### 1. CCR Application Form Update

As of July 22, 2024, the Delaware Sediment and Stormwater Program has implemented a new CCR Application. Older versions of the application form will not be accepted for all statewide projects. When submitting CCR Applications, please refer to the link below under the "Construction Review" tab.

### 2. 2024 CCR Recertification

CCR recertification is for CCRs whose certification will expire at the end of 2024 and would like to continue their certification. This eight-hour course highlights any changes in the Sediment and Stormwater Program and Regulations along with newer approaches to stormwater management. The 2024 CCR recertification will consist of two four-hour online webinar sessions using a virtual platform (MS Teams), held on **Wednesday, October 2<sup>nd</sup> and Wednesday, October 9<sup>th</sup> 2024** from 8:00 AM until noon each day. Eligible individuals have been notified as of July 29th by DNREC Division of Watershed Stewardship's Sediment and Stormwater Program via email. If you know your CCR certification is expiring in 2024 and did not receive an invitation to recertify, please contact the Program with updated contact information.
