Our portable toilet trucks and septic tank trucks service various areas daily Monday through Friday. Services are performed 5 to 6 days a week between 7am and 5pm. This does not change on weekends or on demand.


A-1 Sanitation's trucks are vacuum equipped. All spills can be vacuumed up with our equipment. The ground would be treated with lime and straw as needed to meet environmental conditions. If our trucks were not available, we would contact a company that specializes in cleaning up spills. All spills would be reported to the proper environmental agency. The phone numbers for DNREC are kept in each truck along with copies of our permits for the state and counties. DNREC phone number is also kept on file at our office location.

Our trucks are cleaned daily by our drivers. The trucks are hosed down, restocked with supplies, and trash removed. We also have our own detailed specialist that routinely details the trucks.

Records are kept at our office of all routes, servicing portable toilets. Names, addresses and dates of jobs are also kept for 5 years on all septic cleanings.
