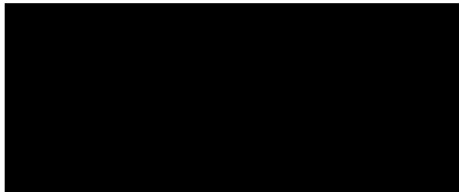

#12. Driver Training:

Each driver undergoes multi-level waste management training. This includes pre-hire road testing by seasoned trainers, general FMCSA inspection and safety protocols, daily vehicle maintenance and inspection training, Waste management and PPE safety protocols, spill control training, post spill reporting procedures, and quarterly meetings of all safety and waste management regulations and protocols. All drivers are required to have a CDL-A (required by federal regulations). We also conduct annual core-competency refresher courses to ensure driver competency, aptitude and compliance with current FMCSA regulations. We quarterly check driver MVR's and clearing house records. Our Code of conduct outlines disciplinary actions for driver infractions and violations including verbal warnings, written warnings, fines, fees, suspensions, and mandatory re-trainings or terminations.

Spill Control and Safety Plan

1. On-Board Spill Control & PPE

- **Personal Protective Equipment (PPE):** Gloves, safety goggles, rubber boots, and a high-visibility safety vest.
- **Absorbent Materials:** Universal absorbent pads, absorbent socks/booms (minimum 10 feet total), and high-capacity granular absorbent (oil-dri or clay-based).
- **Containment Barriers:** Heavy-duty rubber storm drain magnetic covers or conical drain plugs to seal off storm sewers.
- **Tools & Hardware:** A non-sparking plastic shovel, a stiff-bristle broom, and a minimum of two heavy-duty 6-mil plastic overpack disposal bags with heavy ties.
- **Specialized Neutralizers:** A supply of calcium hydroxide (hydrated lime) if municipal liquid/sewage waste is hauled.
- **Safety & Signage:** Three DOT-compliant reflective triangles and a fully charged 10lb ABC dry chemical fire extinguisher.

2. Preventative Measures (Pre-Trip & En Route)

Drivers must actively prevent releases by strictly following daily operating rules:

- **Pre-Trip Fluid Check:** Inspect the vehicle daily for active oil, fuel, or hydraulic leaks; any negative findings must ground the truck until repaired.
- **Load/Container Validation:** Check that all waste container valves, hatches, gaskets, and tailgates are tightly secured and free of structural damage before moving.
- **Manifest & Label Matching:** Confirm that the cargo description matches the manifest exactly.
- **Constant Attendance:** The operator must remain physically present and in attendance during the entire loading and unloading process.
- **Defensive Route Planning:** Avoid restricted residential roads or high-hazard water basins whenever alternative transit routes are available.

3. Control and Clean-Up Action Steps

In the event of an active spill, the driver must execute the following sequence immediately, provided it is safe to do so:

- **CONTROL (Stop the Source):** Shut off the vehicle engine, close open valves, upright a tipped container, or patch a small hole using emergency putty.
- **CONTAIN (Protect the Surroundings):** Deploy absorbent booms or build a dirt berm down-gradient of the spill. Immediately use storm drain covers to block any entry to waterways (if applicable).
- **CLEAN-UP (Apply Absorbents):** Spread granular absorbents or pads over any spilled fluid. Sweep the saturated material into overpack bags and seal them tightly.
- **NEVER DILUTE:** Never wash a spill down with water or attempt to bury it in surrounding soil.

4. Emergency Communications & Reporting Protocols

- **Immediately Call 911:** If the spill impacts public safety, blocks a highway, or causes a fire/explosion threat.

- **Contact DNREC Hotline if management doesn't respond and/or if emergency:** Contact the **DNREC 24-Hour Toll-Free Spill Line at 1-800-662-8802** immediately if the spill threatens state waters, soils, or exceeds federal reportable quantities.
- **Internal Log (Minor Spills):** Maintain an on-site, 3-year running log of all minor solid waste spills exceeding 5 pounds or 1 cubic foot, detailing the exact corrective actions taken.
