Driver Training and Safety Procedures

All LaRue, LLC drivers are required to have a current Class-A CDL, DOT Physical Medical Card and must pass a drug test and background check prior to driving. All background checks are conducted in conformity with the Federal Fair Credit Reporting Act, the Americans with Disabilities Act, and state and federal privacy and antidiscrimination laws. Reports are kept confidential and are only viewed by individuals involved in the hiring process. Drivers are subject to random drug tests throughout the year through a consortium and are also enrolled in the US DOT FMCSA Drug and Alcohol Clearinghouse. Driving records for each driver are pulled annually. Drivers use electronic driver logs in compliance with federal laws. The company conducts monthly safety meetings.

Progressive Discipline Policy

Every employee has the duty and the responsibility to be aware of, and abide by, existing rules and policies. Employees also have the responsibility to perform his/her duties to the best of his/her ability and to the standards set forth in their job description or as otherwise established.

Our progressive discipline policy and procedures are designed to provide a structured corrective action process to improve and prevent a recurrence of undesirable employee behavior and performance issues. It has been designed consistent with our organizational values, best practices and employment laws.

Violations of work rules may be cause for disciplinary action and/or termination of employment.

Disciplinary action consists of:

Counseling and Verbal warning: Employee is verbally counseled and a written record of the discussion is placed in the manager's file for future reference on the standard counseling form. The supervisor is expected to clearly describe expectations and steps the employee must take to improve performance or resolve the problem.

Written warning: Written warnings are used for behavior or violations that a supervisor considers serious or in situations when a verbal warning has not helped change acceptable behavior. Written warnings are placed in an employee's employment file.

Termination Written Warning: Termination warnings are a final notification and opportunity for the employee to change the inappropriate behavior. If immediate and sustained corrective action is not taken, the next steps in the process would be termination.

Suspension: There may be performance, conduct or safety incidents that the most effective action may be the temporary removal of the employee from the workplace.

Termination: The last and more serious step in the progressive discipline procedure is to terminate employment. Our goal will be to try to exercise the progressive nature of this policy before proceeding to termination. We reserve the right to combine and skip steps depending on the circumstances of each situation and the nature of the offense. Employees may be terminated without prior notice or disciplinary action.

An employee should meet with management to discuss ways to improve performance and avoid subsequent violations. Management reserves the right to reduce and/or omit one or more disciplinary steps, or to terminate an employee immediately. Management also reserves the right to issue multiple verbal or written warnings given individual circumstances.

LaRue drivers are trained by one of our driver trainers. They are instructed in the use of our equipment as it pertains to the loading and unloading of the material we transport (wooden utility poles) especially in regards to our waste transporter's permit(s). They receive a full overview of the tools, equipment, PPE, and spill kit carried on each truck as well as safety procedures for the use thereof. They also receive a copy of the "Spill Control Plan".

CONSENT ASSESSMENT OF CIVIL PENALTY

This Consent Assessment of Civil Penalty ("CACP") is entered into this 27th day of October, 2022, by and between the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, Department of Environmental Protection (hereinafter "Department") and Larue, LLC. (hereinafter "Larue").

The Department has found and determined the following:

A. The Department is the agency with the duty and authority to administer and enforce the Solid Waste Management Act, the Act of July 7, 1980, P.L. 380, as amended, 35 P.S. § 6018.101 et seq. (hereinafter "SWMA"), the Municipal Waste Planning, Recycling and Waste Reduction Act, Act of July 28, 1988, P.L. 556, as amended, 53 P.S. § 4000.101, et seq. (hereinafter "Act 101"), the Waste Transportation Safety Act, the Act of June 29, 2002, P.L. 596, No. 90, 27 Pa.C.S. §§ 6201-6209 (hereinafter "Act 90") and the rules and regulations promulgated thereunder.

B. Larue is a transporter under the Waste Transportation Safety Act (Act 90) with the Act 90 Waste Hauler ID number WH15546. Transporter is defined under Section 6202 of Act 90, 27 Pa. C.S. § 6202, as the owner of a public or private waste transportation vehicle. An individual driving a waste transportation vehicle who is not the owner is not a transporter.

C. Pursuant to Section 103 of the SWMA, 35 P.S. § 6018.103, Larue is also defined as a Person. Larue has a mailing address of 2563 Valley View Rd., Morgantown, PA 19543.

D. A Motor Carrier Vehicle is defined in the Pennsylvania Vehicle Code at 75 Pa. C.S. § 102. Under that definition, a Motor Carrier Vehicle is a truck, truck tractor or combination having a gross weight or registered gross weight in excess of 17,000 pounds. Under the Waste Transportation Safety Act at 27 Pa. C.S. § 6202, the terms "truck," "truck tractor" and "combination" refer to vehicles used to transport municipal or residual waste.

E. Section 6202 of Act 90, 27 Pa. C.S. § 6202, defines "Waste Transportation Vehicle" as "Public and private motor carrier vehicles and waste trailers, as defined in this chapter, regularly used in transporting municipal or residual waste to a processing or disposal facility in this Commonwealth. The term does not include vehicles currently registered by the [D]epartment pursuant to 25 Pa. Code § 285.255 (relating to transportation of residential septage)."

F. On September 27, 2022, a Department representative conducted an inspection of a Waste Transportation Vehicle ("Vehicle") in Wayne Township, Clinton County. The Vehicle was hauling residual waste at the time of the inspection. The Vehicle was:

1. Identified as a Tractor Trailer
2. Operated by Larue
3. The Truck had a license plate number of AG30384, VIN was 1XPCD40X0MD748489, Act 90 Waste Hauler ID number was WH15546.
4. The Trailer had a license plate number of PT0213S, VIN was 1R1D03823SJ095660, Act 90 Waste Hauler ID number was WH15546

G. The following was observed with regard to the vehicle identified in Paragraph F, above, during the September 27, 2022 inspection:

1. The Vehicle was transporting residual waste and the driver could not provide a written PPC plan.
2. The Vehicle was not labeled to identify the type of waste being transported.
3. The Vehicle was found to be overweight. The weight of the Vehicle was recorded at 81,380 pounds.

H. Section 299.216(d) of the Residual Waste Regulations, 25 Pa. Code §299.216(d), states: "A person or municipality that transports residual waste shall have a contingency plan to minimize and abate a discharge of residual waste during transportation. A copy of the plan shall be kept in the cab of each transportation vehicle."

I. Section 299.220(2) of the Residual Waste Regulations, 25 Pa. Code § 299.220(2), states: "A vehicle or conveyance that is ordinarily or primarily used for the transportation of solid waste shall bear a sign that meets the following:

- (2) The sign shall include the specific type of solid waste transported by the vehicle or conveyance.
 - (i) Infectious or chemotherapeutic waste shall be designated: Infectious/Chemotherapeutic Waste.
 - (ii) Other municipal waste shall be designated: Municipal Waste."
 - (iii) Residual waste shall be designated: Residual Waste.
 - (iv) Mixed municipal and residual waste shall be designated: Municipal/Residual Waste."

J. Title 75 of the Pennsylvania Vehicle Code Section 4941 states:

"(a) General rule. No vehicle shall, when operated upon a highway, have a gross weight exceeding 73,280 pounds, and no combination driven upon a highway shall have a gross weight exceeding 80,000 pounds, or the applicable weight set forth in subsection (b) or (c), whichever is less.

(b) Combination of vehicles. No combination shall, when operated upon a highway, have a gross weight exceeding the following:

Combination of Vehicles	Maximum Gross Weight In Pounds
Two-axle truck tractor & single-axle semitrailer	58,400
Two-axle truck tractor & two-axle semitrailer	73,280
Three-axle truck tractor & single-axle semitrailer	73,280

Two-axle truck & two-axle trailer 73,280

(c) Motor Vehicles.--No motor vehicle when operated upon a highway shall have a gross weight exceeding the following:

Maximum Gross Weight In Pounds	
Two-axle motor vehicle	38,000
Three-axle motor vehicle	58,400
Four-axle motor vehicle	73,280"

K. The observations noted in Paragraph G, above, constitute violations of the following:

1. Section 299.216(d) of the Residual Waste Regulations, 25 Pa. Code §299.216(d), for failing to provide a contingency plan in the cab of the vehicle while transporting residual waste.
2. Section 299.220(2) of the Residual Waste Regulations, 25 Pa. Code § 299.220(2), for not having a sign to identify the type of waste being transported.
3. Section 610(6) of the SWMA, 35 P.S. § 6018.610(6), for transporting solid waste in such a manner as to adversely affect or endanger the public health, safety and welfare.

L. As a result of the violations found during the September 27, 2022 inspection, the Department issued a Field Notice of Violation dated September 27, 2022 to the vehicle operated by Larue.

M. The violations described in Paragraph K, above, constitute unlawful conduct under Sections 610(4) and 610(6) of the SWMA, 35 P.S. § 6018.610(4) and § 6018.610(6), and adversely affects or endangers the public health, safety and welfare.

N. The violations described in the Paragraph M, above, subject Larue to a claim for civil penalties under Section 605 of the SWMA, 35 P.S. § 6018.605.

O. The Department has the power and authority to assess civil penalties for each and every violation of the SWMA and the Rules and Regulations promulgated thereunder, to a maximum amount of TWENTY-FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$25,000.00) per violation per day pursuant to Section 605 of the SWMA, 35 P.S. § 6018.605.

After full and complete negotiation of all matters set forth in this CACP and upon mutual exchange of the covenants herein, the parties desiring to avoid litigation and intending to be legally bound, it is hereby ASSESSED by the Department and AGREED to by Larue as follows:

1. **Assessment.** In resolution of the Department's claim for civil penalties, which the Department is authorized to pursue under Section 605 of the SWMA, 35 P.S. § 6018.605; the Department hereby assesses a civil penalty of TWO THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$2,000.00), which Larue hereby agrees to pay.

2. **Civil Penalty Settlement.** Upon signing the CACP, Larue shall pay the civil penalty assessed in paragraph 1. This payment is in satisfaction of the Department's claim for civil penalties for the violations set forth in paragraph M, above. The payment shall be made by

3. Findings.

(a) Larue agrees that the findings in Paragraphs A through O are true and correct. In any matter or proceeding involving Larue and the Department, Larue shall not challenge the accuracy or validity of these findings.

(b) The parties do not authorize any other persons to use the findings in this CACP in any matter or proceeding.

4. Remedies. In the event Larue fails to make any payment required by this CACP, all remaining payments shall be immediately due and payable. In that event, the Department may pursue any remedy available for failure to pay a civil penalty, including an action for breach of contract or the filing of this CACP as a lien in any county in this Commonwealth.

5. Reservation of Rights. The Department reserves all other rights with respect to any matter addressed by this CACP, including the right to require abatement of any conditions resulting from the events described in the Findings. Larue reserves the right to challenge any action, which the Department may take, but waives the right to challenge the content or validity of this CACP.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the parties have caused this CACP to be executed by their duly authorized representatives. The undersigned representatives of Larue certify, under penalty of law, as provided by 18 Pa. C. S. §4904, that they are authorized to execute this CACP on behalf of Larue, that Larue consents to the entry of this CACP as an ASSESSMENT of the Department; that Larue hereby knowingly waives any right to a hearing under the statutes referenced in this CACP; and that Larue knowingly waives its right to appeal this CACP, which rights may be available under Section 4 of the Environmental Hearing Board Act, the Act of July 13, 1988, P.L. 530, No. 1988-94, 35 P.S. §7514; the Administrative Agency Law, 2 Pa. C.S. §103(a) and Chapters 5A and 7A; or any other provision of law. Signature by the attorney for Larue certifies only that the agreement has been signed after consulting with counsel.

DEFINITIONS AS USED IN THIS ENDORSEMENT

Accident includes continuous or repeated exposure to conditions or which results in bodily injury, property damage, or environmental damage which the insured neither expected nor intended.

Motor Vehicle means a land vehicle, machine, truck, tractor, trailer, or semitrailer propelled or drawn by mechanical power and used on a highway for transporting property, or any combination thereof.

Bodily Injury means injury to the body, sickness, or disease to any person, including death resulting from any of these.

Property Damage means damage to or loss of use of tangible property.

The insurance policy to which this endorsement is attached provides automobile liability insurance and is amended to assure compliance by the insured, within the limits stated herein, as a motor carrier of property, with Sections 29 and 30 of the Motor Carrier Act of 1980 and the rules and regulations of the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration (FMCSA).

In consideration of the premium stated in the policy to which this endorsement is attached, the insurer (the company) agrees to pay, within the limits of liability described herein, any final judgment recovered against the insured for public liability resulting from negligence in the operation, maintenance or use of motor vehicles subject to the financial responsibility requirements of Sections 29 and 30 of the Motor Carrier Act of 1980 regardless of whether or not each motor vehicle is specifically described in the policy and whether or not such negligence occurs on any route or in any territory authorized to be served by the insured or elsewhere. Such insurance as is afforded, for public liability, does not apply to injury to or death of the insured's employees while engaged in the course of their employment, or property transported by the insured, designated as cargo. It is understood and agreed that no condition, provision, stipulation, or limitation contained in the policy, this endorsement, or any other endorsement thereon,

Environmental Restoration means restitution for the loss, damage, or destruction of natural resources arising out of the accidental discharge, dispersal, release or escape into or upon the land, atmosphere, watercourse, or body of water, of any commodity transported by a motor carrier. This shall include the cost of removal and the cost of necessary measures taken to minimize or mitigate damage to human health, the natural environment, fish, shellfish, and wildlife.

Public Liability means liability for bodily injury, property damage, and environmental restoration.

or violation thereof, shall relieve the company from liability or from the payment of any final judgment, within the limits of liability herein described, irrespective of the financial condition, insolvency or bankruptcy of the insured. However, all terms, conditions, and limitations in the policy to which the endorsement is attached shall remain in full force and effect as binding between the insured and the company. The insured agrees to reimburse the company for any payment made by the company on account of any accident, claim, or suit involving a breach of the terms of the policy, and for any payment that the company would not have been obligated to make under the provisions of the policy except for the agreement contained in this endorsement.

It is further understood and agreed that, upon failure of the company to pay any final judgment recovered against the insured as provided herein, the judgment creditor may maintain an action in any court of competent jurisdiction against the company to compel such payment.

The limits of the company's liability for the amounts prescribed in this endorsement apply separately to each accident and any payment under the policy because of anyone accident shall not operate to reduce the liability of the company for the payment of final judgments resulting from any other accident.
