



DEFINITIONS AS USED IN THIS ENDORSEMENT

Accident includes continuous or repeated exposure to conditions or which results in bodily injury, property damage, or environmental damage which the insured neither expected nor intended.

Motor Vehicle means a land vehicle, machine, truck, tractor, trailer, or semitrailer propelled or drawn by mechanical power and used on a highway for transporting property, or any combination thereof.

Bodily Injury means injury to the body, sickness, or disease to any person, including death resulting from any of these.

Property Damage means damage to or loss of use of tangible property.

Environmental Restoration means restitution for the loss, damage, or destruction of natural resources arising out of the accidental discharge, dispersal, release or escape into or upon the land, atmosphere, watercourse, or body of water, of any commodity transported by a motor carrier. This shall include the cost of removal and the cost of necessary measures taken to minimize or mitigate damage to human health, the natural environment, fish, shellfish, and wildlife.

Public Liability means liability for bodily injury, property damage, and environmental restoration.

The insurance policy to which this endorsement is attached provides automobile liability insurance and is amended to assure compliance by the insured, within the limits stated herein, as a motor carrier of property, with Sections 29 and 30 of the Motor Carrier Act of 1980 and the rules and regulations of the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration (FMCSA).

In consideration of the premium stated in the policy to which this endorsement is attached, the insurer (the company) agrees to pay, within the limits of liability described herein, any final judgment recovered against the insured for public liability resulting from negligence in the operation, maintenance or use of motor vehicles subject to the financial responsibility requirements of Sections 29 and 30 of the Motor Carrier Act of 1980 regardless of whether or not each motor vehicle is specifically described in the policy and whether or not such negligence occurs on any route or in any territory authorized to be served by the insured or elsewhere. Such insurance as is afforded, for public liability, does not apply to injury to or death of the insured's employees while engaged in the course of their employment, or property transported by the insured, designated as cargo. It is understood and agreed that no condition, provision, stipulation, or limitation contained in the policy, this endorsement, or any other endorsement thereon,

or violation thereof, shall relieve the company from liability or from the payment of any final judgment, within the limits of liability herein described, irrespective of the financial condition, insolvency or bankruptcy of the insured. However, all terms, conditions, and limitations in the policy to which the endorsement is attached shall remain in full force and effect as binding between the insured and the company. The insured agrees to reimburse the company for any payment made by the company on account of any accident, claim, or suit involving a breach of the terms of the policy, and for any payment that the company would not have been obligated to make under the provisions of the policy except for the agreement contained in this endorsement.

It is further understood and agreed that, upon failure of the company to pay any final judgment recovered against the insured as provided herein, the judgment creditor may maintain an action in any court of competent jurisdiction against the company to compel such payment.

The limits of the company's liability for the amounts prescribed in this endorsement apply separately to each accident and any payment under the policy because of anyone accident shall not operate to reduce the liability of the company for the payment of final judgments resulting from any other accident.

- C. The driver will notify Chemical Transportation Emergency Center (CHEMTREC) 800-424-9300
- D. The driver will notify the National Response Center and Director of the Office of Hazardous Materials Regulations, Materials Transportation Bureau, Department of Transportation, Washington, D.C. in the event of:
 - 1. A person is killed or requires hospitalization due to injuries.
 - 2. Carrier or property damage exceeds \$50,000.
 - 3. Accident/spill involves radioactive materials or etiological agents
 - 4. Notification caused by continuing danger of life Per 49CFR 171.15 800-424-8802
- E. Containment: The critical problem is to prevent the escape of any spilled liquid or solid into the ground or into a storm or sanitary sewer. A barrier must be erected immediately to prevent escape of spilled materials/waste liquids, using Andax Pac Emergency Spill absorbent pads, or diking the area surrounding the spill to restrict its mobility.

I. EMERGENCY REPORTING

A. In the event of an emergency or a hazardous waste spill during transportation, the transporter will immediately notify the Department of Environmental Resources and the National Response Center with the following information:

1. Name of the person reporting the incident.
2. Name, address, and identification number of the transporter.
3. Phone number where the person reporting the incident can be reached.
4. Date, time, and location of the incident.
5. Mode of transportation and type of transport vehicle.
6. A brief description of the incident, including the type of incident.
7. For each waste involved in a spill, the following information is necessary:
 - a. The name and identification number of the generator of the waste.
 - b. Shipping name, hazard class and U.N. number of the waste.
 - c. Estimated quantity of the material or waste spilled.
 - d. The extent of the contamination of land, water, or air.
8. Shipping name, hazard class and the U.N. number of any other material carried.

B. In the event of an emergency or a hazardous waste spill during transportation, the transporter will immediately notify the affected municipality of the occurrence and the nature of the spill, also, the local fire and police departments.

C. The generator of the hazardous waste will be notified.

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- D. The transporter will submit a report of the incident in writing to the Director, Office of Hazardous Material Registration, Materials Transportation Bureau, Department of Transportation, Washington, D.C. 20590, send a copy to the Department of Environmental Resources and send another copy of the report to the generator.

VII. EXTERNAL COMMUNICATIONS

A. The only means of communication the driver will have in the truck will be a citizen's band radio and/or cell phone.

VIII. ROUTINE DECONTAMINATION PROCEDURES

A. Will be performed by all waste disposal facilities. In the event of a minor spill, available data on the components of the container which has spilled will be reviewed. Upon determination of the material's constituents, a spill procedure cleanup, appropriate to the hazards of this material, will be implemented.

In the case of material contaminating wood or earth, the spill area will be removed or excavated and placed in the DOT 17-H containers. This container will be described, marked, labeled, and manifested for proper disposal at a secure chemical landfill. Other spill materials which can be washed will be collected in DOT certified containers and removed for appropriate waste water treatment at a permitted facility.

B. If leaking drums are identified, the driver will immediately proceed to the nearest off road impermeable surface, if possible, and post reflectors warning approaching traffic from each direction. Vermiculite and/or Speedy Dry will immediately be applied around the container to prevent the flow of liquid from reaching the soil or surface water. If possible leaking containers will be inverted or plugged. Any contamination in the trailer will be washed out or steam cleaned, and the reinstated containerized for appropriate disposal.

For any kind of a major or minor spill, the spill area will be contained with Andax Pac Emergency Spill absorbent pads and Andax Sorb-Sox or as best as possible, Diking

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procedures using these materials will be followed. One of our approved Emergency Response Contractors would be immediately called in to properly clean up and containerize the spill material appropriately into suitable containers for disposal.

IX.

A. The emergency coordinator will train and instruct all personnel in the following areas:

1. Operation of Plant Equipment
2. General Maintenance of All Equipment
3. Inspection and Reporting Procedures
4. Chemicals Used and Spill Control
5. Basic First Aid Course
6. Operation and Use of Self-Contained Breathing Apparatus
7. Contingency Plan Implementation
8. Response to Emergencies
9. Compliance with all applicable laws and regulations for hazardous waste facilities and transporters.

B. A refresher course will be given every six months to all personnel to ensure that they will be able to respond effectively in an emergency by familiarizing them with emergency procedures, emergency equipment, and the proper agencies and phone numbers to be called in the event of a spill or other emergency.

All drivers are given the latest Emergency Response Guide Book (DOT P58005) dated 1990 and are instructed to keep it in their vehicle at all times.

X. FOLLOW UP PROCEDURES:

A. Decontamination - A truck or trailer exposed to a spill or leak will be decontaminated at the site in order to prevent any further release to the extent that it can be transported to an authorized facility capable of further decontamination if necessary.

Equipment will be decontaminated in the following manner:

Each item used will be placed in an open head container and thoroughly rinsed with a compatible solvent or cleaning compound. The residue or wash water will then be drained into a tight head container, sealed, and disposed of properly in accordance with Federal and State Regulations at an authorized disposal site. Clothing that was contaminated will be appropriately packaged and transported to an authorized disposal facility in accordance with Federal and State Regulations.

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B. NOTIFICATIONS WILL BE MADE TO:

The Department of Transportation, Director of Hazardous Materials Registration, Materials, and Transportation Bureau, Washington, D.C. 20590 by written notice of the spill and nature of the incident. Also, if the spill occurs in the State of Alabama, the Alabama Department of Environmental Management, 1751 Cong. W.L. Dickinson Drive, Montgomery, Alabama 36130 will be sent a copy.

- D. Cleanup: Spilled material will be re-wetted and re-bagged for disposal by the contractor or cleanup contractor. After re-bagging the escaped material, the affected spill area will be wet cleaned and/or HEPA vacuumed and/or encapsulated as appropriate for the conditions.
- E. Vehicle Decontamination: If there were any broken bags, the cleanup contractor will decontaminate the vehicle.
- F. The company will notify the State Emergency Response Team by calling any one of the following numbers: 911, (302) 739-9401, 1-800-662-8802
- G. This plan will be carried in all vehicles, along with the permit.
