

DEFINITIONS AS USED IN THIS ENDORSEMENT

Accident includes continuous or repeated exposure to conditions or which results in bodily injury, property damage, or environmental damage which the insured neither expected nor intended.

Motor Vehicle means a land vehicle, machine, truck, tractor, trailer, or semitrailer propelled or drawn by mechanical power and used on a highway for transporting property, or any combination thereof.

Bodily Injury means injury to the body, sickness, or disease to any person, including death resulting from any of these.

Property Damage means damage to or loss of use of tangible property.

Environmental Restoration means restitution for the loss, damage, or destruction of natural resources arising out of the accidental discharge, dispersal, release or escape into or upon the land, atmosphere, watercourse, or body of water, of any commodity transported by a motor carrier. This shall include the cost of removal and the cost of necessary measures taken to minimize or mitigate damage to human health, the natural environment, fish, shellfish, and wildlife.

Public Liability means liability for bodily injury, property damage, and environmental restoration.

The insurance policy to which this endorsement is attached provides automobile liability insurance and is amended to assure compliance by the insured, within the limits stated herein, as a motor carrier of property, with Sections 29 and 30 of the Motor Carrier Act of 1980 and the rules and regulations of the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration (FMCSA).

In consideration of the premium stated in the policy to which this endorsement is attached, the insurer (the company) agrees to pay, within the limits of liability described herein, any final judgment recovered against the insured for public liability resulting from negligence in the operation, maintenance or use of motor vehicles subject to the financial responsibility requirements of Sections 29 and 30 of the Motor Carrier Act of 1980 regardless of whether or not each motor vehicle is specifically described in the policy and whether or not such negligence occurs on any route or in any territory authorized to be served by the insured or elsewhere. Such insurance as is afforded, for public liability, does not apply to injury to or death of the insured's employees while engaged in the course of their employment, or property transported by the insured, designated as cargo. It is understood and agreed that no condition, provision, stipulation, or limitation contained in the policy, this endorsement, or any other endorsement thereon,

or violation thereof, shall relieve the company from liability or from the payment of any final judgment, within the limits of liability herein described, irrespective of the financial condition, insolvency or bankruptcy of the insured. However, all terms, conditions, and limitations in the policy to which the endorsement is attached shall remain in full force and effect as binding between the insured and the company. The insured agrees to reimburse the company for any payment made by the company on account of any accident, claim, or suit involving a breach of the terms of the policy, and for any payment that the company would not have been obligated to make under the provisions of the policy except for the agreement contained in this endorsement.

It is further understood and agreed that, upon failure of the company to pay any final judgment recovered against the insured as provided herein, the judgment creditor may maintain an action in any court of competent jurisdiction against the company to compel such payment.

The limits of the company's liability for the amounts prescribed in this endorsement apply separately to each accident and any payment under the policy because of anyone accident shall not operate to reduce the liability of the company for the payment of final judgments resulting from any other accident.

Other: Gas cylinder salvage vessel	In van trailer (as required)

*All emergency equipment listed above is tested and maintained as well as inspected prior to vehicle being dispatched for pick-ups. After use in an emergency, equipment will either be disposed of at an EPA approved site and replaced with new equipment or decontaminated and cleaned prior to being available for future use.

EMERGENCY PROCEDURES

In-Transit Spills / Releases

Procedures to be followed in case of an In-transit spill or release:

1. **Move** vehicle to an isolated, level area away from ditches or sewers.
2. **Turn off** vehicle engine.
3. **Secure** the scene. Place emergency reflectors in proper locations.
4. **Determine** if anyone needs medical attention. If fire or serious injury, **Call** 911.
5. **Assess** the spill / release. If it can be done safely, **Determine** the identity of the substance, the estimated quantity spilled, location of the spill and source of the spill. In the event of an emergency or large hazardous waste spill in transport notify the affected municipality of the occurrence by calling 911.
6. **Contact** the SET Operations On Call Manager (OCM). If needed, **Request** support from SET OCM.
7. **Follow** directions from OCM. If the spill or release resulted in a fatality, serious injury, evacuation of the area or an RQ release of a hazardous substance, **Provide** the following information:
 - a. Date, time and location of incident;
 - b. Extent of injury, if any;
 - c. Class or division, proper shipping name and quantity of hazardous materials involved, if such information is available; and
 - d. Type of incident and nature of hazardous materials involvement and whether a continuing danger to life exists at the scene.
8. **Stand by and ensure** you are available to take instructions from the OCM. The OCM shall notify, or direct you to notify, the customer (shipper), emergency authorities, the State's Department of Public Safety and emergency response team as is required and appropriate for the situation.
9. **Containment:** If able to be done safely, all releases should be immediately contained by building a barrier using the supplied absorbent socks and spill pads in the vehicle spill kit. Additional sources such as the supplied bags of vermiculite or soil from the ground may be used to build a temporary curb/berm around any released material. At all cost, ensure that released material does not reach any sewer system or waterway.

In the event of a major spill including the possibility of fire or explosion, personnel should be evacuated to a distance of no less than ½ mile from the incident. If possible, driver should bring all shipping papers/manifests with him. Communication should be maintained with emergency responders as to where the evacuation site is located until they have arrived on site.

For small spills or releases, the OCM may direct you to initiate cleanup operations. As appropriate, **contain** the material using absorbent or spill pads located in the vehicle's spill kit. Dispose of soiled cleanup materials and any contaminated items in provided empty 85 gallon over pack drum. The source of

release must be eliminated using the appropriate materials supplied in the spill kit such as an 85 gallon over pack, empty 5 gallon pail, or whatever may be deemed necessary to eliminate it. All contaminated items that have been collected during the cleanup will then be disposed of at an EPA approved disposal facility.

10. Using the SET Accident Reporting Form, **Document** the nature of the emergency, time of event, personnel involved, and actions taken.
11. **Obtain** photos of the scene and names of witnesses.

12. **FOLLOW-UP PROCEDURES**

Trucks or trailers that have been exposed to small releases will be decontaminated on site before continuing on to its next destination, thus eliminating any chance of further contamination or release. If necessary, for larger releases, the vehicle may be moved to an authorized facility for further decontamination.

All vehicles used to transport hazardous materials or hazardous waste will be routinely cleaned and decontaminated after each use. All dry van trailers will be visually inspected ensuring no contaminants from previous load are present. Any items used in the cleaning process will be collected in DOT approved drums and disposed of at an EPA approved facility. Additionally, all bulk tank vehicles will be washed out and decontaminated using a compatible cleaning compound at an EPA approved wash facility in accordance with the guidelines of 40 CFR part 442. This process will take place each time the tanker is scheduled to be loaded with a new material from what it had previously held.

All equipment used in the cleanup of the release will be washed and decontaminated with a compatible cleaning compound. The rinse water from this process will be collected in DOT approved tight head drums for disposal at an EPA approved disposal facility. If equipment cannot be decontaminated, it will be collected into DOT approved drums for disposal at an EPA approved facility.

All PPE and contaminated materials (dirt, grass, rocks, etc.) collected from the cleanup of a release will be collected in DOT approved drums and disposed of at an EPA approved disposal facility.

The Department of Transportation, Director of Hazardous Materials Registration, Materials and Transportation Bureau, Washington, DC 20590 will be notified, in writing, of any occurrence.

Hazardous Waste Operations and Emergency Response (EPA/OSHA/DOT) 40 Hour Initial & Annual Refresher Training

Hazardous Waste Operations and Emergency Response (EPA/OSHA) Supervisor Training

DOT Driver Training

These courses concentrate on the safe operation of SET equipment and the recognition of applicable DOT regulations and hazard communication information. Initial training of qualified drivers includes four to six weeks of instruction and performance evaluation in the safe operation of SET equipment including:

- Operation of Roll Off Equipment
- Operation of Cargo Tanker Equipment
- Pre-trip Vehicle Safety Inspection
- Hours of Service Requirements
- Loading / Unloading of Containers and Load Securement Requirements
- Review of Procedures for Maneuvering Tunnels, Bridges and Railroad crossings
- Accident Prevention and Emergency Procedures

DOT HazMat Employee General Awareness, Function Specific and Safety Training

SET Hazmat employees receive initial and recurrent training which is intended to train the employee how to comply with DOT hazardous materials regulations. This includes general awareness / familiarization training, function specific training and safety training in the following areas:

- Use of the Hazardous Materials Table
- General Packaging Requirements
- Container Marking
- Container Labeling
- Hazardous Materials Segregation
- Manifest System and Shipping Paper General Overview
- Placarding for Highway Transportation
- Emergency Response information



Training Program Description

DOT Hazmat Security General Awareness and In-depth Training

This course is intended to provide instruction in company specific security measures with emphasis on security procedures the employee is responsible for. Various security measures under the following areas are covered during this training.

- Security Objectives
- Specific Security Procedures
- Employee Responsibilities
- Response to a Security Breach
- Organizational Security Structure

EPA/RCRA Contingency Plan, Emergency Preparedness and Hazardous Waste Procedures

This course is intended to provide instruction required by 40CFR 265.16, "Personnel Training" to include training in company specific emergency response procedures as detailed in the contingency plan for the respective location. Instruction includes the following topics:

- SET Contingency Plan and Emergency Procedures
- SET Waste Management Procedures
- SET Waste Storage Area Requirements

SET New Employee Safety Orientation

SET conducts health & safety orientation training for each newly hired employee. The health and safety orientation provides instruction relating to the written SET Health and Safety program and the specific health and safety requirements the employees is expected to follow. Additionally, during the safety orientation, SET employees receive instruction relating to customer-specific requirements prior to performing work for the specific customer.

SET Asbestos Abatement Supervisor and Worker

All SET personnel involved in asbestos remediation operations complete initial and refresher training as required by federal and state regulations. Initial training includes a minimum of 40 hours of instruction for SET asbestos supervisors and 32 hours for SET asbestos workers. Additionally, SET asbestos supervisors and workers receive a minimum of 8 hours of asbestos refresher training. Some of the topics included in the training courses include:

- Physical characteristics of asbestos
- Potential health effects related to asbestos exposure
- Employee personal protective equipment
- State of the art work practices
- Personal hygiene
- Additional safety hazards
- Medical monitoring
- Air monitoring, including sampling equipment and methods, reasons for air monitoring, and interpretation of results
- Relevant Federal, State, and local regulatory requirements


