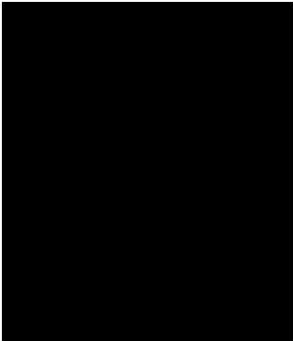

Documentation & Communication Tools

- Material Safety Data Sheets (MSDS/SDS) for all materials carried
- Emergency contact list (company safety officer, hazmat response team, emergency services)
- Copy of the transport manifest
- Spill incident report forms

- Mobile phone or two-way radio

2. Driver Preventative Measures

Drivers should take the following steps to **prevent a spill or incident**:

Before Departure:

- Inspect all **containers for leaks or damage**
- Ensure all materials are **securely loaded and labeled**
- Check for proper **containment and segregation** of incompatible materials
- Verify **spill kit and PPE** are present and stocked
- Review SDS and understand emergency procedures
- Complete **vehicle inspection** (tires, brakes, lights, etc.)

During Transport:

- Drive defensively, maintain **safe speeds**
 - Avoid **sudden stops or sharp turns**
 - **Monitor cargo area** during stops
 - Avoid unauthorized or risky routes

3. Driver Immediate Corrective Actions if a Spill Occurs

If a spill occurs, the driver should follow these **emergency steps**:

1. Ensure Personal Safety

- Pull over in a **safe location**, turn on **hazard lights**
- **Assess the scene** for fire, fumes, or danger
- Don **PPE** before approaching spill

2. Contain the Spill

- Use absorbent socks/pads to limit spread

- Stop leak at the source if safe to do so
- Place containers under dripping material if needed
- Avoid letting material enter **storm drains or water bodies**

3. Secure the Area

- Keep public away from the spill zone
- Place warning triangles, cones, or caution tape

4. Notify Company and Authorities

- Call **company dispatch or safety officer** immediately
- Provide:
 - Location
 - Material spilled
 - Estimated quantity
 - Any injuries or environmental risks
- If necessary, call **911 or local hazmat response**

- Mobile phone or two-way radio
- GPS tracking (preferred)

2. Driver Preventative Measures

Drivers should take the following steps to **prevent a spill or incident**:

Before Departure:

- Inspect all **containers for leaks or damage**
- Ensure all materials are **securely loaded and labeled**
- Check for proper **containment and segregation** of incompatible materials
- Verify **spill kit and PPE** are present and stocked
- Review SDS and understand emergency procedures
- Complete **vehicle inspection** (tires, brakes, lights, etc.)

During Transport:

- Drive defensively, maintain **safe speeds**
- Avoid **sudden stops or sharp turns**
- **Monitor cargo area** during stops
- Avoid unauthorized or risky routes

3. Driver Immediate Corrective Actions if a Spill Occurs

If a spill occurs, the driver should follow these **emergency steps**:

1. Ensure Personal Safety

- Pull over in a **safe location**, turn on **hazard lights**
- **Assess the scene** for fire, fumes, or danger
- Don **PPE** before approaching spill

2. Contain the Spill

- Use absorbent socks/pads to limit spread

- Stop leak at the source if safe to do so
- Place containers under dripping material if needed
- Avoid letting material enter **storm drains or water bodies**

3. Secure the Area

- Keep public away from the spill zone
- Place warning triangles, cones, or caution tape

4. Notify Company and Authorities

- Call **company dispatch or safety officer** immediately
- Provide:
 - Location
 - Material spilled
 - Estimated quantity
 - Any injuries or environmental risks
- If necessary, call **911 or local hazmat response**
