It is further understood and agreed that, upon failure of the company to payany final judgment recovered against the insured as provided herein, the judgment creditor may maintain an action in any court of competent jurisdiction against the company to compel such payment.

The limits of the company's liability for the amounts prescribed in this endorsement apply separately to each accident and any payment under the policy because of anyone accident shall not operate to reduce the liability of the company for the payment of final judgments resulting from any other accident.

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#### **Regulatory Compliance History**

AEG Environmental has been an environmental management contractor in Maryland, Virginia, Pennsylvania, Delaware, and Washington DC since 1995. We currently hold the following permits and certifications:

- Maryland Oil Operations Permit (No. 2019-OPV-2992)
- Maryland Hazardous Waste Hauler (No. HWH 658)

In the 28+ years that AEG has been doing business the Company has received nine Notice of Violations (NOV) from regulatory agencies. In May 2004 the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) issued an NOV for transporting hazardous waste on an erroneous manifest. The reason for this NOV was that one of our drivers had incorrectly dated a waste manifest and had miscounted a particular line item quantity by one.

In May of 2007, July of 2008, October of 2016 and October of 2018, AEG filed our quarterly hazardous waste report to the Pennsylvania DEP late. In January 2017, AEG mistakenly omitted the October 2016 NOV from our Residual Waste Permit Application. The DEP issued a Notice of Violation for these errors. No further action was taken against AEG in any of these cases.

In October of 2007, AEG was issued a Notice of Violation from the State of Connecticut Department of Environmental Protection. The NOV stated that AEG had transported hazardous waste in Connecticut without a obtaining a permit. This was an error. AEG had transported waste for a generator located in Connecticut; however all the waste was located in Maryland and disposed of in Pennsylvania. No waste had ever entered or been transported in Connecticut. Upon explanation, the Connecticut DEP closed the NOV and no further action was taken against AEG.

In February of 2012 AEG was issued a Notice of Violation from the Pennsylvania DEP. On this occasion a drum of non-hazardous waste in our vehicle failed and caused a spill. AEG responded to the spill site with a hazardous materials response team and remediated the spill area. There was no environmental impact from this incident and the NOV is closed.

Other than these instances, AEG has no other Enforcement Actions in our 28+ year compliance history.
