DEFINITIONS AS USED IN THIS ENDORSEMENT

Accident includes continuous or repeated exposure to conditions or which results in bodily injury, property damage, or environmental damage which the insured neither expected nor intended.

Motor Vehicle means a land vehicle, machine, truck, tractor, trailer, or semitrailer propelled or drawn by mechanical power and used on a highway for transporting property, or any combination thereof.

Bodily Injury means injury to the body, sickness, or disease to any person, including death resulting from any of these.

Property Damage means damage to or loss of use of tangible property.

Environmental Restoration means restitution for the loss, damage, or destruction of natural resources arising out of the accidental discharge, dispersal, release or escape into or upon the land, atmosphere, watercourse, or body of water, of any commodity transported by a motor carrier. This shall include the cost of removal and the cost of necessary measures taken to minimize or mitigate damage to human health, the natural environment, fish, shellfish, and wildlife.

Public Liability means liability for bodily injury, property damage, and environmental restoration.

The insurance policy to which this endorsement is attached provides automobile liability insurance and is amended to assure compliance by the insured, within the limits stated herein, as a motor carrier of property, with Sections 29 and 30 of the Motor Carrier Act of 1980 and the rules and regulations of the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration (FMCSA).

In consideration of the premium stated in the policy to which this endorsement is attached, the insurer (the company) agrees to pay, within the limits of liability described herein, any final judgment recovered against the insured for public liability resulting from negligence in the operation, maintenance or use of motor vehicles subject to the financial responsibility requirements of Sections 29 and 30 of the Motor Carrier Act of 1980 regardless of whether or not each motor vehicle is specifically described in the policy and whether or not such negligence occurs on any route or in any territory authorized to be served by the insured or elsewhere. Such insurance as is afforded, for public liability, does not apply to injury to or death of the insured's employees while engaged in the course of their employment, or property transported by the insured, designated as cargo. It is understood and agreed that no condition, provision, stipulation, or limitation contained in the policy, this endorsement, or any other endorsement thereon,

or violation thereof, shall relieve the company from liability or from the payment of any final judgment, within the limits of liability herein described, irrespective of the financial condition, insolvency or bankruptcy of the insured. However, all terms, conditions, and limitations in the policy to which the endorsement is attached shall remain in full force and effect as binding between the insured and the company. The insured agrees to reimburse the company for any payment made by the company on account of any accident, claim, or suit involving a breach of the terms of the policy, and for any payment that the company would not have been obligated to make under the provisions of the policy except for the agreement contained in this endorsement.

It is further understood and agreed that, upon failure of the company to pay any final judgment recovered against the insured as provided herein, the judgment creditor may maintain an action in any court of competent jurisdiction against the company to compel such payment.

The limits of the company's liability for the amounts prescribed in this endorsement apply separately to each accident and any payment under the policy because of anyone accident shall not operate to reduce the liability of the company for the payment of final judgments resulting from any other accident.

EMERGENCY RESPONSE CONTINGENCY PLAN

Dart Trucking Company, Inc.

Purpose: The purpose of this Emergency Response Contingency Plan ("Plan") is to provide information and instruction in the event of a spill, release, leak or discharge of hazardous materials or hazardous waste (collectively a "Spill") during the transportation, loading, unloading or temporary storage of these materials.

EMERGENCY ACTION/ EMERGENCY RESPONSE INSTRUCTIONS:

IN THE EVENT OF A SPILL, PROTECT YOURSELF AND OTHERS. DO NOT ALLOW ANYONE EXCEPT FIRE, LAW ENFORCEMENT, EMERGENCY RESPONSE AND REGULATORY PERSONNEL ACCESS TO THE SPILL AREA.

1. Assess the scene. Set up your triangles. Remain with the unit. Warn others to stay away and to extinguish cigarettes or open flames. Stay up-wind from the spill. **Do not open any access or egress on the trailer unless instructed to do so.**
2. Get your shipping papers, Emergency Response Guidebook, and this Emergency Response Contingency Plan.
3. Go to the State Emergency Response Telephone Number list starting on page 9 of the Plan and find the reporting requirements for the state that you are in. If it says "**driver report immediately**", you must call the phone number listed **immediately**.
4. Call a Dart Trucking Company, Inc. ("Dart") Emergency Response Coordinator. Their telephone numbers are listed on page 3 of this Plan and they should be called in the order they are listed. **In case of fire or injury, call 911 or the local emergency services first, then call a Dart Emergency Response Coordinator.**
5. Follow the instructions of the Emergency Response Coordinator. The coordinator will need to know:
 - a. Is there an injury or fire? If so, who has been called and what are the immediate dangers? What are the injuries, if incurred?
 - b. Your name, vehicle number(s), date, time, and location of the spill
 - c. Telephone number where you can be contacted.
 - d. Nature of the spill – Classification, Name, and Quantity of hazardous materials. Leak within or out of the trailer? Spilling out onto the ground? How much has leaked? Flow rate? Nearby streams or drains?
 - e. The nature of the hazardous materials/wastes according to your shipping papers.
 - f. 24-Hour Emergency Contact Person as listed on your shipping papers.
 - g. Is there a continuing danger that exists at the scene?

- h. For each waste product involved provide:
 1. Name and Identification of Generator
 2. Product shipping, hazardous class, and UN or NA Number
 3. Estimated quantity of material spilled
 4. If possible, estimate the extent of contamination to land, water, or air.
6. After speaking with the Emergency Response Coordinator, you may be instructed to put on your personal protective equipment (PPE) and asked to try to confine the spread of the Spill in accordance with your OSHA training. Use the equipment provided to you to confine the spread of the Spill.
7. Cooperate fully with any officials and with the Emergency Response Contractor. **IN NO EVENT SHOULD YOU ENTER THE TRAILER.**
8. Do not speak to anyone concerning this incident except fire, law enforcement, emergency response and regulatory personnel. If you are questioned by the media, refer them to Dart's corporate office.
9. **The information required to be reported is:**
 - (a) Name of the reporter;
 - (b) Name and address, and id number of the carrier represented by the reporter
 - (c) Telephone number where the reporter can be contacted;
 - (d) Date, time and location of the incident;
 - (e) The extent of injuries, if any;
 - (f) Classification, Name and Quantity of hazardous materials involved, if that information is available; and
 - (g) Type of incident and nature of hazardous material involvement
 - (h) Is there a continuing danger to life that exists at the scene?
 - (i) For each waste product involved, it is important to provide the following data:

Name and Identification Number of Generator.

Product shipping, hazardous class, and UN or NA Number.

Estimated Quantity of Material Spilled.

If possible, estimate the extent of contamination to land, water, or air.

Shipping name, hazard class, and Identification Number of any other material carried.

The Emergency Response Coordinator will:

1. Notify the US DOT National Emergency Response Center at **800-424-8802** when required.
2. Notify the appropriate US EPA Regional Office when required.
3. Notify the appropriate state agency when required.
4. Notify the 24-Hour Emergency Contact Person listed on the shipping papers.
5. Notify the Shipper and/or Generator if this is not the 24-Hour Emergency Contact Person.
6. Notify an Emergency Response Contractor, if one is not provided by the shipper or generator.

FEDERAL REQUIREMENTS
FOR IMMEDIATE REPORTING

The Department of Transportation regulations at 49CFR 171.15 require that, at the earliest practicable moment, each carrier transporting hazardous materials (including hazardous wastes) shall give notice to the National Response Center (**800 424-8802**) of any incident during the course of transportation (including loading, unloading and temporary storage) in which:

A. As a direct result of hazardous materials:

1. A person is killed; or
2. A person is injured requiring his/her hospitalization; or
3. Estimated carrier or other property damage exceeds \$50,000; or
4. An evacuation of the general public occurs lasting one or more hours; or
5. One or more major transportation arteries or facilities are closed or shut down for one hour or more; or
6. The operational flight pattern or routine of an aircraft is altered; or

- B. Fire, breakage, spillage or suspected radioactive contamination occurs involving a shipment of radioactive materials; or
- C. Fire, breakage, spillage or suspected contamination occurs involving a shipment of infectious substances (etiologic agents); or
- D. There has been a release of a marine pollutant in a quantity exceeding 450 L (119 gal) for liquids or 400 Kg (882 LB) for solids; or
- E. A situation exists of such a nature (for example: a continuing danger to life exists at the scene of the incident) that, in the judgement of the carrier, it should be reported to the Department even though it does not meet any of the criteria above.

Specific Actions to be taken at the scene of the spill are:

CONTAINMENT- The critical problem at the scene is to prevent the escape of any spilled liquid or solid into the ground or into a storm or sanitary sewer. A barrier must be erected immediately to prevent escape of spilled materials/waste liquids, using whatever material is at hand, even a dirt curb to prevent the spreading of the spill. Containment of solids will be dependent on wind and weather conditions. Use a tarpaulin that is in the vehicle, or plastic (available at most supply stores) if conditions are wet and windy. Simultaneously, the source of the spill or leak must be located and controlled (e.g., a drum plugged or taped, or turned upside down).

CLEAN UP- With containment effected and the spillage source controlled, cleanup is the next step. If the spill is contained on an impervious paved surface, material should be absorbed onto a compatible material (e.g., sand, diatomaceous earth). Any of a number of commercial absorbent inert materials may be used, but make sure they are compatible with the waste and will not cause a reaction. If the spillage has reached soil, all contaminated dirt should be collected into drums or bogs for disposal at an EPA approved site. If any spilled waste has reached the ground, the contaminated soil will be removed. The extent of contamination will be determined by sampling the spill area. A qualified laboratory will analyze the sample. Sampling techniques, chain-of-custody requirements, and analytical methods will follow approved procedures such as those outlined in SW-846. Any soil exhibiting contamination above the local background level will be removed to an appropriate permitted disposal site. In addition to contaminated absorbents, dirt, or the like as noted above, damaged containers also present a disposal problem. Special "recovery drums" (oversize metal drums) will be used for containing damaged 55-gallon drums. Disposal will be at an approved site.

EMERGENCY RESPONSE EQUIPMENT AND PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT:

All drivers authorized to haul hazardous materials have been trained in accordance with the “HAZWOPER” guidelines and are provided and have been trained in the use of Level C Personal Protective Equipment include the following:

In addition to this equipment, drivers are issued leather palm gloves, ear plugs, eye wash, a fully equipped first aid kit, the most recent edition of the Emergency Response Guidebook, the Hazardous Materials Compliance Pocketbook and the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Regulations.

All drivers are also required to provide their own working flashlight.

Emergency Response Equipment

The **Tractors** are equipped with the following Emergency Response Equipment:

1. 10-Pound ABC Fire Extinguisher – Used to extinguish fires of the type and size for which it has been rated.
2. Reflective Triangles – Used in accordance with FMCSR 392.22 or as a demarcation line to keep the public away from a Spill.
3. Flashlight
4. Qualcomm Communications System, CB Radio and/or Cellular Telephone – For emergency communications.

The van **Trailers** are equipped with the following Emergency Response Equipment:

1. 55-gallon salvage drum – For containment of a leaking drum or to hold used or contaminated equipment.
2. Sorbent Sheets – Used to absorb liquids.
3. Mini Booms – Used to absorb liquids and to form dikes to impede the flow of liquids.
4. Shovel – Used to move dirt or to form dikes or barriers to impede the flow of liquids.
5. Broom (straw) – Used to clean up Spill area or to move liquids into or onto confinement area.

6. Safety Dry – Used to absorb liquids.
7. Nitrile Gloves – Used for hand protection.
8. Safety Goggles – Used for eye protection.
9. Disposal Bags – Used for disposal of contaminated materials or equipment.

FOLLOW-UP PROCEDURES:

Once the emergency aspects of a spill have been taken care of, there are some steps that remain.

DECONTAMINATION:

Tractors and Trailers exposed to a spill or leak will be decontaminated at the site in order to prevent any further release. To the extent that the unit(s) can be transported (or moved away under its own power) to an authorized facility capable of further decontamination, if necessary.

Equipment- Compatible solvents and cleaning compounds will be used to clean each item used in the cleanup. These items will be placed in an open head container and thoroughly rinsed clean. The residue or wash water will be then drained into a container with a tight head, sealed, and disposed of in accordance with Federal and State Regulations at an authorized disposal site.

Clothing- Contaminated clothing will be placed with the cleanup residue and disposed of in accordance with Federal and State Regulations.

TRAINING PROGRAM:

4-Hour Emergency Response Awareness

- Training shall be based on the duties and function to be performed by each responder of an emergency response organization. The skill and knowledge levels required for all new responders, those hired after the effective date of this standard, shall be conveyed to them through training before they are permitted to take part in actual emergency operations on an incident. Employees who participate, or are expected to participate, in emergency response, shall be given training in accordance with the following paragraphs:
- 29 CFR 1910.120: (q)(6)(I): First responder awareness level. First responders at the awareness level are individuals who are likely to witness or discover a hazardous substance release and who have been trained to initiate an emergency response sequence by notifying the proper authorities of the release. They would take no further action beyond notifying the authorities of the release. First responders at the awareness level shall have sufficient training or have had sufficient experience to objectively demonstrate competency in the following areas:

1. An understanding of what hazardous substances are, and the risks associated with them in an incident;
2. An understanding of the potential outcomes associated with an emergency created when hazardous substances are present;
3. The ability to recognize the presence of hazardous substances in an emergency;
4. The ability to identify the hazardous substances, if possible;
5. An understanding of the role of the first responder awareness individual in the employer's emergency response plan including site security and control and the U.S. Department of Transportation's Emergency Response Guidebook;
6. The ability to realize the need for additional resources, and to make appropriate notifications to the communication center.
