

The Delaware Department of Natural Resources and Environmental Control (DNREC) Compliance and Permitting Section (CAPS) is dedicated to overseeing the waste transportation permit process. We carefully receive, review, and provide comments regarding submitted permit applications, requiring a complete application prior to public notice. It is important for transporters submitting applications to DNREC-CAPS to understand that all permit applications will now be publicly accessible during the required 15-day public notice period and are also subject to release under DNREC's Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) afterward.

To improve transparency, DNREC now publishes legal notices on its website that include the names of transporters applying for permits, along with convenient links to the original permit applications. This approach is designed to promote open communication and build public trust.

Spill Control & Safety Plan

Diamond State Junk Removal, LLC
For Company Truck Drivers

Purpose

This Spill Control & Safety Plan outlines procedures to protect drivers, the public, and the environment during trucking operations conducted by **Diamond State Junk Removal, LLC**. Although the materials transported present minimal risk, this plan is maintained to ensure safe, responsible, and compliant operations at all times.

1. Materials Transported

Diamond State Junk Removal, LLC does not transport hazardous waste, hazardous materials, or liquid products.

Materials transported are limited to:

- **Empty or fully dried paint cans**
- Non-liquid, non-hazardous debris

All materials are considered **non-hazardous** and present a **low risk of spills**.

2. Transportation Method

All materials are transported **inside a fully enclosed box truck**.

- Loads are **fully contained** within the cargo area
- No materials are transported loose or exposed
- The enclosed truck body prevents materials from contacting the roadway, soil, or stormwater
- Cargo doors remain closed and secured during transport

This containment method greatly reduces the likelihood of any spill or environmental release.

3. Equipment Carried on Vehicles

Each box truck operated by **Diamond State Junk Removal, LLC** is equipped with basic spill response and safety supplies as a precaution, including:

- Absorbent pads
- Spill containment bags
- Protective gloves
- Small shovel
- Basic personal protective equipment (PPE)

4. Spill Prevention

Spill prevention is achieved through proper containment, inspection, and secure transport.

Drivers must:

- Confirm all paint cans are **empty and fully dried** prior to loading
- Secure all materials to prevent shifting during transit
- Perform daily pre-trip inspections of the cargo area
- Report any damaged containers or concerns before leaving the yard

5. Actions in the Event of a Spill

Spills are unlikely due to enclosed containment; however, if residue or material is released, drivers must:

- Stop work immediately and ensure personal safety
- Keep clear of traffic and hazards
- Use absorbent materials to contain any residue
- Prevent material from entering storm drains or soil
- Collect waste using gloves and shovel
- Place all waste into spill containment bags
- Document the incident with photos and notes

6. Reporting

The driver must notify the company owner or designated supervisor as soon as possible and provide:

- Description of material involved
- Approximate amount
- Location of the incident
- Actions taken

If necessary, appropriate Delaware emergency or environmental authorities will be contacted by the company.

7. Cleanup and Disposal

All cleanup will be conducted safely and disposed of in accordance with Delaware regulations for **non-hazardous, dried paint waste**.

8. Driver Responsibility

Drivers for **Diamond State Junk Removal, LLC** are responsible for:

- Following this plan at all times
- Maintaining proper containment
- Reporting any issues immediately
- Protecting themselves, the public, and the environment.

Driver Training and Safety Program

Owner-Operator (Single Driver) – Class B CDL

Purpose

The purpose of this Driver Training and Safety Program is to ensure that all company driving operations are conducted safely, professionally, and in compliance with all applicable federal and state regulations. Although the company operates as a single-driver owner-operator business, the same safety standards, training expectations, and accountability measures apply as they would in a multi-driver organization.

Driver Qualification

The company owner is the sole driver and holds a valid **Delaware Class B Commercial Driver's License (CDL)**. The driver meets all medical, licensing, and qualification requirements required by the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Regulations (FMCSR) and the State of Delaware. Copies of the CDL, medical certificate, and driving record are maintained and reviewed regularly.

Initial and Ongoing Training

As both owner and driver, the company ensures competency through continuous self-training and compliance monitoring. Training includes, but is not limited to:

- Federal Motor Carrier Safety Regulations (FMCSR) awareness and compliance
- Vehicle inspection, repair, and maintenance procedures
- Defensive driving techniques
- Safe operation of Class B commercial vehicles
- Hours of Service (HOS) compliance
- Cargo securement (when applicable)
- Accident and incident reporting procedures
- Hazard recognition and risk avoidance

The driver remains current on regulatory updates and industry best practices through self-study, online resources, and periodic review of safety materials.

Vehicle Operation and Safety Procedures

The driver follows all safe-driving practices at all times, including:

- Conducting **pre-trip and post-trip vehicle inspections** before and after each operating day

- Operating the vehicle in accordance with posted speed limits, road conditions, and weather conditions
- Avoiding distracted driving, including the use of handheld electronic devices while driving
- Maintaining proper following distance and situational awareness
- Immediately removing the vehicle from service if any unsafe condition is identified

All vehicle maintenance and inspection records are documented and retained.

Monitoring and Self-Evaluation

As an owner-operator, the driver is responsible for continuous self-evaluation. This includes:

- Reviewing driving performance and safety practices
- Monitoring compliance with Hours of Service regulations
- Reviewing any roadside inspections or enforcement interactions

- A fully stocked **first aid kit**
- **Flashlights** for use during low-visibility or nighttime conditions

All safety equipment is inspected regularly as part of routine vehicle inspections to confirm proper condition, accessibility, and readiness for use. Any missing or defective equipment is replaced immediately before the vehicle is operated.

Commitment to Safety

Safety is the highest priority of the company. Even as a single-driver operation, the company is committed to maintaining the same standards of professionalism, accountability, and compliance expected of larger carriers. The driver acknowledges responsibility for protecting the public, the vehicle, and the cargo at all times.



4. Spill Prevention

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Drivers must:

- Perform daily pre-trip inspections of the cargo area
- Report any damaged containers or concerns before leaving the yard

5. Actions in the Event of a Spill

Spills are unlikely due to enclosed containment; however, if residue or material is released, drivers must:

- Stop work immediately and ensure personal safety
