DEFINITIONS AS USED IN THIS ENDORSEMENT

Accident includes continuous or repeated exposure to conditions or which results in bodily injury, property damage, or environmental damage which the insured neither expected nor intended.

Motor Vehicle means a land vehicle, machine, truck, tractor, trailer, or semitrailer propelled or drawn by mechanical power and used on a highway for transporting property, or any combination thereof.

Bodily Injury means injury to the body, sickness, or disease to any person, including death resulting from any of these.

Property Damage means damage to or loss of use of tangible property.

The insurance policy to which this endorsement is attached provides automobile liability insurance and is amended to assure compliance by the insured, within the limits stated herein, as a motor carrier of property, with Sections 29 and 30 of the Motor Carrier Act of 1980 and the rules and regulations of the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration (FMCSA).

In consideration of the premium stated in the policy to which this endorsement is attached, the insurer (the company) agrees to pay, within the limits of liability described herein, any final judgment recovered against the insured for public liability resulting from negligence in the operation, maintenance or use of motor vehicles subject to the financial responsibility requirements of Sections 29 and 30 of the Motor Carrier Act of 1980 regardless of whether or not each motor vehicle is specifically described in the policy and whether or not such negligence occurs on any route or in any territory authorized to be served by the insured or elsewhere. Such insurance as is afforded, for public liability, does not apply to injury to or death of the insured's employees while engaged in the course of their employment, or property transported by the insured, designated as cargo. It is understood and agreed that no condition, provision, stipulation, or limitation contained in the policy, this endorsement, or any other endorsement thereon,

Environmental Restoration means restitution for the loss, damage, or destruction of natural resources arising out of the accidental discharge, dispersal, release or escape into or upon the land, atmosphere, watercourse, or body of water, of any commodity transported by a motor carrier. This shall include the cost of removal and the cost of necessary measures taken to minimize or mitigate damage to human health, the natural environment, fish, shellfish, and wildlife.

Public Liability means liability for bodily injury, property damage, and environmental restoration.

or violation thereof, shall relieve the company from liability or from the payment of any final judgment, within the limits of liability herein described, irrespective of the financial condition, insolvency or bankruptcy of the insured. 





USCG OSRO RATINGS BY CAPTAIN OF THE PORT (COTP) ZONE





This Transportation Emergency Response Procedure was developed by **Clean Harbors** for its affiliated carriers. This procedure is the fact to describe the equipment, management procedures and notification guidelines for responding to any release of Dangerous or Hazardous goods/wastes, petroleum oil or other materials that may pollute during the source of transportation over public roadways.

Note:

This procedure is designed to initiate procedures to mitigate or prevent the release of petroleum oil and other hazardous materials/westes to the environment while waiting for the arrival of an emergency response crew. The information provided by the driver will dictate the level of response needed to effectively respond to the release. Clean Harbors has the internal personnel & equipment to respond to spills from its transport vehicles in addition to a network of third party approved subcontractors used to complement internal resources.

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3. CONTINGENCY PLAN FOR IN-TRANSIT RELEASES

1. PEFERENCE DOCUMENTS (Available to driver and/or response personnel)

- a. Current Ernerser ov Response Guidebook ERG (updated every 4 years)
- b. Shipping Document (Manifest, Bill of Lading)
- c. On-line waste profile information & Safety Data Sheets
 - i. Accessed via 24-hour emergency response operator at 1-800-OILTANK

2. GENERAL RESPONSE PROCEDURES

In the event of a release or the threat of a release from a vehicle, the following procedures are to be followed to mitigate or prevent the release of patroleum oil or other hazardous materials/wastes to the environment.

1. Secure the Area

- i. Ha't/shut down the operation, for example
 - 1. Loading or unloading
 - 2. Transporting
- ii. Keep unauthorized people away from the release area by using physical barriers (i.e. caution tape, pylons) or with the assistance of local officials on the scene.
- iii. Stay upwind.
- iv. Eliminate any ignition sources.
- 2. Determine the type of material/waste that may be involved by reviewing the shipping paper(s).
 - a. Refer to the current Emergency Response Guidebook for properties of the material including any potential evacuation distances, potential fire or explosion hazards, potential health hazards, and/or potential personnel protective equipment that first responders may need.
 - b. When deploying spill containment control materials (i.e. poly sheeting, suitable absorbent material apill containment pail to catch inconsequential drips) ensure that you don your protective Tyvec suit, chemical resistant gloves, hard hat and protective eyewear as a precaution (refer to SDS for full list of required PPE).
 - c. Please note that your initial role is to simply secure the vehicle, keep unauthorized individuals away from the scene and deploy if safe to do so, necessary initial spill containment controls to protect sensitive areas (storm drains, culverts, pervious surfaces).
 - d. Remember you are not to attempt to remediate the release or to enter the dargo space of a waste hauling vehicle to identify the source of a suspected release. Take those steps that are necessary to secure the scene and initiate notification procedures and have all available shipping papers and related documents needed for first responders to safely determine a response plan.
- Attempt to locate the source of the release and the extent of the contamination.
- 4. Determine the volume and rate of release (e.g. slow leak up to a catastrophic failure).
- 5. Identify which category the release falls into:



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a. Category 1

- I. A. C. Re ease (e.g. faulty valve)
- ii. 0-5 callons or 0-23 litera released
- iii. Includes those inconsequential incidental slops & drips of material characteristic to daily servicing of our clients and which can readily and safely be managed by the respective driver with no adverse effective requirement to make notification to the regulatory agency

b. Category 2

- . Serious Rolease (e.g. container failure)
- ii. 5-55 gallons or 23-250 liters released
- iii. A. Dangerous Goods Class 2,3,4,5, 6, 8 and 9
- iv. Any release requiring an immediate notification to Agency, see section D "Notification Procedures"

c. Category 8

- i. Major Ralease (e.g. tank failure)
- ". > 55 rations or > 250 liters released

REMEMBER: The first priority of any emergency response is life & health. If you do not have adaquate information or personnel protective equipment, do not approach the release. Do not enter the material/waste hauling portion of the vehicle under any circumstances. These areas may be defined as a "confined space" and require specific Health & Safety safeguards before entering the space.

3. CONTAIN THE RELEASE

Category 1 - Pline:

- 1. Undertake initial response actions to halt the release of the oil or other material and contain its spread using a bacrbers' retarial, physical barriers, containment pail, etc. if it is safe to do so.
- 2. Look for storm drains, manhole covers and other vertical access points and dike off or dam to prevent roaterial from entering these areas.
- 3. Take those actions to protect public health, safety and the environment that can be taken without compromising your safety or the safety of others.
- 4. Initiate notification procedures.

Category 2 - Sarious

- 1. Undertake initial response actions to halt the release of the oil or other material and contain its spread using absorbent materials, physical barriers, containment device, etc.
- 2. Lock for storm drains, manhole covers and other vertical access points and dike off or dam to prevent material from entering these areas.



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- 5. Take mose actions to protect public health, safety and the environment that can be taken without compressionally or unsafety or the safety of others.
- 4. Initiate notification procedures

Category 3 - Major

- 1. Lock for surm drains, manhole covers and other vertical access points and dike off or dam to prevent material from ontering these areas.
- 2. Take those actions to protect public health, safety and the environment that can be taken without compromising your safety or the safety of others.
- 3. Initiate notification procedures

4. NOTIFICATION PROCEDURES

- 1. The driver is to immediately notify Clean Harbors Driver Manager at his/her home office and provide his/her harms, address & phone number. If after hours, initial notification is to be made to the Clean Harbors 24-hour emergency response phone number. The driver is to provide the following information:
 - a. Fractions for of release;
 - b. Identity of material being released;
 - c Type of vehicle involved in release along with type of container (s). If a tank is involved, provide volume contained within the vessel:
 - d. Estimated amount of material released, flow rate & current weather conditions on scene;
 - e. Area meterial was released to (i.e. asphalt, soil, storm drain, etc.);
 - Name and address of shipper;
 - g. Shipping document and or manifest numbers.
 - h. Actions taken prior to notification.

Note: If required by the respective jurisdiction, the driver must make an immediate report to the applicable agency (i.e. in British Columbia report to Provincial Emergency Program, PEP, 1-800-663-3456).

- 2. Drive: Manager is then to notify the Clean Harbors' Transportation Compliance Team who will then make appropriate notifications to local, state, provincial, and federal agencies (including National Emergency Response Center when applicable) listed in Appendix 1-3.
- 3. Driver Manager will then dispatch necessary equipment and personnel from the closest Clean Harbors sarvice penter to the scene.

- A release of a marine pollutant in excess of 119 gallons for a liquid or 882 pounds for a solid, Or
- A situation exists in which a continuing danger to life exists at the scene of the incident.

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5. RESPONSIBLE COMPANY OFFICIAL

The company officials listed in Appendix 5 will be responsible for insuring that all required notifications are made, all required range are generated and submitted, appropriate emergency response resources are dispatched to the incident scene, appropriate health and safety measures are taken throughout the duration of any response activity and all media involvement is handled in accordance with established company protocols.

NOTE: Clean Harbors will utilize internals spill response teams positioned throughout North America based on proximity to an incident scene. In the event local coverage is not feasible, a 3rd party suitably trained and competent subcentractor (CERCA member in Canada) will be engaged to represent Clean Harbors to address and respond to an incident.



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
6. SCENARIO CLEAN-UP PROCEDURES

The transporter is responsible for the clean-up of a release that occurred during the course of transportation. Therefore, it is the responsibility of the driver to monitor the scene and take any necessary actions to isolate, contain and control the release and prevent its spread. The driver is required to be in attendance (i.e. on-duty not driving) of the motor vehicle until such time that company personnel arrive to conduct the clean-up operation. At this time, the motor carrier will make the determination as to the duty status of the driver.

A. Actions

Once the emergency response crew arrives at the scene, the following actions will be taken if the release has stopped. If the release is ongoing, measures to transfer remaining product from the damaged or defective vessel to a receiving vessel will be conducted concurrent to the below actions. In the event of a fire resulting in a roleage, the extinguishing agent run-off will treated as product contaminated.

- 1. Material that has been released to impervious surface (i.e. concrete or pavement) will be absorbed using a suitable absorbent such as speedy dry or distornaceous earth. This material will then be containerized and sent to a fully licensed waste management facility for disposal.
- 2. Material that has reached any pervious surface such as soil will result in the remediation of the affected area to the extent that all contamination is removed. All material collected as a result of said remediation will be containerized and sent for disposal at a fully licensed waste management facility. In addition, analytical will be conducted by an approved lab (BTEX, PAH etc.) when necessary to determine that all contamination has been removed.
- 3. Material that has reached a water body such as a stream, river or lake will result in a remediation and mitigation of the affected area to facilitate the removal of all contamination possible through use of absorbents, beams, and physical/vacuum material recovery. All material collected as a result of said remediation will be containerized and sent for disposal at a fully licensed waste management facility. In addition, analytical will be conducted by an approved lab (BTEX, PAH etc.) when necessary to determine that all contamination has been removed.
- 4. Prior to leaving any site, appropriate backfill will be used to replace any ground cover removed during the clean-up process.
- 5. Any damaged container involved in an incident will be placed into a suitable salvage drum and shipped to a fully licensed waste management facility for disposal.



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B. Equipment hequirer sats

Every Clean Harbors commercial vehicle (vehicles with CVWR >10,000 #) must have the following equipment readily available and in working condition. Vehicles not found to be in 100% compliance with this part will be placed but of selver until such time that the required equipment is secured.

- 1. (Manda cr., Raced 10 B:C or greater fire extinguisher mounted in the cab of the power unit.
- 2. (Optional for Non-Haz) Rated 40 B:C or greater fire extinguisher mounted outside of the cab. Each fire extinguisher must be inspected for a valid inspection date and to ensure that it is fully charged.

Note: Excinguishers cannot be mounted inside the cargo-carrying portion of the vehicle. In Canada all highway tanks transporting Class 3 or subsidiary Class 3 MUST have a minimum 40 B:C extinguisher arounted to the tank

- 3. Volking flashlight or headlamp (other than cell phone).
- 7. Working 2-way communication (cell phone, satellite phone, CB radio).
- 8. Set of 3 triangle reflectors (warning signals)
- 9. Chock block set.
- 10. First aid kit with 16-ounce eyewash
- 11. Spare fuses and circuit breakers (as appropriate).
- 12. Current copy of Clean Harbor's In-Transit Emergency Response Procedures. (This document)

All Clean Harbors commercial vehicles with GVWR >10,001 # must also have available:

- 1. Current DOT Emergency Response Guidebook (must always be with the manifest and within the reach of the driver while at the controls of the vehicle). (US/CAN)
- 2. Oriver's Pocket Guide to Hazardous Materials (US)
- 3. Federal Motor Carrier Safety Regulations. (US)
- 4. Applicable hazardous waste manifest or shipping document



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- 5. A spile kit (included or otherwise) containing, at minimum:
 - (a) Five (5 g 1:lo bucket w/lid
 - (b) Inort absorbent granular material
 - (c) Absorbent pads, diapers and/or socks
 - / Small showel & broom
 - e) Sim (E, mil poly inset
 - (f) Galbert hags
- 6. Paraonal Protective Equipment containing at minimum:
 - /c' Tyvek or strem suit
 - b) Maria gloves
 - (c) Gorgle
 - (d) Other PPE may be specific to the product being transported
- 7. A One-gallon container of germicide [bleach solution] for those vehicles transporting medical waste.

MOTE: Drivers & Dispatchers: Please be aware that it is your responsibility to ensure that the items on this list are available and in working order before each trip. If any item is missing, do not begin the trip until the required equipment is secured.



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7. FOLLOW-UP PROCEDURES

A. Decontamination

Decontamination of all contaminated vehicles, equipment and clothing will be conducted prior to departure from a spill site. Decontamination of a truck or trailer will be conducted by removing all visible liquid or solid contamination. In addition, a suitable decontamination solution will be used to prepare the vehicle for transport to a suitable facility for further decontamination if necessary. The primary goal of the on-site decontamination is to prevent additional material being released to the environment. Equipment used in the clean-up process will be decontaminated using a suitable decontamination solution.

All rinse-ate used in the process will be containerized and sent for disposal at a fully licensed waste management facility.

All contarpinated clothing will be containerized and managed in the same manner as the rinse-ate collected from the decontamination of the vehicle and equipment involved in the clean-up procedure.

B. Written Notification Canada Notification

If an immediate report was required to be made for an accidental release, a dangerous goods accident, or a dangerous goods incident, a follow-up report must be made as prescribed by TDG Regulations Part VIII and sent to the Director General within 30 days after the occurrence.

USA Notification

Within 30 days of a discharge of a hazardous waste, a written report will be completed on the form prescribed by the U.S. DOT (DOT 5800.1 spill report) and uploaded to the HAZMATICS system on the PHMSA Portal Access Page. This report will be completed by the Transportation Compliance Department.



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B DOTATOG EMERGENCY RESPONSE GUIDEBOOK

A. Purpose of Guidebook

The current Emerger by Response Guidebook is to be used to obtain initial response information (i.e. spill containment, personal protective equipment, first aid, evacuation information) while weiting for emergency response clear to arrive on scene. Federal Regulations require that each driver have this reference document available in the event of a release. The book is updated every 4 years.

APPENDIX 2 LOUISIANA REPORTING REQUIREMENTS

SMP of Transportation Compliance

TRANSPORTATION RELEASE AND INCIDENT REPORTING CRITERIA

RS 32:1510. REPORTING OF INCIDENTS. ACCIDENTS, AND GLEANUPS.

- A. Each person involved in an incident, accident, or the cleanup of an incident or accident during the transportation, loading, unloading, created storage in any place of a hazardous material subject to this Chapter shall report immediately by telephone to the department if that incident, accident, or cleanup of an incident or accident involves:
 - A fatality due to fire, explosion, or exposure to any hazardous material.
 - (2) The hospitalization of any person due to fire, explosion, or exposure to any hazardous material.
 - (3)(a) A continuing danger to life, health, or property at the place of the incident or accident under any of the following circumstances:
 - (i) The incident or accident results in the release of a hazardous material, as defined in Title 49 of the Code of Federal Regulations.
 - [1] As a result of the incident or accident, a bulk package of a regulated hazardous material as defined in Title 49 of the Code of Federal Regulations, comes to rest at an angle forty-five degrees or more from the upright position.
 - (iii) It is deemed necessary to transfer a hazardous material, as defined in Title 49 of the Code of Federal Regulations, from one bulk package to another bulk package on a public highway or within 500 feet of an inhabited building.
 - (b) Vehicles suffering mechanical failures completely unrelated to the transportation container or the material contained therein, shall not be required to notify under this Paragraph.
 - (4) An astimated property damage of more than ten thousand dollars.



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- E. (i) Notwitestancing any other provision of law to the contrary, the provisions of this Section shall not apply to any incidence, accidents, or cleanup of incidents or accidents that occur within a facility that is subject to the release reporting requirements of F.S. 30:2073(B) and is engaged in activities defined or classified under one or more of the following subsectors, industry groups, or industries of the 1997 North American Industry Classification System (NAICS):
 - (a, 111 ,o., and gas a traction)
 - (b) 22111 (cledic power generation)
 - (c) 3221 (pulp, paper, and paperboard mills)
 - (d) 324 (petroleum and coal products manufacturing)
 - (e) 325 (chemical manufacturing)
 - (f) 326 (bl. sucs and tubber products manufacturing)
 - (g) 331 (primare metal manufacturing)
 - (h) 1953 (refuse evetems)
 - (i) 4212 (thosel trucking without storage)
 - (i) 4733 (trucking without storage)
 - (2) Notwith standing the provisions of Paragraph 1 of this Subsection, this Section shall apply to any carrier involved in any incident, accident, or cleanup of an incident or accident which occurs outside the perimeter of any facility exempted from this Section pursuant to Paragraph 1 of this Subsection.

Any emergency or release notification made to the Hazardous Materials Hotline must be received no later than one hour after the occurrence, depending on the exigency of the circumstances. This is a guideline which places the burden of immediate notification on the responsible party ensuring that timely notification to Local and State government occurs. The purpose of this immediate notification is to ensure the public's safety.

Company policy requires that a representative of the Transportation Compliance Department be contacted by phone when a company employee is involved in an accident on either public or private property or when there is a release or any material from a company vehicle in transit. In-transit includes loading, unloading, temporary storage and while being transported. In-transit does not include those times when the transporter is not present, and a vehicle is being loaded and/or unloaded by the facility either accepting a shipment or gropering a shipment for transportation. In this scenario - the reporting is the responsibility of the facility not the transporter.

The expectation is for the responsible party to contact the Transportation Compliance Specialist assigned to the region where the accident/incident occurred. If the primary contact is unavailable, contact the 24 hour Emergency Pespense operator at the number identified above and you will be placed in contact with an alternate Transportation Compliance Specialist.
