Re: Utility Service Extension for Tax Map Parcels 234-12.00-86.00, 86.01, 86.02, 86.03, 86.04, 87.00, 87.01, 87.02, 87.03 and 87.04, Lewes, Delaware

To Whom It May Concern:

The enclosed utility plans have been prepared to provide public wastewater service to ten existing residential parcels identified as Sussex County Tax Map Parcels 234-12.00-86.00, 86.01, 86.02, 86.03, 86.04, 87.00, 87.01, 87.02, 87.03, and 87.04, located along Camp Arrowhead Road in Lewes, Delaware.

The proposed design consists of a new low-pressure sanitary sewer collection system designed to connect the existing and proposed residential dwellings on these parcels to Sussex County's public wastewater system.

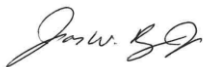
The utility improvements have been designed to serve a total projected flow of approximately 2,400 gallons per day, based on ten equivalent dwelling units (EDUs) at 240 gallons per day per EDU. The proposed infrastructure is intended solely to provide sanitary sewer service to the identified parcels and does not include expansion beyond the properties shown on the plans.

The project has been designed in accordance with Sussex County Engineering Department standards and specifications for low-pressure sewer systems. Construction will occur primarily within existing easements and designated utility corridors while minimizing disturbance to adjacent properties.

The intent of this project is to improve wastewater infrastructure, protect public health, and support environmental stewardship by connecting the subject parcels to Sussex County's public sewer system in accordance with applicable County and State requirements.
