1. TYPE OF ACTION AND THE REGULATION NUMBER AND NAME:

Amendments to 7 DE Admin. Code 1302, Regulations Governing Hazardous Waste

2. PURPOSE OF ACTION:

The purpose of this action is to adopt federal regulatory amendments required to maintain a delegated, authorized program. The planned revisions include updating the regulations to adopt required federal rules, including the following:

- (1) Modernizing Ignitable Liquids Determinations Checklist 243
- (2) Canada Import Export Recovery and Disposal Code Changes Checklist 244

The action will also include state-only amendments, including but not limited to:

- (1) Replacing a state-only requirement that used oil containers and tanks be closed with the requirement that used oil containers and tanks be handled and stored in a manner to prevent ruptures, overfilling, leaks, and spills
- (2) Including a requirement that leaks and spills in satellite accumulation areas be cleaned up immediately

Additionally, the amendments will include corrections to typographical and grammatical errors and corrections to ensure consistency with the *Delaware Administrative Code Drafting and Style Manual*. Examples of these amendments include, but are not limited to:

- (1) Correcting spelling errors
- (2) Correcting punctuation errors
- (3) Correcting formatting errors, including the ensuring proper formatting of references to Delaware Code
- (4) Eliminating the use of the term "and/or"
- (5) Eliminating the use of "(s)" at the end of a word to mean either the singular or plural version of the word
- (6) Addressing the use of "owner or operator," "owner/operator," and "owner and operator" to ensure consistency
- (7) Eliminating the use of the section symbol for regulatory references and replacing with the word "Section"
- (8) Replacing "percent" with "%" when referring to a specific number
- (9) Replacing references to "Solid and Hazardous Waste Management Section" with "Compliance and Permitting Section" to reflect the Division's reorganization

3. STATUTORY BASIS:

Amendments to Delaware's hazardous waste regulations are proposed and amended in accordance with the provisions found at 7 *Del. C.* §§ 6010(a) and 6305.
