

## DEFINITIONS AS USED IN THIS ENDORSEMENT

**Accident** includes continuous or repeated exposure to conditions or which results in bodily injury, property damage, or environmental damage which the insured neither expected nor intended.

**Motor Vehicle** means a land vehicle, machine, truck, tractor, trailer, or semitrailer propelled or drawn by mechanical power and used on a highway for transporting property, or any combination thereof.

**Bodily Injury** means injury to the body, sickness, or disease to any person, including death resulting from any of these.

**Property Damage** means damage to or loss of use of tangible property.

The insurance policy to which this endorsement is attached provides automobile liability insurance and is amended to assure compliance by the insured, within the limits stated herein, as a motor carrier of property, with Sections 29 and 30 of the Motor Carrier Act of 1980 and the rules and regulations of the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration (FMCSA).

In consideration of the premium stated in the policy to which this endorsement is attached, the insurer (the company) agrees to pay, within the limits of liability described herein, any final judgment recovered against the insured for public liability resulting from negligence in the operation, maintenance or use of motor vehicles subject to the financial responsibility requirements of Sections 29 and 30 of the Motor Carrier Act of 1980 regardless of whether or not each motor vehicle is specifically described in the policy and whether or not such negligence occurs on any route or in any territory authorized to be served by the insured or elsewhere. Such insurance as is afforded, for public liability, does not apply to injury to or death of the insured's employees while engaged in the course of their employment, or property transported by the insured, designated as cargo. It is understood and agreed that no condition, provision, stipulation, or limitation contained in the policy, this endorsement, or any other endorsement thereon,

**Environmental Restoration** means restitution for the loss, damage, or destruction of natural resources arising out of the accidental discharge, dispersal, release or escape into or upon the land, atmosphere, watercourse, or body of water, of any commodity transported by a motor carrier. This shall include the cost of removal and the cost of necessary measures taken to minimize or mitigate damage to human health, the natural environment, fish, shellfish, and wildlife.

**Public Liability** means liability for bodily injury, property damage, and environmental restoration.

or violation thereof, shall relieve the company from liability or from the payment of any final judgment, within the limits of liability herein described, irrespective of the financial condition, insolvency or bankruptcy of the insured. However, all terms, conditions, and limitations in the policy to which the endorsement is attached shall remain in full force and effect as binding between the insured and the company. The insured agrees to reimburse the company for any payment made by the company on account of any accident, claim, or suit involving a breach of the terms of the policy, and for any payment that the company would not have been obligated to make under the provisions of the policy except for the agreement contained in this endorsement.

It is further understood and agreed that, upon failure of the company to pay any final judgment recovered against the insured as provided herein, the judgment creditor may maintain an action in any court of competent jurisdiction against the company to compel such payment.

Emergency response arrangements are in place. Contractors are capable of providing emergency response assistance for the cleanup and disposal of liquid and solid hazardous waste.

**V. Emergency Response Equipment**

Each Univar Solutions USA unit carries an emergency response kit containing the following:

- Gloves
- Goggles
- DOT Emergency Response Guidebook
- Flashlight
- Spill cleanup material

**Each unit also carries:**

- First aid kit
- Reflector Triangles
- ABC Fire Extinguisher

All emergency equipment and supplies are inspected, and the results of the inspections documented in facility files.

**VI. External Communications**

All Univar Solutions USA power units that transport hazardous waste are equipped with a CB radio or cellular telephone for communication in the event of an emergency.

**VII. Clean Up & Decontamination Procedures**

A. Truck and Trailer- In the event of a spill aboard a truck or trailer, the first step is to contain and absorb the spill. The vehicle is then taken to an authorized truck washout station where it will be cleaned.

B. Clothing and Equipment-Each item thought to be collated will be disposed of into an open head container. The container and contents will be manifested to a permitted treatment/ disposal facility for proper disposal.

## VIII. Training Program

Each driver and warehouse worker involved in handling hazardous materials and hazardous waste receive initial and annual refresher training. Training consists of a combination of formal classroom training and on the job training. Training is conducted by facility management and regional specialists from within Univar Solutions USA. Trainers are qualified through training and experience. The following is a list of typical topics covered during formal classroom training:

- Waste manifesting
- Container receiving and inspection
- Emergency response equipment
- Emergency Procedures
- Waste labeling
- Container and product compatibility
- Placarding of vehicles
- Use of Emergency Response Guidebook

## IX. Spill response

Since much of the drivers' actions involve hazardous materials and handling hazardous wastes their instruction specifically includes the following: Vehicle Inspection Procedures, Safety and Health Hazards and Spill Response procedures.

In the event of an emergency, the driver is trained to protect the scene of an incident, contain any spill as possible, obtain emergency assistance and notify the nearest Univar Solutions USA facility of the incident as soon as possible.

In addition, the driver will ensure the following:

A. Know his/her load contents:

Before a driver leaves a facility with a load of hazardous materials or hazardous waste, he/she will know the nature of any dangerous articles on the load so that in the event of an emergency, he/she will be able to inform emergency responders and other officials.

B. Instruct other persons to stay away from the vicinity of the vehicle during an emergency.

C. Communicate that open flames, fires, lighted cigarettes and other sources of ignition are kept away from the vehicle.

- D. Place proper emergency warning devices are set up as required.
- E. Prevent, if possible, liquids from running onto highways, into sewers, streams, ditches, ponds or other bodies of water.

### **Emergency Procedure Guide**

When transporting hazardous materials and hazardous wastes the lading must be checked to ensure its integrity and to safeguard human health and the environment from release of any hazardous materials or hazardous waste.

Transportation incidents may be classed in two general categories: 1) Major accidents involving injuries and / or the release of large quantities of hazardous materials, and 2) minor incidents involving the discovery of a small release.

To provide immediate emergency response to a release of a solid material or waste while on the road. Each company vehicle carries an isolation spill kit. The kit allows the driver to contain the spill until the emergency response contractors arrive on scene.

If a minor release of a solid material or waste is discovered during transport, it is incumbent upon the driver to attempt to the maximum extent practicable, to stop the release and dean up any spilled substance. During transportation, when it is discovered during routine inspection that a solid waste is being released, regardless of quantity, the following emergency procedures shall apply.

A copy of the table of Contents for the training manuals and other materials used in the Univar Solutions USA training program is maintained at our Univar Solutions USA facilities. Also available is a copy of the hazardous waste training topics reviewed during the training process.

### X. **Implementation Schedule**

All of the above are already in use.

### **Major Transportation Accident**

1. The driver should ensure the truck is safely parked and contact the local authorities first to summon help for the injured. If hazardous material is on fire or leaking, report this also to the local authorities. Most local authorities can be contacted via 911. If 911 service is not available, the driver should contact the state police.
2. The driver should contact the Transportation Manager/ Supervisor at the closest Univar Solutions location to report the incident. The Transportation Manager/ Supervisor shall contact the Regional Regulatory Manager who in turn will report the release to the appropriate federal and state authorities. The Transportation Manager/ Supervisor will contact one of the Univar Solutions nationwide response contractors to respond to the event location.
3. The driver should assist and obtain help for the injured.
4. Only after emergency medical help has arrived, should the driver attempt to control and contain any release of solid material or waste. This should be done only with the proper safety clothing and equipment and only if there is no risk of injury to the drivers.
5. The driver should attempt to control the release using the methods described for minor incidents (leakers).

### **Minor Incident (Leaker)**

1. The driver should attempt to stop the release or to at least contain the release. This should be done with proper safety clothing and equipment and if there is no risk of injury to the driver. Once a leak has been found, the following steps apply:
  - a. Set up reflective triangles
  - b. Attempt to stop the release if safe to do so by laying down absorbent material.
2. The Transportation Manager/ Supervisor will make the decision to obtain outside assistance and or respond with additional resources.
3. The Transportation Manager/ Supervisor shall contact the Regional Regulatory Manager immediately, who will in turn report the release to the appropriate federal and state authorities.


