

ATTACHMENT D: Spill Plan

Section 1: Spill Control & Safety Equipment Carried in each vehicle

1. A set of 3 DOT approved reflective triangles
2. Fire extinguisher
3. First aid kit
4. Heavy duty rubber gloves
5. Hard hat
6. Reflective Vest
7. Flashlight

Section 2: Loading and emptying procedures to prevent accidental discharge of waste during transport to the disposal facility

1. Contents of the container shall never be removed from said container unless at the proper dumping location within an approved state facility.
2. Prior to loading the container on the truck verify the tailgate is closed, the locking mechanism is engaged and the secondary safety chain is configured in such a way to prevent the tailgate from opening.
3. Prior to loading the container on the truck visually check the overhead area for obstructions or utilities/wires which may be damaged or interfere with the loading of the container.
4. After the tailgate and overhead check area is completed, hook the container and load the container on the truck.
5. After the container is loaded on the truck, tarp the container and verify that the tarp is secured around the perimeter of the container to prevent the traveling wind from dislodging the container's contents accidentally.
6. The uncovering of the load shall not be conducted until the approved state disposal facility has been entered, the weighing in operations at the facility have been completed and the vehicle has reached a safe location to perform the uncovering operation.

Section 3: Driver performed pre-trip inspections

1. The driver shall perform all necessary department of transportation inspection necessary including all lights, tires, frame, engine components, braking system, steering system, windshield wipers, etc.
2. The driver shall verify that all spill control and safety equipment listed above is in the vehicle.
3. The driver shall inspect all hoisting components to verify there are no defects that may cause the containers to load violently causing spillage of the container's contents.

Section 4: In the event of a spill

1. The driver shall call the designated company coordinator: Jason Ewing at 410-924-5619
2. The driver if uninjured shall to the best of his or her ability prevent further spread of the contents of the container.
3. The designated company coordinator shall then contact 911 and the Delaware Department of Natural Resources and Environment Control at 302-739-9401 or 1-800-662-8802

Section 5: Required information to be always carried in vehicle

1. All necessary department of transportation and insurance information.
2. A copy of this spill control plan.
3. A copy of the current Solid Waste Transporter Permit.

ATTACHMENT E: Driver Training Program

Section 1: Driver pre-qualifications prior to employment

1. Must possess a CDL license.
2. Must have an air brake endorsement on their CDL license.
3. Must have an approved DOT physical.
4. Must demonstrate the ability to maneuver the vehicle safely and confidently around obstacles set up at our facility.
5. Must be capable of climbing the containers to verify contents and proper load level.
6. Must demonstrate safe driving abilities in a road test conducted by an approved company administrator.

Section 2: Driver training

1. Mandatory company safety meeting held every Monday morning at 6:30am covering a variety of topics including safe driving practices, lifting, load securing, spill containment, safety program review, etc.
2. Monthly ride along reviews will be conducted by an approved company administrator for the purpose of verifying safe driving abilities.
3. Monthly pre-trip inspection reviews will be conducted by an approved company administrator for the purpose of verifying proper walk around inspection of the vehicles operated.
4. Upon employment and yearly there after instruction about the following handling of waste being transported shall be performed.
 - a. All contents: Driver shall prior to loading of the container verify no liquid substances are in the container, if liquid substances appear to be present contact the designated company coordinator listed on the Spill Control Plan whom will verify the liquid with the loader of the container and if necessary with the Delaware Department of Natural Resources and Environment Control to verify acceptance of, the approval to transport and the nature of its disposal.
 - b. Construction debris, residential waste, commercial waste, industrial waste, dry waste: Driver shall prior to loading while wearing the appropriate personal protection equipment including gloves, reflective vest, hard hat and safety glasses, rearrange the load to ensure it is below the top of the can and so that after the coverage of the load is complete the potential for spillage is not possible.
5. Upon employment and yearly there after review of the Spill Control Plan and the Solid Waste Transporter Permit, to ensure proper interpretation and understand is to be conducted.

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Section 3: Driver violation assessment

1. The company yearly obtains a copy of each drivers record to ascertain if any moving violations have occurred in that period.
2. If a driver obtains more than 3 points in that period of time they will be required by the company to complete and independent driving safety course.
3. If a driver obtains more than 5 points in that period of time, they will be removed of driving duties and possibly terminated if other positions within the company are not available.
