

Driver Training and Compliance Statement - The Trash Porters LLC

At The Trash Porters LLC, we take driver training, vehicle safety, and regulatory compliance seriously. Below is a summary of our driver training and internal procedures as they relate to regulatory requirements:

(a) Special Licenses, Training, and Ongoing Programs

- CDL Requirements: None of our vehicles require a Commercial Driver's License (CDL), as our fleet consists of non-CDL vehicles.
- · Initial & Ongoing Training:
 - All drivers undergo onboarding training that includes safety procedures, proper waste handling, and route management.
 - We conduct monthly training sessions to cover new procedures, safety protocols, and updates from governing agencies (DSWA and DNREC).
 - Drivers are updated regularly on policy changes, environmental handling procedures, and any permit-specific requirements.
 - Any specialized training (such as asbestos or hazardous material handling) is documented with dates and certifications, if applicable.

(b) Driver Records and Progressive Discipline

- We perform periodic checks of all drivers' motor vehicle records to monitor for moving violations.
- Our progressive discipline policy includes:
 - Verbal warning
 - Written warning
 - Suspension
 - Termination (based on severity and accumulation of points or violations)
- Drivers are counseled promptly if issues arise, with a focus on corrective actions and re-training.

(c) Driver Instruction Areas

(i) Proper Handling Procedures

- All drivers are trained on proper handling and transport of solid waste.
- Emphasis is placed on safety, environmental respect, and customer property protection.
- Drivers receive instruction tailored to the types of waste we handle in both residential and commercial settings.

(ii) Accidental Discharge Containment (Spill Control Plan)

- Drivers are trained to recognize, report, and respond to spills or accidental discharges.
- They are instructed in the use of spill kits and containment measures.
- Our roadside assistance technician is on-call to assist with any emergency clean-ups or breakdowns.

(iii) Conditions of Solid Waste Transporter's Permit

- All employees are briefed on the conditions of our DSWA solid waste transporter permit.
- Updates or changes to the permit are communicated company-wide, and incorporated into our training materials.

Additional Safety Procedures

- Daily Vehicle Inspections are performed by all drivers before beginning their shifts to ensure vehicles are safe and compliant.
- Any issues found are reported immediately and addressed before the vehicle is put into service.
- A dedicated technician is on call for roadside repairs or emergency support.
