



DEFINITIONS AS USED IN THIS ENDORSEMENT

Accident includes continuous or repeated exposure to conditions or which results in bodily injury, property damage, or environmental damage which the insured neither expected nor intended.

Motor Vehicle means a land vehicle, machine, truck, tractor, trailer, or semitrailer propelled or drawn by mechanical power and used on a highway for transporting property, or any combination thereof.

Bodily Injury means injury to the body, sickness, or disease to any person, including death resulting from any of these.

Property Damage means damage to or loss of use of tangible property.

Environmental Restoration means restitution for the loss, damage, or destruction of natural resources arising out of the accidental discharge, dispersal, release or escape into or upon the land, atmosphere, watercourse, or body of water, of any commodity transported by a motor carrier. This shall include the cost of removal and the cost of necessary measures taken to minimize or mitigate damage to human health, the natural environment, fish, shellfish, and wildlife.

Public Liability means liability for bodily injury, property damage, and environmental restoration.

The insurance policy to which this endorsement is attached provides automobile liability insurance and is amended to assure compliance by the insured, within the limits stated herein, as a motor carrier of property, with Sections 29 and 30 of the Motor Carrier Act of 1980 and the rules and regulations of the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration (FMCSA).

In consideration of the premium stated in the policy to which this endorsement is attached, the insurer (the company) agrees to pay, within the limits of liability described herein, any final judgment recovered against the insured for public liability resulting from negligence in the operation, maintenance or use of motor vehicles subject to the financial responsibility requirements of Sections 29 and 30 of the Motor Carrier Act of 1980 regardless of whether or not each motor vehicle is specifically described in the policy and whether or not such negligence occurs on any route or in any territory authorized to be served by the insured or elsewhere. Such insurance as is afforded, for public liability, does not apply to injury to or death of the insured's employees while engaged in the course of their employment, or property transported by the insured, designated as cargo. It is understood and agreed that no condition, provision, stipulation, or limitation contained in the policy, this endorsement, or any other endorsement thereon,

or violation thereof, shall relieve the company from liability or from the payment of any final judgment, within the limits of liability herein described, irrespective of the financial condition, insolvency or bankruptcy of the insured. However, all terms, conditions, and limitations in the policy to which the endorsement is attached shall remain in full force and effect as binding between the insured and the company. The insured agrees to reimburse the company for any payment made by the company on account of any accident, claim, or suit involving a breach of the terms of the policy, and for any payment that the company would not have been obligated to make under the provisions of the policy except for the agreement contained in this endorsement.

It is further understood and agreed that, upon failure of the company to pay any final judgment recovered against the insured as provided herein, the judgment creditor may maintain an action in any court of competent jurisdiction against the company to compel such payment.

The limits of the company's liability for the amounts prescribed in this endorsement apply separately to each accident and any payment under the policy because of anyone accident shall not operate to reduce the liability of the company for the payment of final judgments resulting from any other accident.

1. Spill Control and Safety Equipment Carried in Each Vehicle

Each vehicle used to transport dry solid waste will carry the following equipment at all times:

1. Reflective warning triangles and/or road flares
2. Fire extinguisher (properly rated and maintained)
3. First aid kit
4. Heavy-duty work gloves
5. Hard hat
6. Safety vest (high visibility)
7. Flashlight
8. Broom, shovel, and basic hand tools
9. Absorbent materials (for incidental fuel, oil, or hydraulic fluid leaks)
10. Tarps or covers suitable for fully enclosing loads

2. Load Securement and Prevention of Accidental Discharge

- All loads will be **enclosed, covered, or securely tarped** prior to transport.
- Vehicles and containers will be inspected to ensure tailgates, doors, and fasteners are secure.
- Drivers will ensure no debris, dirt, or rocks can escape during transit.

3. Driver Pre-Trip Inspection Procedures

Before each trip, the driver will inspect:

1. Tires, brakes, lights, mirrors, and steering
2. Load securement equipment (tarps, straps, tailgates)
3. Condition of container or dump body
4. Presence and condition of spill control and safety equipment
5. Vehicle for signs of fluid leaks

Any deficiencies will be corrected **before** the vehicle is operated.

4. Emergency Spill or Accident Response

If an accident or incident occurs that results in a spill or release of material:

- The driver will immediately:
 - Secure the scene and ensure personal safety
 - Use warning devices to alert traffic
 - Contain the spilled material if it can be done safely

Driver Qualification and Experience

Bang Brothers Towing & Transport Inc. ensures that all drivers transporting solid waste are qualified, competent, and knowledgeable of applicable safety and environmental requirements.

The company currently operates as an owner-operator business.

- All drivers must possess a valid driver's license appropriate for the vehicle operated, including a **Commercial Driver's License (CDL)** when required by vehicle weight or configuration.
- Drivers must meet all **state and federal motor carrier safety requirements** applicable to their operations.
- Drivers are required to maintain a safe driving record and comply with all traffic and motor vehicle laws.

Training and Safety Procedures

(a) Licenses and Training

- Drivers receive instruction on:
 - Proper operation of dump trucks, roll-off trucks, and/or trailers
 - Safe loading, securing, tarping, and unloading of **dry waste** materials (construction and demolition debris, dirt, and rock)
- Any required CDL or endorsements are maintained in good standing.
- Refresher training is provided as needed and when regulations or operating conditions change.

Driver Record Monitoring and Discipline

(b) Driving Record Review

- Driver motor vehicle records (MVRs) are reviewed periodically to identify moving violations or unsafe driving patterns.
- Any violations are addressed through progressive corrective action, which may include counseling, retraining, or suspension of driving duties, depending on severity.

Waste Handling and Permit Compliance Training

(c) Driver Knowledge Requirements

Drivers are trained and instructed in the following:

(i) Proper Waste Handling Procedures

- Understanding the types of waste authorized for transport under the permit
- Ensuring loads are fully covered and secured to prevent spillage
- Transporting waste only to approved and permitted disposal or recycling facilities

(ii) Spill Control and Emergency Response

- Familiarity with the company's **Spill Control Plan**
- Proper use of spill control and safety equipment
- Immediate response procedures in the event of an accident or spill

(iii) Permit Conditions

- Familiarity with the conditions and limitations of the Delaware Solid Waste Transporter Permit
- Compliance with all DNREC reporting and notification requirements



IMPORTANT NOTICE

The Delaware Department of Natural Resources and Environmental Control (DNREC) Compliance and Permitting Section (CAPS) is dedicated to overseeing the waste transportation permit process. We carefully receive, review, and provide comments regarding submitted permit applications, requiring a complete application prior to public notice. It is important for transporters submitting applications to DNREC-CAPS to understand that all permit applications will now be publicly accessible during the required 15-day public notice period and are also subject to release under DNREC's Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) afterward.

To improve transparency, DNREC now publishes legal notices on its website that include the names of transporters applying for permits, along with convenient links to the original permit applications. This approach is designed to promote open communication and build public trust.

Before releasing each permit application, DNREC-CAPS ensures that all personally identifiable information (PII)—such as driver names, birthdates, and Social Security numbers—is properly redacted.

Transporters who wish to keep other certain information in their permit applications confidential—excluding personally identifiable information (PII) which is being redacted—must explicitly request confidentiality when they submit their original application. This request must comply with DNREC's Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) regulations. For detailed policies and procedures regarding confidentiality requests, refer to 8 DE Admin. Code § 900, titled *Policies and Procedures Regarding FOIA Requests*.

Please note that any request to hold specific information as confidential must be made in writing at the time you submit your original waste transporter application to DNREC-CAPS. Your request must include a justification for why the information should be kept confidential, as required by Subsections 6.2.1 through 6.2.4 of the *Policies and Procedures Regarding FOIA Requests*.

Additionally, if you are making a confidentiality claim, you are required to submit two applications: the original waste transporter permit application and a second version of the original application that redacts the information you wish to keep confidential.
