

1. Spill control and safety equipment carried in each vehicle:
 - 1) Fire extinguisher
 - 2) First aid kit
 - 3) Flashlight
 - 4) Heavy-duty gloves, hard hat
 - 5) Reflector and/or flares
 - 6) Spare fuses
 - 7) Shovel
2. All loads will be enclosed, covered, or tarped to prevent accidental discharge of the waste during transport to the disposal facility.
3. The driver will perform the following pre-trip inspections:
 - 1) Service brakes, including trailer brake connections
 - 2) Parking (hand) brake
 - 3) Steering mechanism
 - 4) Lighting devices and reflectors
 - 5) Tires
 - 6) Horn

6. The designated coordinator will contract for clean-up services with another company.

If there is a situation where a driver has spilled a load, and they could clean it up they would:

3. Put reflectors and/ or flares around the spillage, to make sure it is noticeable to others to avoid an accident.
4. Direct the traffic away from the spillage.
5. Clean the spill up as quickly and safely as possible.

If there is a situation where the driver has spilled a load and could not clean it up they would:

1. Pull the truck over on to the shoulder and put the flashers on.
2. Contact the designated coordinator & the police immediately.
3. Put reflectors and/ or flares around the spillage.
4. Direct the traffic away from the spillage while waiting for clean up crew to arrive.

Drivers Qualification/Training

- Potential hires screened for 5 years experience in construction hauling
- Background / Previous employment checks performed
- All FMCSA / Del Dot requirements fulfilled
- CDL Driver License Required
- Check/pull driving records yearly
- Drivers instructed as to location of Spill Control Plan & Reviewed

Driver Training Program

- Our DOT consultants, MGSafer Services, LLC and our internal office obtain/complete for all potential and existing drivers the following:
- Clearinghouse Query (Full Query for all potential new hires, Limited query, minimum every 12 months for all existing drivers.)
- Pre-employment drug test for all potential new hires. Random drug and alcohol testing for all existing drivers. Random drug/alcohol testing is conducted according to FMCSA regulations.
- Driver Application for Employment
- Copy of the current CDL license is obtained and maintained
- Copy of the current DOT Medical Examiners Certificate is obtained and maintained. CME's are verified utilizing the CME Registry. [FMCSA National Registry](#)
- MVR is obtained. A new MVR is obtained a minimum of every 12 months & within 15 days of a new DOT Medical Examiners Certificate being obtained.
- A review of the MVR is completed by both our consultants, MGSafer Services, LLC and our internal office a minimum of every 12 months, additionally, as MVR is obtained.
- Drivers with points are counseled on an individual basis as needed.
- CDL Endorsements are obtained as required.
- FMCSA Safety Measurement System is reviewed monthly by MGSafer Services, LLC and internal office. All drivers are required to turn in all roadside inspections. Trends are analyzed by violations, and additional focused training is provided on an as needed basis.
- Monthly safety topics are provided by MGSafer Services LLC for all drivers.
- Newly hired drivers are placed with a senior driver as a mentor, until which time the newly hired driver can haul a specific product and is knowledgeable in the handling procedures. This includes being familiar with the procedures and guidelines in the event of a spill, and the conditions of the solid waste transporter's permit. Additional training and instruction are provided as needed.
