**The start and end dates (if applicable) for the operations, as given on the Notification, are: December 15, 2023 – Continuous.**

Please note that this activity is exempt from the NJDEP Solid Waste approval process; however, all local municipal and county approvals, permits, ordinances, and other applicable state permitting requirements must be fully complied with in order for this Exemption to remain valid. This would include, but is not limited to, the following: local site plan approval, zoning restrictions, soil conservation district approvals, wetland permits/setback requirements, floodplain restrictions, etc.

Please be aware of the following, if your facility has been granted an exemption #5:

If the recycling center that is the subject of this acknowledgement exceeds the **5,000** scrap tire reception **limitation per month, or at any given time**, this exemption will be subject to violation. As such, the corresponding enforcement personnel will conduct an investigation into said facility's practice; then, they shall assess and devise the corresponding steps to resolve the issues. If the steps are not heeded, penalties may follow-suit until the problems are rectified.

## Scrap Tire Hauling

### Spill Control and Safety Manual

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#### 1. Purpose

The purpose of this manual is to establish procedures for the **safe handling, transportation, and emergency response** related to the hauling of scrap tires. These procedures are designed to protect employees, the public, and the environment from hazards associated with scrap tire transportation.

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#### 2. Scope

This manual applies to:

- All company drivers
  - Transportation contractors
  - Employees involved in loading or unloading scrap tires
  - Maintenance personnel
  - Supervisors and safety personnel
- 

#### 3. Responsibilities

##### Management

Management is responsible for:

- Providing proper training to drivers and employees
- Ensuring vehicles and trailers meet DOT safety standards
- Providing proper spill response equipment

- Ensuring compliance with federal, state, and local regulations

## **Drivers**

Drivers must:

- Inspect vehicles before and after trips
- Ensure loads are properly secured
- Report spills, accidents, or unsafe conditions immediately
- Follow all safety procedures outlined in this manual

## **Safety Officer**

The Safety Officer is responsible for:

- Conducting safety training
- Reviewing incidents and accidents
- Ensuring emergency procedures are followed
- Maintaining compliance documentation

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## **4. Hazards Associated with Scrap Tire Transport**

Potential hazards include:

- Falling or spilled tires from trailers
- Road accidents involving tire loads
- Tire tires
- Environmental contamination
- Traffic hazards caused by scattered tires

Scrap tires may collect water and can create environmental concerns if not handled properly.

All loads will be enclosed, covered, or tarped to prevent accidental discharge of the waste during transport to the disposal facility.

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## **5. Vehicle and Equipment Safety**

All hauling vehicles must:

- Meet **DOT inspection standards**
- Have **secure sidewalls or containment systems**
- Use **heavy-duty straps, chains, or nets**
- Maintain proper lighting and reflectors
- Carry emergency equipment

Required equipment:

- Fire extinguisher
- Reflective triangles
- Spill containment kit
- Heavy-duty gloves
- Safety vest
- Flashlight

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## **6. Loading Procedures**

Employees must:

1. Inspect trailer condition before loading
2. Ensure tires are stacked safely
3. Avoid overloading trailers
4. Secure the load using straps or nets
5. Confirm tires cannot shift during transport

Drivers must verify load security before departure.

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## **7. Transportation Safety**

Drivers must:

- Follow all **DOT regulations**

- Obey speed limits
- Avoid sudden braking or sharp turns
- Maintain safe following distance
- Stop immediately if load shifts

Drivers must conduct **periodic load checks** during long trips.

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## **8. Spill or Load Loss Response**

If tires fall or scatter from a trailer:

### **Step 1 – Secure the Area**

- Safely pull over
- Activate hazard lights
- Place reflective triangles

### **Step 2 – Protect Public Safety**

- Keep traffic away from spilled tires
- Contact emergency services if necessary

### **Step 3 – Notify Management**

Immediately contact:

- Company supervisor
- Dispatch office

Provide:

- Location
- Number of tires spilled
- Road conditions
- Any injuries

### **Step 4 – Cleanup**

Only trained personnel should conduct cleanup.

Procedures:

- Collect scattered tires
  - Reload safely
  - Remove debris from roadway
- 

## **9. Fire Emergency Procedures**

Tires are combustible and can produce heavy smoke.

If a tire fire occurs:

1. Stop the vehicle immediately
2. Move away from the fire if safe
3. Call **911**
4. Use fire extinguisher only if the fire is small
5. Notify company management

Never attempt to fight a large tire fire alone.

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## **10. Incident Reporting**

All incidents must be reported within **24 hours**.

Reports must include:

- Date and time
- Location
- Description of incident
- Photos if available
- Names of involved personnel

Management will conduct a review to prevent future incidents.

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## **11. Training Requirements**

All drivers and relevant personnel must receive training on:

- Load securing
- Emergency procedures
- Fire response
- Spill response
- DOT compliance

Training will be conducted **annually**.

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## **12. Regulatory Compliance**

This manual supports compliance with:

- **DOT transportation safety regulations**
  - **State scrap tire transport regulations**
  - **Environmental protection guidelines**
  - **Occupational safety standards**
- 

## **13. Emergency Contact Information**

## **New Driver Procedures**

Each new driver is provided with one on one training regarding the handling of waste tires, after this initial training we offer safety meeting every 30-60 days.

Ben Tire checks driving records before hire, random drug testing throughout the year are scheduled.

Driver's driving records are then revised one per year.

Driver's are instructed on proper handling procedures and safety procedures through our Spill Control and Safety Manual.
