed, covered, or tarped to prevent accidental discharge of the waste during transport to the disposal facility.

- (3) The driver will perform the following pre-trip inspections:
 - a. Driver will check the Truck per their Pre-inspection vehicle list to ensure that truck is in a safe condition for travel
 - b. Driver will ensure that they are loaded with the state-wide permitted weight and that the load is evenly distributed throughout the bed of the truck
 - c. Driver will ensure that tarp is correctly placed over the loads
 - d. Driver will ensure that the turnbuckles on the back of the truck are securely fastened
