Good afternoon Jana,

Attached is the Operation Permit Renewal Application for an on-site wastewater treatment and disposal system. Part 2.B.1 of Jellystone's permit (359002-03) and Deep Branch's (359079-02) states: "At least 180 days prior to the expiration date of the operation permit, the permittee must submit an application for renewal or notify the Department of the intent to cease discharging by the expiration date. In the event that a timely and complete application has been submitted as determined by the Department, and the Department is unable, through no fault of the permittee, to issue a new permit before the expiration date of this permit, the terms and conditions of this permit are automatically continued and remain fully effective and enforceable until a decision is made on the new application." The renewal application has a \$750 application fee and a \$210 advertisement fee that is required along with the submittal.

Jellystone's operation permit expires on 7/2/23 and the Deep Branch operation permit expires on 3/6/24. Please let me know if you have any questions or trouble viewing the attachment.
