SUBJECT: Tony Strett & Sons Septic Service Operation Plan for Spill Reporting and Clean-Up, Cleaning Vehicles, Recordkeeping Procedures, and Days and Hours of Operation

1. Spill Reporting and Clean-Up – Spills will be washed down and the area treated with hydrated lime within DNREC limits. A call will be placed to DNREC if over limit for proper procedures for handling spill and assistance request if necessary.
2. Cleaning of Vehicles – Exterior of vehicles are cleaned bi-weekly or as needed by hose and brush or power-washing. Interior of truck tank is power washed monthly at wastewater treatment facility accessed through manhole. Trucks stay parked inside of pole building when not in use.
3. Recordkeeping Procedures – Records of everyday activities to include pumps, disposals, and repairs are maintained by the owner. Paper and digital copies are kept for historical purposes.
4. Days and Hours of Operation – Tony Strett & Sons Septic Service is a 24-hour, 7 days per week operation.
