This application shall not be considered complete and shall be returned to the applicant unless accompanied by the following documents:

1. Two Sets of Plans and Technical Specifications for the Facility(ies) to be Constructed:

The plans for the facility should indicate property lines, driveways, buildings, structures, facilities used for material storage (both above-ground and underground tanks), pipelines, valves and appurtenances, diking around storage facility (if applicable), drainage areas and paved areas. Any areas reserved for future expansion or additional storage should also be noted on the plans.

The technical specifications should outline the sizes, capacities and construction materials for tanks, pipes, appurtenances, process equipment, venting devises, etc. Information on inspection procedures for the operation and maintenance of the storage facility must also be included.

All plans and specifications submitted must bear the seal and signature of a Delaware-licensed Professional Engineer.

2. Design Report:

The Design Report should describe the design standards used for tank/storage facility construction, measures for insuring tank/storage facility integrity and character of the material used for construction.

- 3. U.S.G.S. 7.5 minute series topographic map showing location one (1) copy.
- 4. Documentation that the county or municipality having jurisdiction has first approved the activity by zoning procedures provided by law.
- 5. A check in the amount of one hundred dollars (\$100.00), made payable to the State of Delaware to cover the applicable permit application review fee.
