Protecting Consumers

- 1. Most electric cars require that owners take the vehicle back to a service center owned/operated by them. This in turn creates an environment on which they can charge whatever. A similar example would be Apple (iPhone's) requiring you to take your device back to them for repair so all features stay functional.
- 2. Many of these electric cars have cameras/gps/monitoring modules where users have no choice to opt out of being tracked. This data is likely being sold for profit by these car manufactures without user consent.
- 3. Some car manufacturers (Tesla/BMW) are starting to adopt a "subscription model" for things that used to come standard with a car. This should is another cost that may be passed on to consumers.
