Application Period Open for Community Reinvestment Funds

Eligible municipal and non-profit organizations may now apply for Community Reinvestment Funds.

Here is a partial list of how the grant money can be used:

- Preconstruction costs, including the development of plans and specifications.
- The acquisition, construction, reconstruction, rehabilitation, or restoration of buildings.
- The acquisition or installation of apparatus or equipment permanently attached to the building.
- The acquisition of land required as sites for such buildings, including land or rights to land needed to provide access, and grading or other improvements.
- The construction of sidewalks, where authorized by law.
- The construction of any sewers or water mains needed to connect such buildings to any publicly-owned sewer system or water system.

Eligible entities include county and local governments, community-based nonprofits, and private-sector nonprofit organizations. All nonprofit organizations must hold a 501(c)3 designation in order to be considered eligible.

State agencies, school districts, charter schools, private schools, institutions of higher education, childcare facilities, churches, fire companies, fiscal agents, and for-profit organizations are not eligible for funds from the Community Reinvestment Fund.

The application deadline is May 15, 2023.

The Department of Natural Resources and Environmental Control (DNREC) is engaged in the process of promulgating [California's Clean Car II regulations](#). The rules will require that by the fall of 2025 (model year 2026), 35% of all new light-duty vehicles sold in Delaware be zero-emission vehicles (ZEVs). The mandated percentage of ZEV sales increases every year afterward, reaching 100% in model year 2035 -- effectively banning the sale of new fuel-powered vehicles.

The sale of plug-in electric hybrid vehicles, which are classified as zero-emission vehicles under the California rules, [would also be restricted to no more than 20% of new car sales in model year 2035](#).

DNREC will reportedly take the next step to promulgate the Clean Car II regulations between now and March, when an announcement will be published in the state [Register of Regulations](#).

Reassessment Update

While reassessment data collection continues in the North Murderkill and Milford Hundreds, South Murderkill and the Mispillion Hundreds are added.

This includes the unincorporated areas of Camden, Woodside, and Viola, in the North Murderkill Hundred; Milford, Houston, and Frederica in the Milford Hundred, and also Felton, in the South Murderkill Hundred and Farmington, and Harrington in the Mispillion Hundred.

Data collectors can be identified by their bright yellow "Tyler" vest and Kent County-issued photo ID badge, and can also be identified on the Reassessment Section of Kent County Levy Court website at:

Visitation at State Parks Exceeds 8 Million

Delaware State Parks set an attendance record in 2022, welcoming more than 8 million visitors. Attendance has

increased annually since 2015, climbing 37% in the last five years alone.

Locally, Killens Pond State Park was among six state parks that saw visitation increase by more than 10% in 2022.

The most visited state park last year was Cape Henlopen, with 1.9 million visitors -- accounting for nearly a quarter of the system total. Officials are urging anyone planning to camp or host events in a state park to make reservations as early as possible.

Delaware State Parks annual passes and surf fishing permits are on sale now and can be purchased at any state park office Monday through Friday, from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m., or online at www.destateparks.com/Know/PassesTagsFees.
