This license may be revoked or suspended if the license holder violates any of the lawful rules or regulations of the board, any condition of this license, or the provisions of the act under which the license is issued.

License Conditions

1) All activity shall be performed in accordance with The Regulations Governing the Design, Installation and Operation of On-Site Wastewater Treatment and Disposal Systems, amended January 11, 2014.

2) The activity authorized by the license shall only be performed under the name of the person on the face of the license.

3) The licensee is responsible for correct and complete information submitted to the Department (address, telephone number, employer, etc.).

4) The licensee is responsible for providing proof of ten (10) annual continuing education training hours relating to wastewater. Carryover credit hours from a previous year are not accepted.

5) For all new licensees, please refer to the chart below for continuing education training requirements for the current calendar year only. If your license is issued in:

* January - April (required to complete 10 hours)

* May - July (required to complete 8 hours)* August - October (required to complete 6 hours)

* November - December (required to complete 0 hours)

6) Licenses issued are not transferable and expire on December 31st of each year.

7) All Class F licensees shall operate under a valid State of Delaware Non-Hazardous Liquid Waste Transporters Permit.

8) All Class F licensees shall be knowledgeable of the Non-Hazardous Liquid Transporters Permittee's Plan for the Prevention, Control and Clean-up of Accidental Discharges. A copy of the Plan is to be maintained on file with the Department.

9) All Class F licensees shall operate under a \$5,000 performance bond, or other form of security, is maintained on file with the Department for the duration of licensing.

10) All Class F licensees shall keep a copy of their Class F license identification card available for verification while performing any Class F license related work.

11) All Class F licensees shall enter into a "Sewage Holding Tank Maintenance Contract" with the property owner prior to pumping out holding tanks. A copy of the contract document must be submitted to the Department within 15 days of signing the contract.

12) All Class F licensees shall enter into a "Grease Trap Maintenance Contract" with the property owner prior to pumping out grease traps. A copy of the contract document must be submitted to the Department within 15 days of signing the contract. Class F licensees may not enter into a "Grease Trap Maintenance Contract" unless the Class F licensee has an approved facility to dispose of grease trap waste identified in

the Non-Hazardous Liquid Waste Transporters Permit that he/she is operating under.

13) All Class F licensees shall not co-mingle septage and grease trap waste, unless specifically approved, in writing, by the facility(ies) that will be receiving the grease trap waste.

14) All Class F licensees shall conduct business in a manner that is compliant with the Safety, Tank Access and Tank Cleaning provisions of Section 7101 of the Delaware Administrative Code, as amended or revised.

15) All Class F licensees shall submit quarterly reports documenting the location, the 911 mailing address, and amount of septage removed in total gallons. This requirement becomes effective one (1) year after promulgation of these Regulations.



Spill Control

- 1) Operator will immediately use proper PPE, and find the source of the spill / leak, and stop use of the leaking device until it has been properly repaired.
- 2) If there were a large enough spill, operator will confirm spill type and if over the threshold, will contact DNREC Emergency response at 800-660-8802.
- 3) Operator will then begin the clean up process utilizing the vacuum truck to gather what can be gathered, then will utilize straw bales to contain / soak up all remaining.
- 4) If the leak is still not contained, operator will contact CES in Delmar, MD and dispatch their on-call technician with proper trucks and equipment to assist with clean up.
- 5) If necessary, a pressure washer will be utilized to clean the remainder of materials to wash the non-hazardous material into the spill containment area.
- 6) Once contained and dry, operator will begin the final clean-up process with water, liquid detergent, bleach, brooms and shovels.
- 7) All contaminated soils, straw bales, and clean up rags will be disposed of properly at the local authorized landfill.
- 8) If spill is in a large area, to aid in killing of potential bacteria, lime may be used as well as sunlight exposure, then washing of area repeatedly, as necessary.
- 9) After completion of cleanup, a full written report will be kept on file in the office for 5 years, for reference of DNREC, which will be available upon request.
- 10) Moving forward, business leadership will make note of all safety concerns, and report back to all employees to prevent future spills. A thorough investigation into the leak on the affected vehicle, as well as an automatic re-inspection on all other vehicles to prevent spills in the future.

Please be advised permission is granted under the following conditions to discharge wastewater for calendar year **2025** into The Town of Laurel's wastewater treatment facility:


1. This annual permit shall have an effective date of January 1, 2025. The fee for this permit is \$275.00 for new haulers.
2. Request for each annual permit must be made each year at least thirty (30) days prior to the end of each calendar year.
3. Spot random samples may be taken from selected loads. Only residential wastewater from Delaware will be accepted.
4. You will be given a password, which will permit access to the sewage acceptance receiving unit.
5. The hours of operations are weekdays from 7:00 a.m. – 4:30 p.m., weekends/holidays are 8:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m. The dumping fees is \$0.07 normal septic waste and \$0.09 for portable toilets for each gallon dumped. Should there be a need for after hours dumping you are to call the after hours phone. Please specify which type of waste you will be dumping (check one): normal septic _____ or portable toilets ✓.

6. The after/weekends hours phone numbers are: (1) 302-853-5323.
7. A current valid Class F license from The State of Delaware, Department of Natural Resources and Environmental Control, is required. License number and date of expiration 6311F - 12/31/2025
8. This permit may be withdrawn or amount being dumped daily reduced, if dumping or wastewater is interfering with the operation of the treatment plant, as may be determined by The Town of Laurel.
9. The town will bill you the first of each month for the preceding month. Bill is due upon receipt and if not paid within thirty (30) days, interest will be imposed at twenty five percent (25%) on any unpaid balance.

Vehicle Cleaning & Recordkeeping Procedures

Vehicle Cleaning Procedures

- The truck is equipped with a liquid-tight tank, the tank is cleaned regularly and monitored closely to confirm there are no leaks.
- The truck is washed bi-weekly with a power washer and vehicle soap, or as necessary in case of emergency situations.
- The truck will be equipped with hand sanitizer whenever being used
- The pump, hoses, valves and tanks are checked thoroughly each day of use prior to leaving the office.
- The truck is visually inspected after each stop to confirm there is no debris, and the truck has no leaks or weeps.
- The truck will have all trash removed from it following the completion of each day.

Vehicle Recordkeeping Procedures

- The truck has a pre-trip inspection checklist, and is also visually checked at the end of each day of usage.
- Records of the pre-trip inspections are kept for 6 months in the office, and digitally for one year.
- There is a mileage report filed at the end of each day, to keep track of miles traveled and fuel economy.
- We keep a record of all gallons pumped, date of units serviced, estimated gallons and the licensee who completed the pumping.
- Each customer will receive an invoice each month from Quickbooks with projected dates if pre-billed, or actual dates if post-billed.

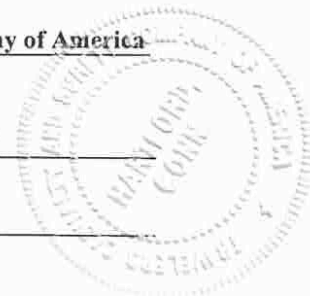


