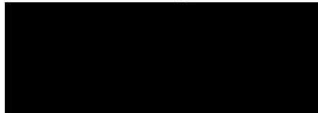

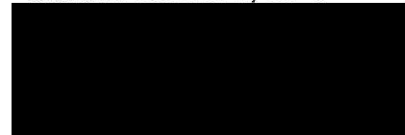

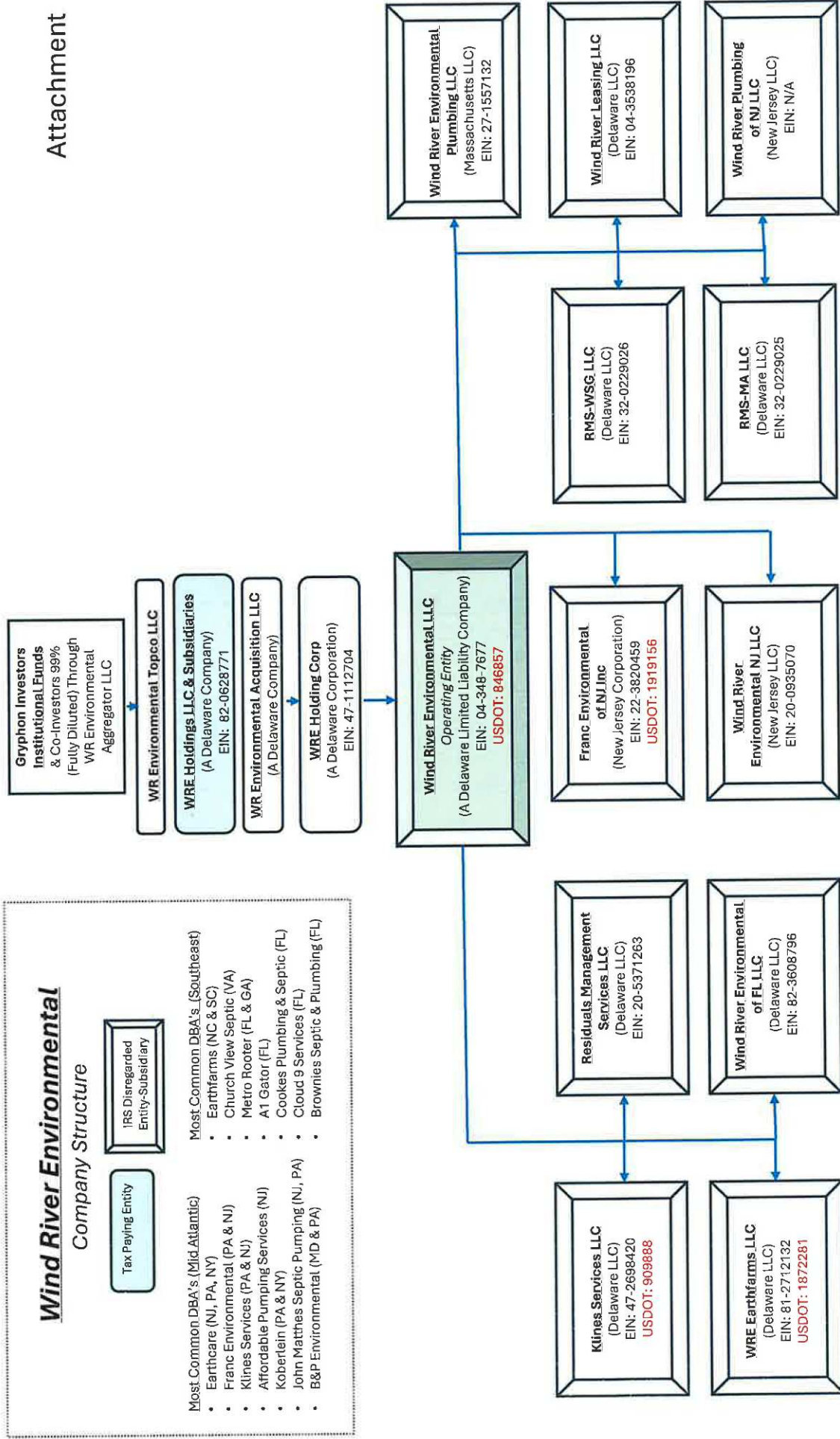

**Motor Vehicle** means a land vehicle, machine, truck, tractor, trailer, or semitrailer propelled or drawn by mechanical power and used on a highway for transporting property, or any combination thereof.

**Bodily Injury** means injury to the body, sickness, or disease to any person, including death resulting from any of these.

**Property Damage** means damage to or loss of use of tangible property.

The insurance policy to which this endorsement is attached provides automobile liability insurance and is amended to assure compliance by the insured, within the limits stated herein, as a motor carrier of property, with Sections 29 and 30 of the Motor Carrier Act of 1980 and the rules and regulations of the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration (FMCSA).

Your certificate of insurance must include by special endorsement or otherwise, these Ryder entities as additional insureds for all vehicles leased, rented, substituted or supplied to you by Ryder. 15. **Party Responsible for Physical Damage:**

If **Customer** is designated on Appendix, the following applies. You shall be responsible for all loss or damage to the Vehicle(s) in accordance with the VOSA. Charges will not abate while a Vehicle is being repaired for Physical Damage during the lease term or at expiration. If a Vehicle is lost, stolen or damaged beyond economic repair, then you agree to pay Ryder its purchase price at the time of loss and related costs and expenses as determined under the VOSA. At the expiration of a Vehicle's Term In Months (or upon earlier termination if you are not required to purchase the Vehicle), you shall pay Ryder the cost to de-identify each Vehicle and return the Vehicle to the Ryder service location listed on this Schedule A in good and working order without Physical Damage (normal wear and tear excepted). If you fail to do so, you shall continue to be liable for all obligations under this Agreement until you return the Vehicle to Ryder in accordance with this provision.

If **Ryder** is designated on Appendix, the following applies. Customer deductible per occurrence, per Vehicle is [see amount in Appendix]. If windshield damage deductible waiver is applicable for a Vehicle under this Schedule A, as designated in the Appendix, Ryder shall provide windshield damage protection for such Vehicle and any claim for windshield damage shall be at a \$0.00 deductible. In addition to Ryder's other driver requirements in the Agreement, each Vehicle shall only be operated by a properly licensed driver who is at least 21 years of age and has a minimum of one year of commercial driving experience.

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Notwithstanding anything to the contrary, upon at least 30 days written notice from Ryder, the aforementioned rates, limits, deductibles, policies or other terms and conditions can be modified or cancelled in Ryder's sole discretion.

**16. Other:**

**Inspections:** Customer shall conduct pre and post inspections of the Vehicle, complete required reports, and promptly notify Ryder of any Vehicle condition issues. Ryder will not be liable for any Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration ("FMCSA") violations or other citations for which Ryder was not provided notice.

**Guaranteed Residual During the Term and at the End of the Term:** If either party terminates the Agreement during the term of any Vehicle listed on this Schedule A (the "Scheduled Vehicle(s)") for any reason, and at the expiration of the term of each Scheduled Vehicle, you shall either: (a) purchase all such Scheduled Vehicles with respect to which termination notice has been given or with respect to which the full term has expired (as the case may be), at its Schedule A Value on the effective date of termination or the term expiration date (as the case may be), or (b) no later than 30 days before the termination date or the term expiration date (as the case may be), you shall request Ryder to determine the "Net Realizable Sales Proceeds" (as defined below) for each Scheduled Vehicle and shall then pay all amounts provided in this paragraph. Ryder shall determine the "Net Realizable Sales Proceeds" for each Scheduled Vehicle by selecting, at Ryder's option, one of the following two methods: (1) making a bona fide cash sale of each Scheduled Vehicle; or (2) obtaining 3 bona fide wholesale cash bids for each Scheduled Vehicle. The amount that Ryder receives from a sale of a Scheduled Vehicle pursuant to (1) above, less all expenses incurred by Ryder in making such sale (including any sales commission paid by Ryder) and less all taxes resulting from the sale, or the highest of the 3 bids under (2) above, shall constitute the "Net Realizable Sales Proceeds". If the Net Realizable Sales Proceeds for a Scheduled Vehicle exceed that Scheduled Vehicle's Schedule A Value, then Ryder shall remit the excess to you, provided, however, that prior to remitting the excess to you, Ryder shall subtract an amount equal to any of your unpaid obligations under the Agreement. If, on the other hand, the Net Realizable Sales Proceeds for a Scheduled Vehicle are less than that Scheduled Vehicle's Schedule A Value, then you agree to remit that deficiency to Ryder within 10 days of the date of Ryder's invoice.

**Tax Treatment:** The parties intend that this Agreement and Schedule A constitute a conditional sale and service agreement between the parties for federal and state income tax purposes. The parties understand and intend that for federal and state income tax purposes, Customer, and not Ryder, has the depreciable interest in each Vehicle. Customer expressly declines to provide the certification provided by Section 7701(h)(2)(C) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, relating to certain "qualified motor vehicle operating agreements." Ryder and Customer agree that Customer is the owner of each Vehicle for federal income tax purposes, and Ryder agrees not to claim depreciation deductions in respect of any such Vehicle or otherwise take any position on any income tax return inconsistent with such treatment.

**Additional Services:** Except for the charges listed on this Schedule A, all charges for goods and services under the VOSA, including any services subcontracted by Ryder, will be billed per Ryder's retail sales and service procedures and charges then in effect.

**Disclaimer of Warranties.** RYDER MAKES NO EXPRESS OR IMPLIED WARRANTY REGARDING THE VEHICLES, CHARGES OR ANY OTHER MATTER WHATSOEVER, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, ANY WARRANTY OF MERCHANTABILITY OR FITNESS FOR A SPECIAL OR PARTICULAR PURPOSE.

**Waivers.** CUSTOMER WAIVES AND RELEASES RYDER FROM ANY CLAIMS OR LIABILITY FOR ANY INDIRECT, INCIDENTAL, SPECIAL OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, LOST PROFITS. BOTH RYDER AND CUSTOMER WAIVE ANY RIGHT TO TRIAL BY JURY IN ANY SUIT RELATING TO THE TRANSACTIONS CONTEMPLATED BY THE VOSA.

**Default on Rental or Return.** If you are in default under any rental agreement with Ryder, you will also be in default under the VOSA. If you are in default under the VOSA, you will also be in default under any rental agreement with Ryder.

**Confidentiality.** You agree to maintain the confidentiality of the terms and rates contained in the VOSA and agree not to disclose our rates and terms unless required by law.

**Indemnity Survival.** All of the defense, release, indemnification, insurance and hold harmless provisions in the VOSA shall survive the termination or expiration of the VOSA for any reason.

When you are responsible for Substitute Vehicles, the charges shall not abate for any reason whatsoever, including, but not limited to, temporary mechanical failure.

**Component not to be Maintained by Ryder:** Notwithstanding anything in the VOSA to the contrary, Ryder shall have no obligation to maintain, repair, or adjust the following component(s) of the Vehicles listed on this Schedule A (the "Excluded Component(s)"): [See applicable component(s) and Vehicle(s) in Appendix]. You shall have sole and exclusive responsibility to maintain, repair, and adjust the Excluded Component(s) listed on the Appendix.

**Component Owned by You:** The following components ("Your Component(s)") mounted on the cab & chassis of the applicable Vehicle(s) listed on the Appendix (the "Eligible Vehicle(s)") are your property and are not covered by or subject to the Vehicle lease: [See component in Appendix]. Ryder shall have no obligation to maintain, repair, or adjust Your Component(s), and all maintenance, repair, and adjustment thereof shall be your responsibility. You shall also be solely responsible for the costs and expenses associated with mounting, as well as detaching Your Component(s) from the Eligible Vehicle(s) at the termination or expiration of the lease term thereon. Ryder has included the amount of approximately [See Appendix] for Your Components in the Original Value of the Scheduled Vehicles for licensing purposes only.)

**Pegged Maintenance:** The Mileage Rate Per Mile and Refrigeration Hourly Rate, if any, listed on this Schedule A for each Vehicle is an estimate of the actual per mile, and any hourly, costs and expenses that Ryder will incur in the performance of maintenance, repair and other vehicle related services (including but not limited to emergency road service) for that Vehicle. ### Spill Control Plan

#### Purpose

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To prevent injuries from improper handling of spills or inadequate spill response.

To prevent damage to the environment as a result of spills or releases from maintenance, field (operational) tasks or vehicle malfunctions.

To protect WRE's reputation as a responsible environmental service provider.

#### Hazards

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Slip hazards (liquid on ground).

Inhalation, eye and skin injuries (including death).

Detrimental impacts to the environment due to the release of toxic or hazardous materials.

#### Standard Operating Procedures / Best Practices

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##### General

- All spills of flammable and combustible liquids shall be cleaned up immediately.  
**! Spilled solvent or petroleum products (oil and gas) should never be allowed to drain off into sewers, any body of water or onto the ground !**
- Check all hoses, fittings, and valves for wear, damage, or leaks before departure, and ensure all caps and containment systems are properly secured to prevent accidental spills during transport.
- It is important to inspect and maintain your process equipment, holding tanks and spill control devices continually, and know what to do ahead of time if a spill or leak occurs.
- Be prepared by having proper protective equipment identified and available for personnel cleaning up any spills.  
**! If you or a fellow associate experience symptoms of dizziness, "drunkenness" or eye irritation, or if breathing becomes difficult, leave the area immediately and seek fresh air !**
- Each WRE vehicle shall maintain a spill kit that includes pig mats, spill socks, cloths, disposal bag capable of handling a spill of less than 5 gallons. Any spill greater than 5 gallons must be contained as best practical, ensuring that:





- Spilled material is kept from entering any sanitary or storm sewers, drainage ditches, rivers, streams or other water bodies of any kind and;
- Kept from coming into contact with bare soil.

## Reporting

If the spill is to pavement or to the ground, the reporting procedure depends on the volume, type and location of material spilled. That procedure is as follows:

- Procedure for Small Spills and Leaks:
  1. If it is safe to do so, stop the source of any release (shut off pump, close valves).
  2. If necessary and if you've been trained, render First Aid or CPR.

**! IF SOMEONE IS SERIOUSLY HURT, CALL 911!**

**! IF YOU BELIEVE THAT FIRE OR OTHER POTENTIAL PUBLIC SAFETY THREAT EXISTS, IMMEDIATELY CALL 911 !**

3. Locate your spill kit.
  4. Put on your protective gear (gloves & safety glasses).
  5. Cover/block nearby storm drains using drain cover seal or absorbent pads.
  6. Attempt to contain the spill material and prevent it from spreading, using broom, absorbent pads, or absorbent material.
- In the event any material of any kind is spilled to a wetland, waterway or storm drain, immediately report the spill to the branch manager or field supervisor (the first of these you can reach) and the Delaware emergency response.
  - In the event the spill occurs at either an industrial facility or a wastewater treatment plant, immediately notify the health and safety personnel for that facility so it may implement its own spill response procedures.



- If the material spilled is wastewater (septage, grease, etc.) and not fuel, oil or other vehicle fluids, and if it can safely be vacuumed up, then do so. Be sure to clear hose before beginning to vacuum so no other material is spilled.

**! DO NOT USE PUMP TRUCK TO VACUUM FUEL, OIL, OR OTHER HAZARDOUS CHEMICALS !**

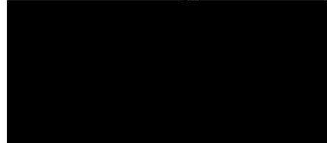

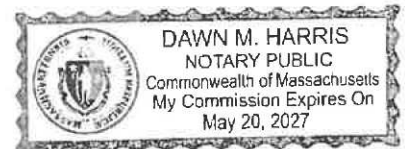
