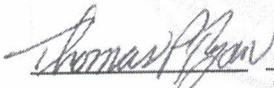

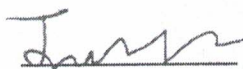

Dear Mr. Ryan:

With reference to the above noted Special Approval that expires December 31, 2025, we are hereby extending the special approval permit to discharge wastewater as part of the waste hauling contracts for grease trap customers. The discharge into the County sewer system at the Airport Road Receiving Station is approved subject to the following conditions:

1. The discharge for this approval shall only be from the grease trap/interceptors within the State of Delaware and within the Delaware River Watershed. Any additions to this list must be approved by the Department, prior to discharge.
2. Discharges will only be accepted between the hours of 6am and 11pm Monday through Sunday.
3. The permitted discharge shall be monitored by the permit holder in compliance with the following schedule:

4. A report including the results of all monitoring for the discharges and the total flow volume discharged shall be submitted quarterly.
5. The permittee shall be billed according to the current waste hauler charge per 1,000 gallons discharged and an administrative fee of \$200 per quarter. The waste hauler contracted to haul the

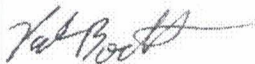

NON-HAZARDOUS LIQUID WASTE SPILL CLEANUP PLAN:

If accidental discharge of liquid waste should occur, the following steps shall be taken:

1. The waste hauler should first attempt to stop the source of the discharge.
2. The waste hauler must notify the main office at (302) 653-8777 and the owner at (302) 670-0859.
3. The main office shall notify DNREC if there is a large spill.
4. If the waste hauler on site is unable to vacuum up the spill because of mechanical problems or the spill is too large; the main office shall contact another crew from Weaver's Sanitation and that crew shall go to the site and vacuum up the spill.
5. Lime shall be spread in the spill site.
6. If additional equipment or personal is need to clean up the spill, the main office shall contact the needed contractors.

Vehicle cleaning plan:

Vehicles shall be washed weekly, weather permitting.

Record keeping Procedures:

Records shall be kept electronically by the drivers with the tablets provided and by the office staff. The required records shall be sent to DNREC electronically quarterly.

Hours of operation:

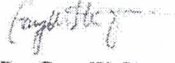
