#### Clean Delaware policy regarding the transportation of solid waste on a roll off dumpster truck:

All drivers/technicians should use extreme care when loading, off loading and transporting solid waste in a roll off container.

If the roll off dumpster is overfull at the job site, the technician should contact the office and/or the site foreman to take steps to compact, organize and condense the load to remain below the top of the can.

All roll off dumpsters should have a decal indicating the maximum fill level for loading.

All dumpsters, during transport will be covered completely by a tarp permanently attached to the truck.

A load filled to the correct level and covered completely should properly prevent the release of solid waste from the roll off dumpster the vehicle is carrying.

Each operator of a roll off truck should be properly trained as to the loading, off-loading, hauling and dumping of the specific vehicle they are operating.



Dear Tara,

This letter serves to affirm that one of Clean Delaware's Roll Off Dumpster trucks was stopped because "while transporting solid waste did fail to prevent solid waste from escaping from the vehicle causing several articles of solid waste to escape out onto rt 113."

This letter also affirms that we were negligent in not reporting the violation within 15 days of its occurrence. This past week I stood before a judge at JP court 3 and pledge to all charges and paid a fine.

We have made sure that our three trucks are all labelled prominently with DE-SW-1739 and a copy of our permit DE-SW-1739, effective June 20, 2020, and is maintained in each vehicle and available for review upon request. (see attached)

Each truck is equipped with a permanently attached tarp that completely covers the load. Additionally, each dumpster is decaled with a maximum fill line. (see attached)

A policy (or written procedure) has been established by Clean Delaware and for it's technicians to understand and sign off on regarding the transportation of solid waste and the steps to be taken to prevent the release of solid waste to the environment. (see attached)

We believe the violation was a result of the container being overfull and not allowing the tarp to fully cover and secure the load. We will do everything in my power to avoid this occurrence in the future.

Dear Mr. Desmond:

On April 20, 2021, Delaware's Department of Natural Resources and Environmental Control (DNREC) Natural Resource Police (NRP) stopped a vehicle transporting solid waste. The vehicle, labeled Clean Delaware, LLC is tagged with Delaware license plate number CL121495. At the time the vehicle stop, NRP issued a criminal citation to Clean Delaware, LLC for its failing to prevent the release of solid waste from the vehicle, not carrying a copy of its valid Delaware solid waste transportation permit, and not marking the vehicle with its issued permit number.

By way of this notice, Clean Delaware, LLC is advised that it is found in violation of the statutory and regulatory requirements of 7 *Del. C.* Chapter 60 and 7 DE Admin. Code §1301, Delaware's *Regulations Governing Solid Waste* (DRGSW), and conditions of the above-referenced permit, including but not limited to the following:

1. Pursuant to issued permit DE-SW-1739, Clean Delaware, LLC is required to carry a copy of its valid Delaware solid waste transporter permit in each vehicle and present the permit to a department representative upon request. Failure to do so is a violation of Permit Condition 5, which reads:

"A copy of this permit must be carried in each transport vehicle and presented upon request to any law enforcement officer or representative of the Delaware Department of Natural Resources and Environmental Control (DNREC)."

- 2. Pursuant to issued permit DE-SW-1739, Clean Delaware, LLC is required to prominently display its issued permit number on both sides and the rear of the vehicle. Failure to do so is a violation of Permit Condition 8, which reads:
  - "The permittee's permit number shall be prominently displayed on both sides and the rear of the vehicle (motorized and containerized units) in figures at least 3 inches high and of a color that contrasts with the color of the vehicle."
- 3. Pursuant to issued permit DE-SW-1739, Clean Delaware, LLC is required to fully enclose or cover a vehicle engaged in waste transportation to prevent the discharge or release of solid waste to the environment. Failure to do so is a violation of Permit Condition 11, which reads:
  - "Each vehicle engaged in the transportation of solid waste must be fully enclosed or covered to prevent the discharge or release of solid waste to the environment."
- 4. Pursuant to issued permit DE-SW-1739, Clean Delaware, LLC is required to report all environmental violations to the Department within fifteen (15) days. Failure to do so is a violation of Permit Condition 20, which reads:

Environmental Violations: Permittee is responsible for reporting all proposed and final notices of violation, criminal citations, tickets, arrests, convictions, civil or administrative penalties proposed or assessed whether against the company, its owners or operators, corporate officers, and company employees including but not limited to drivers, operating under the authority of this permit involving any environmental statute, regulation, permit, license, approval or order. Such report shall be made to the Department within 15 days of the date issuance regardless of the state in which it occurred.

Upon receipt of this notice, Clean Delaware, LLC must immediately comply with the above-cited requirements and unless otherwise specified, submit documentation demonstrating compliance to DNREC within thirty (30) days. Submitted documentation is to include, but is not limited to:

- Written affirmation that all Clean Delaware, LLC's vehicles engaged in the transportation
  of solid waste will maintain in each vehicle a copy of the current and valid Delaware
  solid waste permit.
- 2. Photographs demonstrating that the issued permit number is placed on both sides and the rear of the identified vehicle.
- 3. A written procedure to be shared with all Clean Delaware, LLC employees engaged in the transportation of solid waste the steps to be taken to 1 prevent the release of solid waste to the environment.
- 4. Written affirmation that all future environmental violations incurred by Clean Delaware, LLC or any of its employees will be reported to the Department within fifteen (15) calendar days.

Section 9(b) Clean Delaware does not transport solid waste out of the state

Section 10 Clean Delaware is a "For Hire" company. Please see attached MCS-90 document

Section 12 Clean Delaware conducts driver training throughout the calendar year including:

- a) Drivers must hold a valid CDL-B driver's license and receive 10 hours annual training regarding Safe Driving/Jobsite Safety. Each driver is required to have a valid DOT Medical Card and agree to Random Drug Testing. Monthly driver "Tailgate Talks" past topics provided by our Workmen's Compensation provider include: Distracted Driving, Preventing Not-at-Fault Accidents, Safety with Battery operated tools, Lone worker safety, Winter weather slips and falls prevention guide, Back care, Prevent Eye injuries, Eye safety, Severe Weather tips, Step ladders, music listening devices, winter weather safety.
- b) CDL drivers in Delaware must report traffic convictions to both their employer and DE DMV within 30 days of conviction. In addition, each May, Clean Delaware checks driver records for all employees for moving violations. Our insurance carrier assesses driver safety and will disallow drivers with 10 or more points to drive. In those cases, we offer progressive training to get drivers back into compliance.
- c) (i) Proper handling procedures for the type of solid waste being hauled include first understanding what the material is, C&D debris, tires, concrete, organic waste, branches and stumps, etc. Each driver is instructed to determine what disposal facility can receive the load prior to being dispatched. Clean Delaware has a written policy (attached) on proper handling of each load.
  - (ii) All Clean Delaware drivers are required to familiarize themselves with the Clean Delaware Spil Prevention Plan for Solid Waste Haulers (attached). Drivers also have periodic training on spill control throughout the year.
  - (iii) Prior to driving any of our vehicles, drivers are trained, informed, and required to read over and understand The Clean Delaware solid waste transporter's permit. A copy is also located inside each truck.

This shall include the cost of removal and the cost of necessary measures taken to minimize or mitigate damage to human health, the natural environment, fish, shellfish, and wildlife.

Property Damage means damage to or loss of use of tangible property.

The insurance policy to which this endorsement is attached provides automobile liability insurance and is amended to assure compliance by the insured, within the limits stated herein, as a motor carrier of property, with Sections 29 and 30 of the Motor Carrier Act of 1980 and the rules and regulations of the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration (FMCSA).

In consideration of the premium stated in the policy to which this endorsement is attached, the insurer (the company) agrees to pay, within the limits of liability described herein, any final judgment recovered against the insured for public liability resulting from negligence in the operation, maintenance or use of motor vehicles subject to the financial responsibility requirements of Sections 29 and 30 of the Motor Carrier Act of 1980 regardless of whether or not each motor vehicle is specifically described in the policy and whether or not such negligence occurs on any route or in any territory authorized to be served by the insured or elsewhere. Such insurance as is afforded, for public liability, does not apply to injury to or death of the insured's employees while engaged in the course of their employment, or property transported by the insured, designated as cargo. It is understood and agreed that no condition, provision, stipulation, or limitation contained in the policy, this endorsement, or any other endorsement thereon, or violation thereof, shall relieve the company from liability or from the payment of any final judgment, within the limits of liability herein described, irrespective of the financial condition, insolvency or bankruptcy of the insured. However, all terms, conditions, and limitations in the policy to which the endorsement is attached shall remain in full force and effect as binding between the insured and the company. The insured agrees to reimburse the company for any payment made by the company on account of any accident, claim, or sult involving a breach of the terms of the policy, and for any payment that the company would not have been obligated to make under the provisions of the policy except for the agreement contained in this endorsement.

All drivers/technicians should use extreme care when loading, off loading and transporting solid waste in a roll off container.

If the roll off dumpster is overfull at the job site, the technician should contact the office and/or the site foreman to take steps to compact, organize and condense the load to remain below the top of the can.

All roll off dumpsters should have a decal indicating the maximum fill level for loading.

All dumpsters, during transport will be covered completely by a tarp permanently attached to the truck.

A load filled to the correct level and covered completely should properly prevent the release of solid waste from the roll off dumpster the vehicle is carrying.

Each operator of a roll off truck should be properly trained as to the loading, off-loading, hauling and dumping of the specific vehicle they are operating.

Each Roll Off truck is required to have the following:
