DNREC has preliminarily agreed to the much more lengthy compliance schedule to go in a Consent Decree as we discussed a few weeks ago – the idea being that you cannot do this all at once, but taking this more slowly will make it more manageable. In sum it is as follows:

Water

1. *Within 15 days of receipt of the Consent Decree, Donovan's shall submit a Notice of Intent (NOI) request to obtain permit coverage in accordance with §9.1.3 of 7 DE Admin. Code 7201 State of Delaware Regulations Governing the Control of Water Pollution (Water Pollution Regulations).*
2. *Within 60 days of receipt of the Consent Decree, Donovan's shall submit a Storm Water Plan in accordance with §9.1.5 of the Water Pollution Regulations.*
3. *Within 90 days of approval of the Storm Water Plan or receipt of the Consent Decree, whichever is later, Donovan's shall submit quarterly routine inspection results in accordance with §9.1.5.7.4 of the Water Pollution Regulations.*
4. *Within 90 days of approval of the Storm Water Plan or receipt of the Consent Decree, whichever is later, Donovan's shall submit comprehensive site evaluation results in accordance with §9.1.5.7.4 of the Water Pollution Regulations. Comprehensive site evaluations may substitute for a periodic inspection if it is conducted during the regularly scheduled periodic inspection.*
5. *Within 90 days of approval of the Storm Water Plan or receipt of the Consent Decree, whichever is later, Donovan's shall submit training records in accordance with §9.1.5.7.6 of the Water Pollution Regulations.*
6. *Within 90 days of approval of the Storm Water Plan or receipt of the Consent Decree, whichever is later, Donovan's shall submit quarterly visual monitoring results in accordance with §9.1.4 of the Water Pollution Regulations.*
7. *Within 90 days of approval of the Storm Water Plan or receipt of the Consent Decree, whichever is later, Donovan's shall submit analytical monitoring results for the facility's stormwater outfalls. All outfalls shall be sampled semiannually in accordance with §9.1.4 of the Water Pollution Regulations, and results shall be submitted to the Department for review to observe effectiveness of BMP implementation.*
8. *Within one year of receipt of the Consent Decree, Donovan's shall submit a surface impoundment improvement plan for Department review and approval that details any proposed improvements to the surface water impoundments and an operations plan to assure no future discharge from the impoundments occurs. Donovan's will submit to the Department within 9 months of receipt of the Consent Decree proof of engagement of an environmental consultant. These long-term corrective actions, once in place, will supersede the current interim pumping activities; however, periodic pumping can also be part of the proposed long-term solution. The plan shall include any drawings and design documentation detailing the current and proposed design specifications of the impoundments. A construction permit application for the proposed improvements shall be submitted to the Department in accordance with Section 4 of the Water Pollution Regulations within 60 days of surface impoundment improvement plan approval. Construction of the improvements shall begin within 60 days of construction permit issuance.*

Waste/Remediation - These proposals are, by their nature, more general. We agreed that the Consent Decree will likely be worded along the lines of "Donovan's, through its environmental consultant, shall submit a plan to investigate _____, with a minimum of _____" for each action point below.

MTBE: 18 Months

- At the minimum we need 2-3 collocated off-site monitoring wells to determine the shallow and deep groundwater flow in the eastern portion of the site, and to see if any MTBE is coming from the County Seat Gardens. Along with the off-site wells, some (let the consultant propose) on-site monitoring wells should be resampled for VOCs. Groundwater elevations at the Former Georgetown Dump should be included in the areawide groundwater elevation map.

PFAS: 18 Months

- Review of the private well data and installation of 2-3 nested on-site monitoring wells up to the depth of the private wells. Resampling some of the on-site groundwater monitoring wells for PFAS.
- Ongoing filtration operations and maintenance at private wells
 - Donovans initially pushed back claiming the costs would be prohibitive. DNREC offered to reduce the sampling frequency: treated water tested annually, raw water tested biennially, reevaluate after 4 years. Donovan's has not officially agreed to this, but Mike Teichman is working on it.

Surface and Sediment: 24 Months

- Collecting surface water and sediment samples off the east end of the property where rain water collects.

Surface water discharge: 24 Months

- Address BrightFields recommendation to further investigate the localized area of impacted soil and water immediately adjacent/downgradient of the rainwater discharge valve at the smelter building pad.

Tanks: 24 Months

- Addressing three RI Tanks Areas of Concern (AOC) and the 2022 AST locations with TPH-DRO above 1,000 mg/kg (2 AOC and AST areas overlap totaling in 7 Tank's locations). At these locations, grab groundwater samples should also be analyzed for Tanks contaminants (VOCs and SVOCs).

Mercury: 24 Months

- Investigate a potential mercury release in the area of the railcar deconstruction where crushed fluorescent lamps were observed. This is little more than grabbing a handful of dirt near where they broken fluorescent tubes were found and testing it for mercury.
