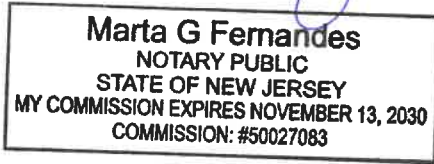

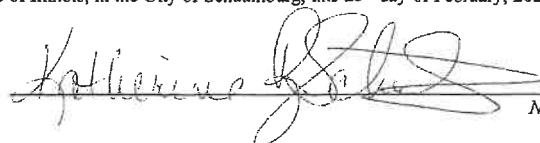

Kuehne Chemical Company Operation Plan

- **Water Quality**

- The source of our liquid is process water. It is comprised of facility wash water, cooling water, boiler blow down water, reverse osmosis unit purge water and storm water. It is collected and a large portion is recycled back into the process. The excess is treated to remove chlorine, correct pH to the range of 6-9 and some solids removal is performed.
- This waste will not contain any petroleum products.

- **Recordkeeping**

- Kuehne maintains copies of each Bill of Lading for wastewater and a log of each shipment. The information is utilized to prepare summaries which are submitted to New Castle County.
- Invoicing is received and forwarded to Accounts Payable who enter it into the respective ERP/Accounting system for payment.

- **Tanker Cleaning**

- The tankers are only for wastewater transportation, so cleaning is conducted (internal and external) as needed through a truck wash facility.
- Truck cleaning is daily and as needed internally with external cleaning as needed at the truck wash facility.

- **Spills**

- In case of spill, each driver is instructed to:
 - Call 911, report the emergency and request assistance, if needed.
 - Notify his dispatcher.
 - The dispatcher will notify the HSES Manager who will notify DNREC and determine whether reporting is required to any other regulatory agency.
 - Our drivers are not trained as emergency responders, but the operators at the production facility are trained in spill control and response and are available for cleanup.
 - A third party is available for cleanup if events warrant it.

- **Disposal Facility**
 - New Castle Sanitary Waste Depository at Airport Pump Station on McArthur Drive, New Castle, DE.
- **Operations**
 - The Kuehne facility operates 24 hours per day, 365 days per year. Wastewater could be transported to the New Castle Sanitary Waste Depository any time of day if available.
