Hours of Operation

Typical hours of operation will be from 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. However, there may be circumstances where we will need to be out earlier or later depending on the urgency of the call. Also, we respond to emergency jetvac calls 24 hours a day from municipalities.

Spill Plan

In the event of a spill from a motor vehicle accident or other unforeseen cause, we will be contracting Guardian Environmental Service for clean-up and containment (302) 918-3070 or 877-437-0007. The Jetvac truck will have booms, pigs and sta-dri on it for immediate response to attempt to control and contain the spill until the spill control team and Guardian Environmental Services arrive to clean up.

Hopkins Construction, Inc. will create an internal spill response team.

All vehicles will be cleaned at our facility with hot water pressure washers and water from this to be appropriately disposed.

DNREC Notification

DNREC will be notified by phone at (800) 662-8802 (24 hour line) in the event of a release of any waste material during transport. In addition, any spill of liquid waste greater than 25 gallons will be reported to DNREC's Commercial & Government Services Section (C&GSS) in writing within five (5) days of the incident. The report will document the date, time and location of the incident and the measures taken to contain and clean up the spill.

Record Keeping

The jetvac truck will have a Jetvac Work Order (duplicate copy) log book that the driver will be required to fill out. These logs will contain start and finish time, customer name and address, project name/address & job #, contact information, PO#, operator name, truck # and gallons dumped (if applicable). This information will also be relayed to the office and recorded. Once the Jetvac Work Order book is full, it is turned into the office and filed. The driver will then be issued a new work order book.
