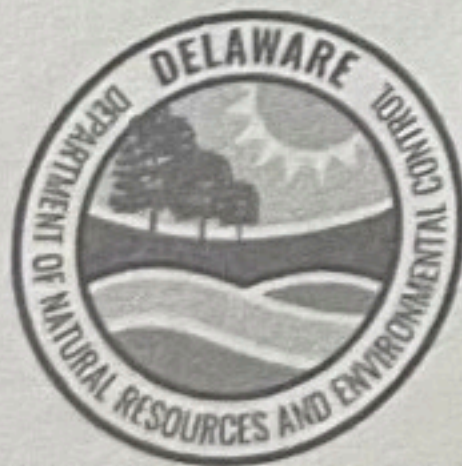



(For Sewage Handling Permit – DNREC)

1. Spill Reporting & Cleanup Plan

Slaughter's Spill Plan (1)

- All company vehicles will remain equipped with a shovel, lime, absorbent materials, rubber gloves, and basic containment tools at all times.
 - If a spill occurs, the driver will immediately stop the vehicle, secure the area, and take all possible steps to divert sewage away from waterways, storm drains, ditches, wells, or other sensitive areas.
 - Lime or approved absorbent material will be applied to the affected surface to help neutralize and disinfect the spill area.
 - If unloading the vehicle becomes necessary to prevent additional discharge, the driver will contact the nearest authorized waste hauler or disposal facility for emergency support.
 - The spill will be reported to **DNREC** immediately, followed by local emergency services if there is any threat to public health or the environment.
 - A written incident report will be completed within 24 hours and maintained in company records for a minimum of 5 years.

2. Vehicle Cleaning Procedures

- All pump trucks will be cleaned and rinsed only at approved disposal sites or designated wash-down areas designed to prevent discharge into the environment.
 - No vehicle washing or tank rinsing will occur on roadways, unpermitted locations, or areas where wastewater could enter waterways or storm drains.
 - Exterior surfaces contaminated with sewage during pumping operations will be sprayed down and disinfected at the end of each workday or sooner if needed.
 - Vacuum tanks will be washed out as required to prevent buildup, odors, or cross-contamination—always at an approved disposal location.
 - Any cleaning wastewater generated will be disposed of at an approved liquid waste facility.

3. Recordkeeping Procedures

Slaughter Septic Services will maintain organized records for all sewage handling activities, including:

Load Tracking

- Date & time of each pump-out
- Address or location of service
- Gallons collected
- Type of waste (residential septic, grease, holding tank, etc.)
- Driver/technician name
- Disposal facility name and receipt/manifest number

Vehicle & Equipment Logs

- Daily pre-trip inspections
- Maintenance and repairs
- Tank clean-out documentation
- Equipment cleaning and sanitation logs

Spill & Incident Reports

- Any spill or environmental incident will be documented and retained for a minimum of five years.

All records will be kept digitally and in office files and will be made available to DNREC upon request.

4. Operating Days & Hours

Slaughter Septic Services operates:

Standard Operating Hours:

- **Monday–Friday: 7:00 AM – 5:00 PM**

Emergency Services:

- **24/7 availability**, including nights, weekends, and holidays, for emergency pump-outs and spill response.

Dispatch, recordkeeping, and administrative functions occur during standard business hours, while drivers are dispatched as needed to meet customer needs and regulatory response requirements.

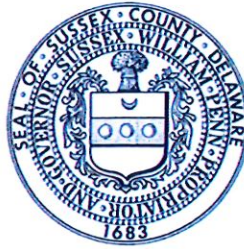

Slaughter Septic Services LLC has applied to the Sussex County Engineering Department for authorization to discharge wastewater for treatment at the Inland Bays Regional Wastewater Facility.

The applicant must provide us with a copy of their State of Delaware Department of Natural Resources and Environmental Control (DNREC) Waste Hauler Permit that approves the use of the above treatment plants as disposal sites.
