Pursuant to the provisions of Del. C. 7203, and the Department's Regulations Governing the Use
of Subaqueous Lands, permission is hereby granted on this 26th day of July A.D.
2005, to construct the above-referenced project in accordance with the revised approved plans for
this Lease (2 Sheets) as approved on 6/14/05, and the application dated 5/18/05 and received by
this Division on 5/9/05 and revisions received 6/14/05.

WHEREAS, the State of Delaware is the owner of ungranted subaqueous lands lying
beneath the waters of the Indian River; and

WHEREAS, Kenneth A. Murphy, owner of certain adjoining lands to the Indian River,
has applied for permission to construct a pier, a dock and piling and repair bulkheading, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of 7 Del. C., 7203, the Secretary of the Department
of Natural Resources and Environmental Control through his duly authorized representative finds
that it is not contrary to the public interest if this project is approved subject to the terms and
conditions herein set forth.

Delaware's good nature depends on you!

This approval is in accordance with plans and application submitted to Department of Natural Resources and Environmental Control, a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof.

This Lease shall be continued for a period of twenty (20) years or so long as the conditions attached to the lease are adhered to, whichever is the shorter in time. Upon the expiration of the twenty-year term, this lease shall expire and become null and void, unless prior thereto the lessee shall have applied for and received a renewal of this lease. A renewal may be denied if the State determines that the lease is no longer in the public interest.

THIS lease is issued subject to the following conditions:

SPECIAL CONDITIONS

1. This Lease shall not be considered valid until it has been duly recorded in the office for the Recorder of Deeds in and for the appropriate County and a copy of the recorded lease is returned to, and has been received by, the Department.
2. Prior to construction, a copy of the vessel registration, and the information regarding vessel dimensions required in Application Appendix A, shall be submitted to this office. No construction shall begin until the Department has issued written authorization for the lessee to proceed. If the vessel information required in Application Appendix A, or if any requested revised plans are not submitted prior to the construction expiration date of this Lease, the Lease shall be considered null and void.
3. The current leased area of structure over public subaqueous lands is 432 square feet represented by a pier 4 feet by 76 feet, a dock 5 feet by 25 feet and a three piling for a boat lift, channelward of the owner's property line.
4. The conditions contained herein shall be incorporated into any and all construction contracts and other ancillary documents associated with earth disturbance and any other activities directly or indirectly associated with construction which may impact subaqueous lands associated with this project. The lessee and contractor are responsible to ensure that the workers executing the activities authorized by this Lease have full knowledge of, and abide by, the terms and conditions of this Lease.

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5. Construction shall be conducted so as not to violate the State of Delaware Department of Natural Resources and Environmental Control, "Surface Water Quality Standards" dated August 11, 1999.
6. The pier and dock shall be constructed and installed in a manner so as not to impair water access to the adjoining property and a minimum of ten (10) feet from the adjacent properties.
7. A copy of this Lease must be available on-site during all phases of construction activity.
8. The structures on/or adjacent to subaqueous lands shall be for the explicit purpose of berthing two vessels and erosion control as stated in the application.
9. Disturbance of wetlands and/or aquatic vegetation adjacent to the permitted construction by burning, cutting, herbicide treatments or other methods is prohibited. Disturbance of wetlands and/or aquatic vegetation in the path of construction shall be minimized.
10. All construction debris, excavated material, brush, rocks and refuse incidental to such work shall be placed above the influence of surface waters.
11. Construction of the pier, dock and bulkhead repair are subject to the terms and conditions of the attached Department of the Army Permit number GP-20.
12. No portion of the decking on any dock, or pier, authorized by this Lease shall exceed the width dimensions for that structure identified on page one of this Lease.
13. The bulkheading reconstruction shall be done in accordance with the approved plan. The bulkhead shall be constructed within the footprint of the existing bulkhead and shall not step out in front of the existing bulkhead.
14. There shall be no excavation channelward of the permitted alignment either before, during or after the installation of the repaired bulkhead/riprap.
15. The bulkhead/riprap shall be constructed so that it aligns with the existing adjacent bulkhead on both sides.

GENERAL CONDITIONS

1. The project is to be undertaken in accordance with the plans submitted and attached hereto. Any activities not specifically authorized herein may require a supplemental approval from this office prior to the initiation of construction. A determination on the need for a supplemental approval will be made by this office pursuant to the permittee submitting written notification and revised plans indicating project changes to this office.
2. Representatives of the Department of Natural Resources and Environmental Control may inspect such work during any phases of the construction and may collect any samples or conduct any tests that are deemed necessary.
3. This lease does not cover the structural stability of the project units.
4. Prior to the expiration of this lease, the lessee shall remove all structures covered under this lease unless the lease has been renewed in accordance with its terms.
5. Any actions, operations or installations which are considered by the Department to be contrary to the best interests of the public shall constitute reason for the discontinuance and/or removal of said action, operation or installation.
6. The lessee shall notify the Department of Natural Resources and Environmental Control within ten (10) days of the date work will be commenced.
7. The lessee shall maintain any structure on public subaqueous lands in good and safe condition and will protect and save the State of Delaware harmless from any loss, cost or damage by reason of said structures.
8. The issuance of this lease does not imply approval of any other part, phase or portion of any overall project the lessee may be contemplating.
9. This lease shall not be construed to grant or confer any right, title, easement, or interest in, to, or over any land belonging to the State of Delaware other than that of a tenant.
10. This lease is subject to the terms and conditions contained in any easement, license or lease that may have been granted by the State or any political subdivision, board, commission or agency of the State in the vicinity of the leased premises.

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11. This lease and authorization are granted for the purposes as stated herein. Any other use without prior approval shall constitute reason for this lease being revoked.
12. This lease shall expire if the project has not been completed within three (3) years from the date of issuance.
13. If the lessee considers three (3) years insufficient for completion of the project, the lessee may submit a project time schedule for consideration by the Department. If the time schedule is approved it shall be attached hereto and made a part hereof.
14. This Lease is personal and may not be transferred without the prior written consent of the Department. Prior to the transfer of the adjacent upland property, the lessee shall obtain the written consent of the Department to transfer this Lease to the new upland property owner. Failure to obtain such written consent may result in the revocation of this Lease and the removal of all structures authorized by this Lease at the expense of the lessee.
15. The lessee shall at all times comply with all applicable laws and regulations of the Department of Natural Resources and Environmental Control.
16. The issuance of this lease does not constitute approval for any of the activities as may be required by any other local, state or federal governmental agency.
17. Application for renewal must be submitted six (6) months prior to the expiration date of this lease.
18. This lease may be revoked upon violation of any of the above conditions.

Re: Transfer and Recordation of Public Subaqueous Lands Leases

To Whom It May Concern,

It has come to the attention of the Wetlands & Subaqueous Lands Section (WSLS) that there are Subaqueous Land Leases that may not have been transferred or have been incorrectly transferred and recorded without authorization from the Department of Natural Resources & Environmental Control (DNREC).

A Subaqueous Lands Lease is issued to waterfront property owners who have structures extending channelward of the mean low water line in public subaqueous lands. You may come across a Subaqueous Lands Lease issued by the DNREC when completing a property deed search for a waterfront property that contains water access structures (piers, docks, etc.) in public subaqueous lands. Pursuant to 7 Del. C. § 7206(a), which states, in relevant part:

"...Pursuant to this chapter, the Secretary shall have exclusive jurisdiction and authority over all projects to convey a fee simple or lesser interest or to grant easements with respect to subaqueous lands belonging to the State. All jurisdiction and authority to convey a fee simple or lesser interest or to grant easements over subaqueous lands as to which grants have been made or may be made is vested in the Secretary...."

Delaware's good nature depends on you!

Since the DNREC Secretary has exclusive jurisdiction and authority in all conveyance of Subaqueous Land Leases, notification of transfer of ownership of a property with an associated Subaqueous Lands Lease is required. The notification packet must include a cover letter requesting the transfer of the Subaqueous Lands Lease, the copy of the deed showing the new ownership, the identification number for the Lease or a copy of the current Lease as well as the contact address for direct mailing of the Lease Transfer.
