

SPILL CONTROL PLAN

SPILL CONTROL EQUIPMENT

Reflectors, Fire Extinguisher, first aid kit, Heavy Duty Gloves, Hard Hat, Flashlight, Safety Glasses Broom and shovel.

Spill Prevention

The following are general requirements for any Solid Waste hauled.

General Requirements

- The driver shall perform pre and post trip inspection of vehicle and safety equipment.
- Ensure a copy of the Manifest for all Solid Waste being hauled is in driver's possession.
- All loads will be enclosed and tarped to prevent accidental discharge of waste during transport.
- Ensure prior to leaving pickup site that tailgate is secured and not leaking or will allow spillage while transporting.
- Ensure the load of Solid Waste is tarped.
- Routine/Daily checks of dump body condition prior to loading.

Spill Containment and Corrective Action

Assess the size of the leak and any immediate threat of the spill reaching storm drains or surface water. If there is an immediate threat and there are no safety concerns, then attempt to clean up and block the spill from coming in contact with reaching storm drains or surface water. The driver is to stop the source of the spill immediately, contain any spilled material and clean up the spill in a timely manner to prevent accidental contamination.

Emergency Procedures

- If a spill has occurred, contact the following persons immediately:
William E. Bishop a (Primary)
Shirley Bishop (Secondary)

Spill Reporting

The primary or secondary emergency contact shall contact the state and municipal authorities where accident occurred. If the accident or spill has the potential to cause environmental damage either due to the nature of the waste, location of the accident, or additional factors such as leaking oil, gasoline, or hydraulic fluid the person contacted will notify the state emergency response team by calling one of the following numbers: Immediately call **911** in the event of injury, fire or potential fire, or spill has caused contamination that gives rise to an emergency situation.

Fleet Safety Rules and Guidelines

WEB Construction Inc

1. No employee is permitted to make repairs of any kind on any vehicle, electrical device or equipment unless authorized to do so by William E. Bishop (Ed), President/Mechanic 302-437-4103. **Electrical equipment is not to be tampered with in any way. Violation of this rule can result in serious injury or death. Under no circumstance is the driver to open the cap to the anti-freeze reservoir if the truck has overheated or motor is HOT. Severe burns and injury will occur.**
2. WEB Construction Inc complies with all DOT and FMCSA laws and regulations including compliance with FMCSA "Driver Qualification File" and annual limited inquiry of drivers FMCSA Drug and Alcohol Clearing House eligibility. Anyone who operates a licensed vehicle owned or controlled by WEB Construction Inc must maintain a current CDL and comply with all FMCSA /or State regulations. Driver will provide Annual Violations certification and Driving record report from DMV. Driver shall provide current Medical Exam Certificate. Driver shall have no more than 2 points on driving record. If driver is found to have more than 2 points the driver may be terminated.
3. Transportation of non-employee passengers is prohibited. Use of company vehicles by non-employees or unqualified employees is prohibited, unless permission has been given by an authorized official of the company.
4. All drivers are required to inspect their vehicle at the beginning of each work day. A vehicle check list will be provided to all drivers in the form of "Driver's Vehicle Inspection Report" Booklet. Vehicles must be kept clean.
5. All drivers are required to check the following, before every shift and report any defects to your supervisor and or Ed Bishop:
 - Oil and fluid levels add if need and let Jim know what was added for billing purposes;
 - Leaks
 - Worn Belts
 - Tire air pressure and wear;
 - All Lights
 - Gauges to ensure they are working properly
 - Suspension for crakes and worn parts
 - Safety Equipment
6. All drivers are required to check the following, at the end every shift and report any defects to your supervisor and or Ed Bishop:
 - Trucks are to be filled with fuel
 - While fueling check the tires, lights and look for leaks under the truck
7. Obey all traffic laws. All fines are the responsibility of the driver. Traffic citations are to be reported to your supervisor in writing. Repeated violations are cause for disciplinary action, which may include suspension and/or dismissal.
8. Seat belts will be worn by all occupants, at all times.

9. Unattended vehicles shall have the keys removed, brakes set, windows rolled up and the doors locked.
10. Consumption of alcohol or non-prescribed drugs is grounds for immediate dismissal whether reporting for work or while on the job. If anyone is taking prescribed medication which may affect their ability to perform their duties safely, they must notify their supervisor when reporting to work.
11. All incidents involving damage to company property, property of others, personal injury of employee or to others must be reported immediately to William E. Bishop (Ed), President and or Shirley Bishop, Safety Director. Failure to report any injury or accident involving a company vehicle is grounds for termination.
12. No radar equipment will be permitted in any company vehicle.
13. Courtesy should be extended to other motorists. The vehicle and you are a rolling billboard for your company.
14. All drivers should use good Defensive Driving Techniques while operating company vehicles.
15. Compressed air should never be used for cleaning clothes, cooling or practical jokes. **Violation of this rule can result in serious injury or death.**
16. Horseplay, such as scuffling, practical jokes, or throwing articles at each other will not be tolerated.
17. Follow the established safe job procedures and Solid Waiste Spill Control Plan. You are to perform only those jobs you have been assigned and properly instructed to perform.
18. Wear the protective equipment required for your job as established by the job foreman. It is your responsibility to see that protective equipment should be in good repair. Damaged equipment should be reported to your supervisor immediately. While on job site out of truck, drivers are to wear boots, long pants (you may wear shorts but put on long pants over them on job site), safety vest and hard hat. Drivers are to have a pair of gloves.
19. Report unsafe acts or unsafe conditions to your supervisor without delay.
20. Report all accidents to your supervisor immediately whether anyone is hurt or not. In cases of injury, get first aid as soon as possible.
21. All vehicles shall be equipped with an appropriate fire extinguisher and a first aid kit and Solid Waste Spill Control Plan. Drivers are responsible for all safety equipment and shall report any missing or damaged equipment immediately to your supervisor.
22. Drivers are to follow Spill Control Plan that you have been trained on and found in your trucks 3 ring binder. Failure to follow the plan will result in disciplinary action and or termination.
