Spill Prevention and Clean-up Plan

Spill prevention will consist of:

- 1) All valves will be checked weekly to ensure they are drip proof.
- 2) A bucket will be employed on each valve upon opening.
- 3) Hoses will be capped on each end to prevent leakage.
- 4) All caps will be maintained in good working order and secured on each discharge/suction point.

Spill Clean-up Plan:

- 1) Spills of 25 gallons or less will be cleaned up with a shovel and rake for any solids. Liquids will be vacuumed up with the truck
- 2) The area will be limed to achieve a pH of 12
- 3) Spills over 25 gallons will be cleaned up using a shovel and a rake for any solids
- 4) All liquid will be vacuumed up with the truck and an outside contractor if necessary in order to maintain the area in an acceptable condition.
- 5) The affected area will be limed to achieve a pH of 12 for pathogen reduction.
- 6) If the spill is such that it covers a large area and is in proximity to a populace, the area will be limed to a pH of 12 for 2 hours after contact and samples will be taken and tested for enterococcus.

Cleaning of Equipment

- 1) The truck will be cleaned on an impervious surface.
- 2) All solids will be cleaned and dried and disposed of at the landfill
- 3) Water will be captured and sucked up with the truck to be disposed of at the treatment plant.

Records

- 1) Records will be maintained for 5 years

Hours of Operations

- 1) Monday – Friday 7 am to 5 pm
- 2) After 5 pm will be on an emergency basis to prevent a spill or household damage.
- 3) Weekends and holidays will be on an emergency basis
