- 1. Each driver is required to fully complete the Driver daily Log & Inspection Report at the end of each day.
- Each driver is required to thoroughly inspect their vehicle prior to leaving the employer's premises to perform their daily delivery duties. At the end of the inspection, each driver must fill out a pre-trip report and place it in the wall organizer at the end of each day.
- 3. The interior of each truck is to be thoroughly cleaned at the end of each shift such as cigarette butts, paper bags, soda bottles, cans, etc.
- 4. Every truck body must be carefully examined and cleaned prior to the loading of any type of material. The vehicles must also be cleaned at the end of each delivery.
- 5. Drivers are required to monitor the operator who is loading the truck so as to ensure that no damage is caused to the body of the vehicle.
- 6. Cellphone use by any employee while operating their truck is strictly prohibited. If the employee is contacted by the main office or has to take a call, that employee is required to respond to call(s) after the vehicle has come to a complete and safe stop at the side of the road.
- 7. Every employee is required to adhere and observe all State and Federal laws including but not limited to speeding and tailgating.

- 9. If there are any difficulties with a vehicle, each employee is required to immediately contact the office at 1-718-556-0800
