DEFINITIONS AS USED IN THIS ENDORSEMENT

Accident includes continuous or repeated exposure to conditions or which results in bodily injury, property damage, or environmental damage which the insured neither expected nor intended.

Motor Vehicle means a land vehicle, machine, truck, tractor, trailer, or semitrailer propelled or drawn by mechanical power and used on a highway for transporting property, or any combination thereof.

Bodily Injury means injury to the body, sickness, or disease to any person, including death resulting from any of these.

Property Damage means damage to or loss of use of tangible property.

Environmental Restoration means restitution for the loss, damage, or destruction of natural resources arising out of the accidental discharge, dispersal, release or escape into or upon the land, atmosphere, watercourse, or body of water, of any commodity transported by a motor carrier. This shall include the cost of removal and the cost of necessary measures taken to minimize or mitigate damage to human health, the natural environment, fish, shellfish, and wildlife.

Public Liability means liability for bodily injury, property damage, and environmental restoration.

The insurance policy to which this endorsement is attached provides automobile liability insurance and is amended to assure compliance by the insured, within the limits stated herein, as a motor carrier of property, with Sections 29 and 30 of the Motor Carrier Act of 1980 and the rules and regulations of the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration (FMCSA).

In consideration of the premium stated in the policy to which this endorsement is attached, the insurer (the company) agrees to pay, within the limits of liability described herein, any final judgment recovered against the insured for public liability resulting from negligence in the operation, maintenance or use of motor vehicles subject to the financial responsibility requirements of Sections 29 and 30 of the Motor Carrier Act of 1980 regardless of whether or not each motor vehicle is specifically described in the policy and whether or not such negligence occurs on any route or in any territory authorized to be served by the insured or elsewhere. Such insurance as is afforded, for public liability, does not apply to injury to or death of the insured's employees while engaged in the course of their employment, or property transported by the insured, designated as cargo. It is understood and agreed that no condition, provision, stipulation, or limitation contained in the policy, this endorsement, or any other endorsement thereon,

or violation thereof, shall relieve the company from liability or from the payment of any final judgment, within the limits of liability herein described, irrespective of the financial condition, insolvency or bankruptcy of the insured. However, all terms, conditions, and limitations in the policy to which the endorsement is attached shall remain in full force and effect as binding between the insured and the company. The insured agrees to reimburse the company for any payment made by the company on account of any accident, claim, or suit involving a breach of the terms of the policy, and for any payment that the company would not have been obligated to make under the provisions of the policy except for the agreement contained in this endorsement.

Preface:

All necessary precautions must be taken while performing a pick-up at a customer site.

EMERGENCY ACTIONS

All containers should be inspected prior to loading at the customer site. Containers must be shippable according to DOT regulations. If the container appears to be compromised (leaking, punctured, without proper closing mechanisms, etc.), it will not be loaded onto the transport vehicle.

STOPPING AND CONTAINING A LEAK FROM A VESSEL

1. Pull over and put on emergency flashers.
2. Place DOT reflectors 500 feet behind and 100 feet in front of the vehicle. Divert traffic around the area. All personnel should be located upwind and kept out of low areas. **NEVER LET ANYONE NEAR THE SPILL SITE AREA UNLESS THEY ARE AUTHORIZED TO BE THERE.**
3. Comply with notification procedures at the first available opportunity.
4. Consult the manifest or bill of lading for the identification of the material that is being hauled or any special handling instructions. Review the Emergency Response Guidebook for the **Potential Hazards** and **Emergency Actions** sections for the appropriate information.
5. Don the appropriate safety gear for personal protection against this material.
6. Secure the area from potential fire hazards.
7. Utilize any plugging device or material that may be available. If the vehicle is a vacuum tanker, start up the pump and put on the vacuum to hold the product inside the tanker.

STOPPING THE RELEASE OF ANY TOXIC CHEMICAL IS THE FIRST PRIORITY.

8. After the leak is slowed or stopped, put a plastic bucket, an over-pack drum or plastic sheeting under the leak to catch any further release.
9. If it is impossible to stop the leak, control the liquids by making ditches, swales or berms to an existing low point, or by constructing a catch basin. This will allow the material to pool and will minimize the area to be cleaned. Protect any waterways or storm drains by making an earthen dike using the plastic shovel in the vehicle's Emergency Response Kit. Speedy-dri or other absorbent material may be helpful in doing this. **ALWAYS DIVERT THE SPILLED MATERIAL AWAY FROM WATERWAYS, CULVERTS, DRAINS, ETC.**
- 10a. If there is a leak into a waterway and the product is lighter than water, it will float on the surface. Use absorbent booms to divert the product to a collecting area where it can be absorbed or skimmed off with a vacuum pump.
- 10b. If there is a leak into a waterway and the product is heavier than water it will sink to the bottom. Try to make a dike across the waterway containing the chemical and allowing the water to flow over the dike. Mark off the area and wait until the Has-Mat Crew gets there to divert the flow, de-water, and excavate the contamination.

STOPPING AND CONTAINING A LEAK FROM A DRUM

1. Place DOT reflectors 10 feet behind, 100 feet behind and 100 feet in front of the vehicle. If possible, divert traffic around the area. All personnel should be located upwind and kept out of low areas. *NEVER LET ANYONE NEAR THE SPILL SITE AREA UNLESS THEY ARE AUTHORIZED TO BE THERE.*
2. Comply with notification procedures at the first available opportunity.
3. Consult the manifest or bill of lading for the identification of the material that is being hauled or any special handling instructions. Review the "Guides" section of the Emergency Response Guidebook (ERG) for the Potential Hazards and the appropriate Emergency Response for the leaking material.
4. Don the appropriate safety gear for personal protection against this material.
5. Locate the fire extinguisher in the work area. Secure the area from potential fire hazards.
6. Plug the leak with drum plugs and / or sealant. Place absorbent pillows, pads or Speedy-dri on the spillage.
7. Cover leaking drum with several poly-liners. Poly-liners will minimize any sparking or corrosion of recovery drums.
8. Place an inverted recovery drum over the leaking container. Lay both drums on their side and then up right both drums so that the leaking drum is contained inside the recovery drum.
9. Gather any contaminated absorbent material and debris using a non-sparking shovel or other appropriate means. Place the contaminated material in the empty spaces inside the recovery drum. Excess contaminated material should be contained in poly-liners or plastic sheeting.
10. Close and label recovery drum with the same information that was on the original drum.

CLEAN-UP PROCEDURE FOLLOWING CONTAINMENT OF VESSEL LEAK

1. Post area to warn people and establish exclusion area with plastic ribbon or other appropriate materials. All personnel should be located upwind and kept out of low areas. Only trained and authorized personnel are allowed in the exclusion area.
2. Personal protective equipment and safety requirements must be appropriate to protect against the known or worst-case hazards on site.
3. Communications and emergency evacuation procedures will be established by site supervisor.
4. Compatible clean-up supplies and equipment (e.g., speedy-dry, absorbent pads, containment booms, etc.) will be used during abatement operations. All contaminated cleaning supplies will be collected and disposed of in accordance with all applicable federal and state regulations.
5. In the event of ground contamination, the affected soil will be removed. The extent of soil contamination will be determined by sampling. Samples will be collected following proper sampling techniques and analyzed by an accredited laboratory.
6. All contaminated soils will be removed and transported to an appropriate disposal site in accordance with all applicable federal and state regulations.

PERSONNEL AND EQUIPMENT DECONTAMINATION PROCEDURES

1. Personnel and protective clothing will be subject to decontamination procedures using water (or an appropriate solvent) in the area immediately outside of the regulated area.
2. The decontamination area will consist of a plastic lined open drum for disposal of suits, gloves and other expendable items. Two (2) wash tubs will also be located in this area for decontamination of reusable clothing items (e.g., rubber boots and gloves, respirators).
3. Equipment and vehicle decontamination will be performed on site in a designated area at the completion of abatement operations.
4. Contaminated rinse water will be collected in DOT approved containers and disposed of in accordance with all applicable federal and state regulations.

COORDINATION OF SPILL RESPONSE TEAM SERVICES

1. EQ Northeast's Haz-Mat Division will respond to all releases of hazardous substances that exceed a level that the driver cannot safely abate himself. This determination will be made by the driver, the office based on information provided by the driver, or a regulatory official at the site.
2. Once the determination is made that the driver cannot abate the release himself, he will evacuate the area of any personnel, bring the manifest or shipping paper with him and await the arrival of the Spill Response Team. The driver will remain accessible on the scene to provide any information to the Spill Response Team or regulatory officials that may be required.
3. Should the release occur beyond the geographic area that the EQ Northeast's Haz-Mat Spill Response Team can respond to in an adequate period of time, a third-party Spill Response Team will be obtained.
4. EQ Northeast maintains listings of spill response firms located throughout the United States for use in emergency situations. An emergency response division based out of Livonia, Michigan can also be used as a resource to obtain spill response contractors in the lanes the company travels.

EMERGENCY REPORTING PROCEDURES

In the event of an emergency and/or release of hazardous waste during transportation, the driver will take any immediate action that will stop or slow down the release into the environment ***without placing himself in danger***. If this is not possible, he will evacuate the area of any personnel and bring the manifest or shipping paper with him.

At the first opportunity, the driver will notify the local police & fire departments by calling "911". He will then call the office and report the incident to a supervisor who will take responsibility for notifying the appropriate federal and state agencies and the generator. If the driver is unable to reach the office, he is responsible for notifying the appropriate agencies and the generator through the phone or his vehicle's CB radio. The notification will contain, at a minimum, the following information:

1. Name of person reporting the incident.
2. Name, address, and the EPA Identification number of the transporter.
3. Phone number where the person reporting the incident can be reached.
4. Date, time, and location of the incident.
5. Mode of transportation and type of transport vehicle.
6. A brief description of the incident and actions already taken to prevent further contamination.
7. For each waste released:
 - The name and EPA ID number of the waste generator.
 - Shipping name, hazard class, packing group and UN or NA number of the waste.
 - Estimated quantity of the material released.
 - The extent of the contamination - land, water, or air.
8. Shipping name, hazard class, packing group and the UN or NA number of any other material carried.


The National Response Center and Director of the Office of Hazardous Materials Transportation must be contacted in the event of:

1. A person is killed or required hospitalization due to injury.
2. Carrier or property damage exceeds \$50,000.00.
3. Accident or spill includes radioactive materials or etiologiical agents.
4. A release that causes a continuing danger to life.
5. A release of a marine pollutant in a quantity exceeding 119 gallons for liquids or 882 pounds for solids.
6. An evacuation of the general public lasting one or more hours.
7. One or more major transportation arteries or facilities are closed or shut down for one or more hours.
8. The operational flight pattern or routine of an aircraft is altered.

This is to certify that all employees of EQ Northeast, Inc. have been trained and tested in compliance with state and federal regulations including those found in 49 CFR part 172, subpart H; and 49 CFR part 177.880. In addition, all employees involved in handling hazardous waste received training in accordance with OSHA regulation 29 CFR 1910.12.

Included in this program is training in DOT requirements regarding labeling, packaging, placarding; the safe handling, transportation and storage of hazardous materials; and the proper preparation of shipping documents including hazardous waste manifests. Drivers are also instructed in the DOT regulations concerning hours of service, vehicle inspections and substance abuse. Each driver is issued a DOT Emergency Response Guide, a Federal Motor Carrier Safety Regulation handbook and an EQNE Emergency Response Plan for Transportation vehicles which includes instructions on protecting the environment and public safety. They are also issued all of the proper personal protective equipment and supplies necessary to safely perform their tasks.

Each year employees are provided with refresher training that covers both DOT and OSHA regulations and procedures. This training serves as a follow-up to the initial 40-hour hazardous waste operations training that is performed upon hire. Employees are trained in safety and industrial hygiene topics pertinent to the handling and transportation of hazardous chemicals. During the training sessions, all the attendees are tested to assure thorough understanding of all material presented. Those successfully completing the training receive certificates of training.


