Adopt a new regulation 7 DE Admin. Code 1154 "Fenceline Air Monitoring for Petroleum Refineries, and other Applicable Sources"

2. PURPOSE OF ACTION: The purpose of this regulation is to require Real-Time Fenceline Air Monitoring Systems that provide air quality information to the public about levels of various criteria air pollutants, volatile organic compounds, and other air pollutants, at or near the property boundaries of Petroleum Refineries, and other Applicable Sources.

3. STATUTORY BASIS: 7 Del. C. Chapter 60, Environmental Control. §§ 6001(c) and 6010.


