1. **Submittal Procedures for Plan Review and Approval**

Effective July 1, 2021, all initial digital submittals for plan review and approval by the DNREC Sediment & Stormwater Program should be sent to the main program email address rather than an individual staff member:

DNREC.Stormwater@delaware.gov

Once a responsible staff member has been assigned to the project additional guidance will be provided for future submissions.

2. **Contractor Training Program (Blue Card) Now Available Online and On Demand**

The Sediment and Stormwater Program has converted its Contractor Training Program to an on-line, on demand offering. Links to the training and registration information are located at <https://dnrec.alpha.delaware.gov/watershed-stewardship/sediment-stormwater/training/>

In accordance with subsection §6.2.3 of the Delaware Sediment and Stormwater Regulations, certification as Responsible Personnel is valid until the Department notifies the individual that additional training is required due to a change in course content. The regulations were revised with an effective date of February 11, 2019, and the Contractor Training Program content has been updated accordingly in addition to transitioning to the online, on demand format.

4. **UPDATE: Proposed Federal 2022 Construction General Permit**

EPA is seeking public comment on its proposed 2022 Construction General Permit (CGP) for stormwater discharges from construction activity. Once finalized, this permit will replace the 2017 CGP, which expires on February 16, 2022, and will cover stormwater discharges from construction activities in areas where EPA is the NPDES permitting authority nationwide.

Key proposed changes in the permit include new or clarified provisions related to erosion and pollution prevention controls, dewatering discharges, and permittee training. EPA will take comments on the proposal during a 60-day comment period, which was announced in the Federal Register on May 12, 2021. Additional information is available at the following web site:
