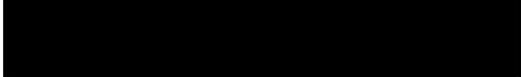

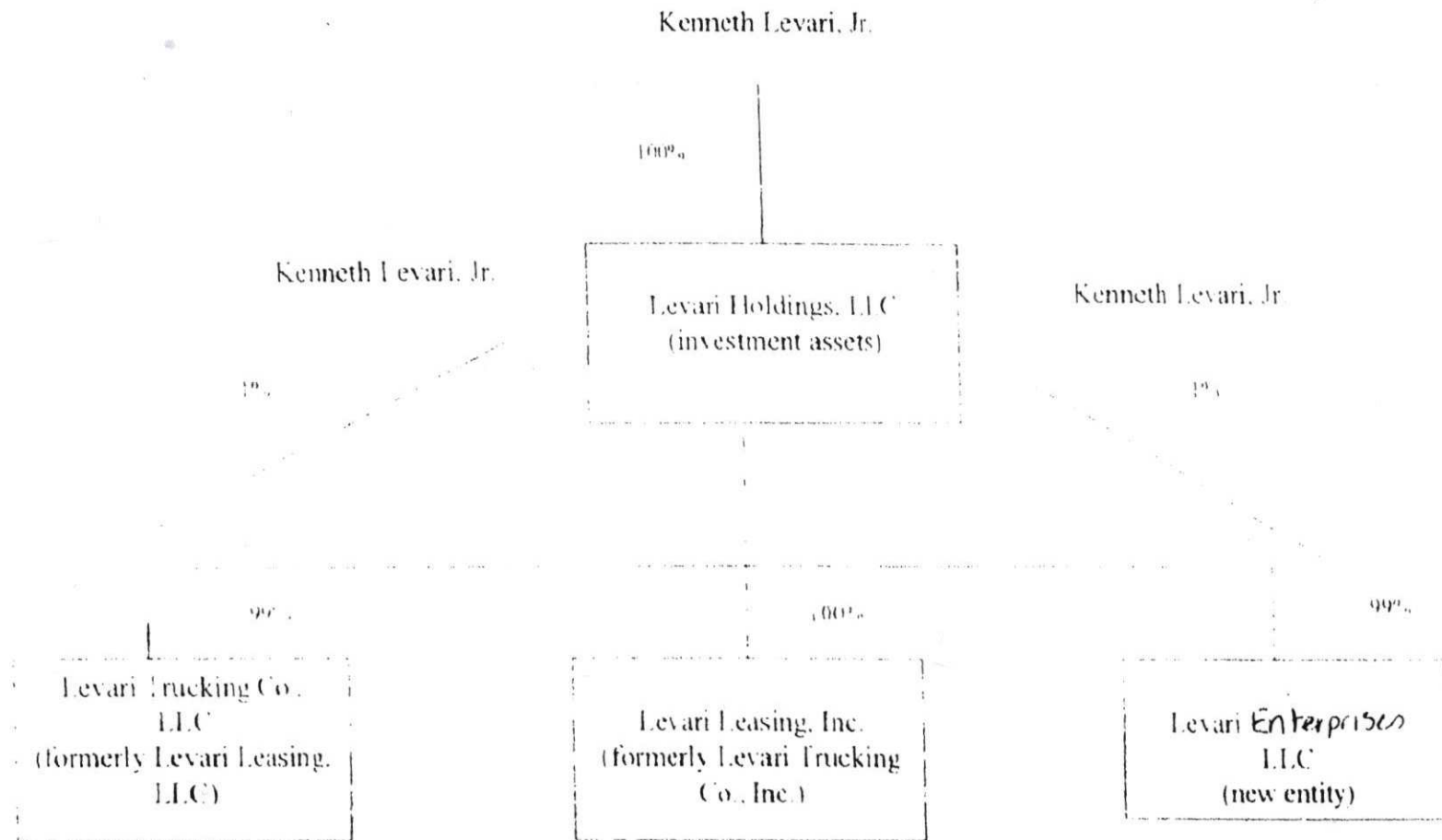

The State of New Jersey, Division of Commercial Recordings database indicates that this company is registered as Levari Trucking Co., LLC (commercial record number: 0600194248), which is the official company name licensed as a solid waste transporter in New Jersey.
