

Facilities

The facilities at the St. Jones Reserve house the Delaware National Estuarine Research Reserve offices, classroom space, research and teaching laboratories, conference rooms in the coastal training center, dormitory rooms and interpretive exhibits. It is a federally funded; state owned and operated environmental education, training and research facility.



1. **St Jones Center for Estuarine Studies** includes Reserve offices, classroom space, research and teaching laboratories, and interpretive exhibits.
2. **Dormitory Rooms** are available for overnight lodging of visiting researchers or educators.
3. **Coastal Training Center** (“The Barn”) has two conference rooms that can be combined into a larger auditorium that can accommodate up to 75 people.
4. **Maintenance Shop**
5. **St. Jones Nature Trail** is a one-mile (one way) trail featuring a boardwalk over the salt marsh.
6. **Native Plant Nursery**
7. **Parking**

A rental fee will be assessed and reinvested in the Reserve program and facilities for its use by educational, governmental, natural resource and non-profit groups. The center is not available for private parties. Reservations will be scheduled on a first-come, first-serve basis.
