



OVERVIEW

Walker Construction Inc. ensures that all company drivers are safe, qualified, and competent to transport solid waste through licensing requirements, structured training, weekly safety meetings, and periodic monitoring of driving records.

(a) Licensing & Training Requirements

- All drivers must maintain a valid Commercial Driver's License (CDL) appropriate for the class of vehicle operated.
- Drivers must maintain a current DOT Medical Certificate as required for intrastate commercial operation.

Initial Training Includes:

- Company safety orientation upon hire
- Review of DNREC Solid Waste Transporter Permit conditions
- Spill Control Plan training
- Proper load securement and tarping procedures
- Defensive driving practices
- Equipment operation and pre-trip/post-trip inspection procedures

Ongoing Company Programs:

- Weekly safety meetings covering safe driving practices, accident prevention, equipment inspection, and regulatory updates
- Annual safety refresher training
- Review of any incident reports and corrective action procedures

(b) Driver Record Monitoring & Progressive Discipline Policy

- Motor Vehicle Records (MVRs) are checked at minimum annually for all drivers.
- Additional MVR checks are conducted upon hire and as required by insurance carrier guidelines.
- Records are reviewed for moving violations, point accumulation, suspensions, revocations, DUI/DWI offenses, and serious traffic violations.

Progressive Counseling/Discipline Based on Points or Violations:

- Verbal counseling for minor violations or low point accumulation.
- Written warning for repeated violations or moderate point levels.
- Probation, suspension from driving duties, or remedial training for serious violations or excessive point accumulation.
- Immediate suspension or termination for major safety violations, loss of CDL, DUI/DWI, or reckless driving offenses.

Drivers who exceed acceptable point thresholds or pose a safety risk may be removed from driving duties pending review.

(c) Driver Instruction Procedures

(i) Knowledge of Proper Handling of Solid Waste

Drivers are trained in the proper handling, loading, securing, and covering of solid waste materials transported by Walker Construction Inc., including construction and demolition debris and other approved solid waste types.

Training emphasizes prevention of leakage, spillage, or discharge during transport and compliance with all applicable DNREC regulations and state laws.

(ii) Spill Control Plan (Accidental Discharge Containment Plan)

Drivers are trained on the company's approved Spill Control Plan and are required to carry spill response materials in each truck.

Training includes emergency response procedures, containment methods, notification requirements, and proper cleanup procedures in the event of accidental discharge.

(iii) Familiarity with Solid Waste Transporter Permit Conditions

Drivers are instructed on and required to comply with the conditions of the DNREC Solid Waste Transporter Permit.

This includes approved waste types, authorized disposal facilities, reporting requirements, operational limitations, and compliance obligations.

Drivers acknowledge understanding of permit requirements as part of company onboarding and safety training.
