

Motor Vehicle means a land vehicle, machine, truck, tractor, trailer, or semitrailer propelled or drawn by mechanical power and used on a highway for transporting property, or any combination thereof.

Bodily Injury means injury to the body, sickness, or disease to any person, including death resulting from any of these.

Property Damage means damage to or loss of use of tangible property.

Environmental Restoration means restitution for the loss, damage, or destruction of natural resources arising out of the accidental discharge, dispersal, release or escape into or upon the land, atmosphere, watercourse, or body of water, of any commodity transported by a motor carrier. This shall include the cost of removal and the cost of necessary measures taken to minimize or mitigate damage to human health, the natural environment, fish, shellfish, and wildlife.

Public Liability means liability for bodily injury, property damage, and environmental restoration.

Containment- After notifying local fire and/or police departments and proper company personnel, the driver should make an attempt to contain the spilled waste to the best of their ability. Containment efforts are to keep spilled from water sources and soil.

1. Use any available resource to contain the spill by constructing a temporary barrier. Use absorbent material carried in vehicles where practical. If the spill is too large to be contained by absorbent material, use dirt or any other available materials to construct the temporary barrier. The driver should make every attempt to prevent the spilled waste from spreading.
2. If the source of the spill is from drummed waste the driver should plug or tape the leaking drum. If necessary the driver should turn the leaking drum upside down.
3. If the shipping description is known (refer to the manifest) find the name in your Emergency Response Guidebook in the blue pages and turn to the corresponding guide number (orange top page land 1/3 of book).
4. If the shipping description is not known check the placard on the vehicle for a "UN" or "NA" number, look up the number in the yellow pages IN YOUR EMERGENCY RESPONSE GUIDEBOOK, and refer to the corresponding guide number.

Clean-up - Driver having contained the spill to the best of his/her ability, cleanup is the next step. Drivers will cooperate with Clean-up Company to help decontaminate the area. Clean-up Company will be responsible for the following:

1. Putting down and cleaning up any commercial absorbent such as oil dry, corn cob, fly-ash or other compatible inert material THAT will be used to absorb the spilled material sealing the container and disposing of excess material according to Federal Regulations.

2. Clean-up company will be responsible for seeing that all samples are analyzed by a qualified laboratory and is done in accordance with EPA, DOT AND Federal Regulations and all clean-up and disposal is in accordance with these regulations.
3. Follow-up Procedures - once the immediate emergency aspects of the spill have been taken care of the following steps will be performed.
 1. Notification to the National Response Center and Director of the Office of Hazardous Material Regulations, Material Transportation Bureau, Department of Transportation, Washington, D.C. must be notified in the event of :
 - A. A person is killed or requires hospitalization due to injuries.
 - B. Carrier or property damage exceeds \$50,000.
 - C. Accident/Spill involves radioactive materials or etiological agents.
 - D. Notification caused by continuing danger to life.
 2. Written Notification Requirements: To the Federal DOT which specify that a copy of the notice will be submitted to the Alabama Department of Environmental Management, P.O. Box 301463, Montgomery, Alabama 36130-1463.

Equipment will be decontaminated in the following manner:

1. Decontamination – a tractor or trailer exposed to a spill or leak will be decontaminated at the site in order to prevent any further release and so that the vehicle can be transported or move under its own power) to an authorized facility capable of further decontamination if necessary.
2. Notification – the Department of Transportation, Director of Hazardous Materials Regulation, Materials and Transportation Bureau, Washington, DC 20590 will be notified, in writing of the occurrence and nature of the incident and a copy will be submitted to the Alabama Department of Environmental Management, 1751 Federal Drive, Montgomery, AL 36130.

Emergency Equipment- Each tractor carries the following emergency equipment.

1. Qualcomm Communication Devices are in all trucks
2. All trucks have a fully equipped first aid kit containing eyewash.
3. All drivers are required to carry a flashlight as part of their emergency response equipment.
4. All drivers are issued the following:
 - Gloves, safety glasses, hard hat, protective clothing, respirator

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5. All trucks have the following:

- DOT Emergency Response Guidebook, ten pound ABC fire extinguisher, emergency reflective triangles, shovel.
- Spill kits containing booms and absorbent pads shovel, oil dry absorbent, plastic sheets, and clean-up storage bag are carried in all vehicles.
- Salvage drums containing booms, pads, and oil dry absorbent are carried on van trailer.

Safety equipment is tested and maintained to assure proper operation in time of emergency. After an emergency, all equipment is either decontaminated for future use or discarded with the load.

Training Program - In preparation for handling hazardous materials and hazardous waste, all drivers are given 24 hours of classroom training as required by OSHA 29 CFR 1910.120, 49 CFR PART 172 subpart h and part 177 as well as HM 232. All personnel are given an 8 hour refresher course to update them on current regulation.

The training familiarizes the driver with the types of materials hauled by Robbie D. Wood, Inc. and the corresponding safety and/or health hazards involved. Pursuant to that information, instruction is given in the proper use of personal safety equipment and the types of safety equipment to be used with each particular material or waste.

Spill prevention is stressed through the use of safe driving habits and, LOAD SECUREMENT, in the case of dump trailer or roll-off operation, use of rubber gasket tailgate seals and lock-down safety bolts. In the event of a spill, drivers are instructed to follow the reporting procedures on page one of this plan and the following:

1. Keep unauthorized persons away from the scene
2. Keep open flames away
3. Prevent migration of spilled materials through the use of absorbent in the case of liquid wastes and damming or dike solid material using the shovel carried in each vehicle.
4. Advise safety officials of all details of the situation.
5. Insure you don your PPE before attempting to resolve spill

Use of emergency equipment is explained and demonstrated to stress protection of the driver through the use of personal safety gear, as well as protection of the public and the environment through the use of other emergency equipment listed under the Emergency Equipment section.

The DOT Emergency Response Guidebook is reviewed so that the employee will be familiar with it in an emergency situation.
