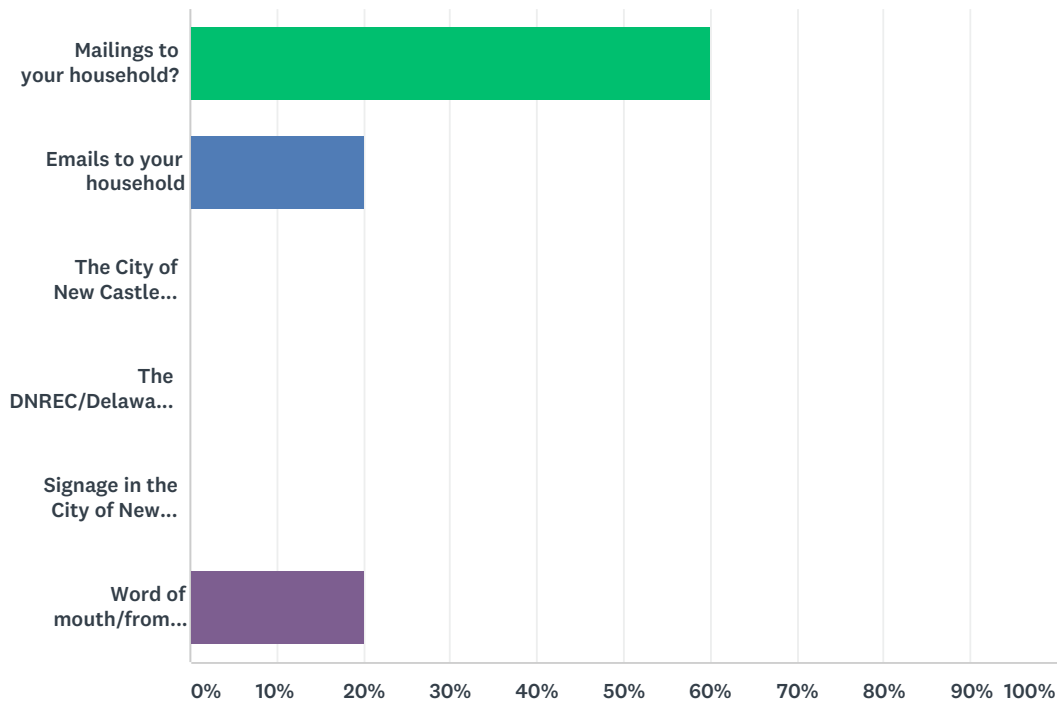

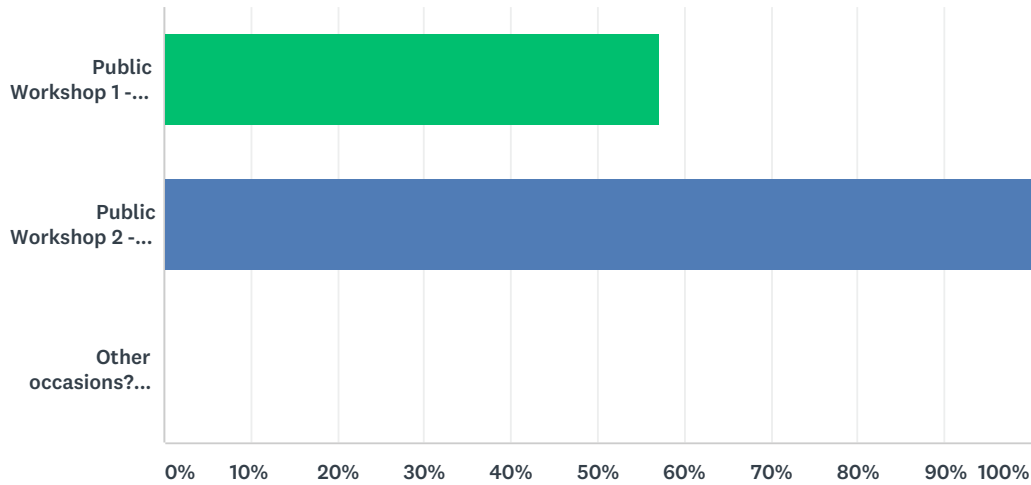

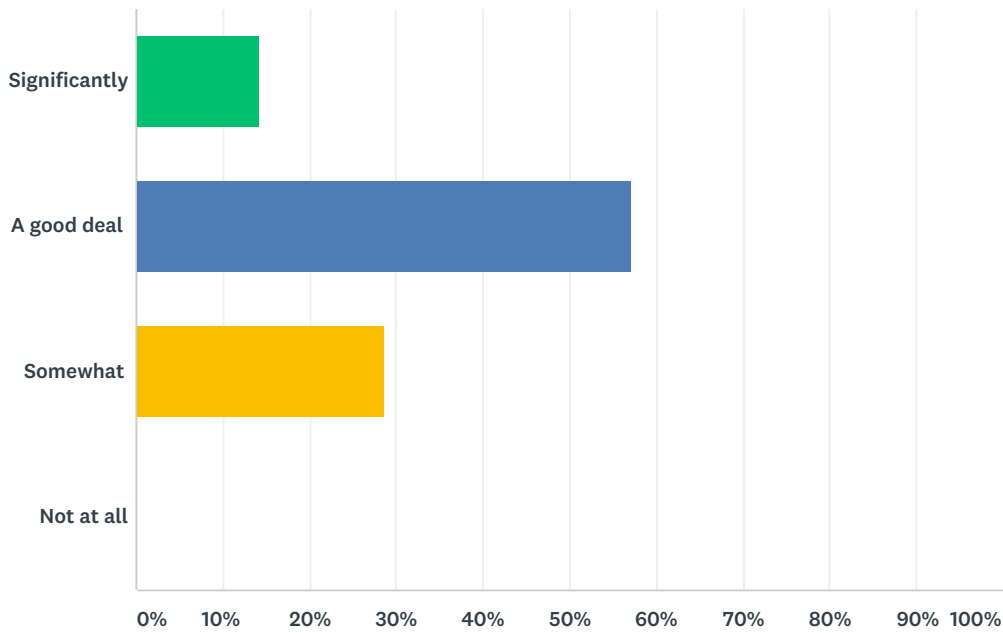

Q5 How much did your knowledge or understanding of community resiliency increase since this project began a year ago?

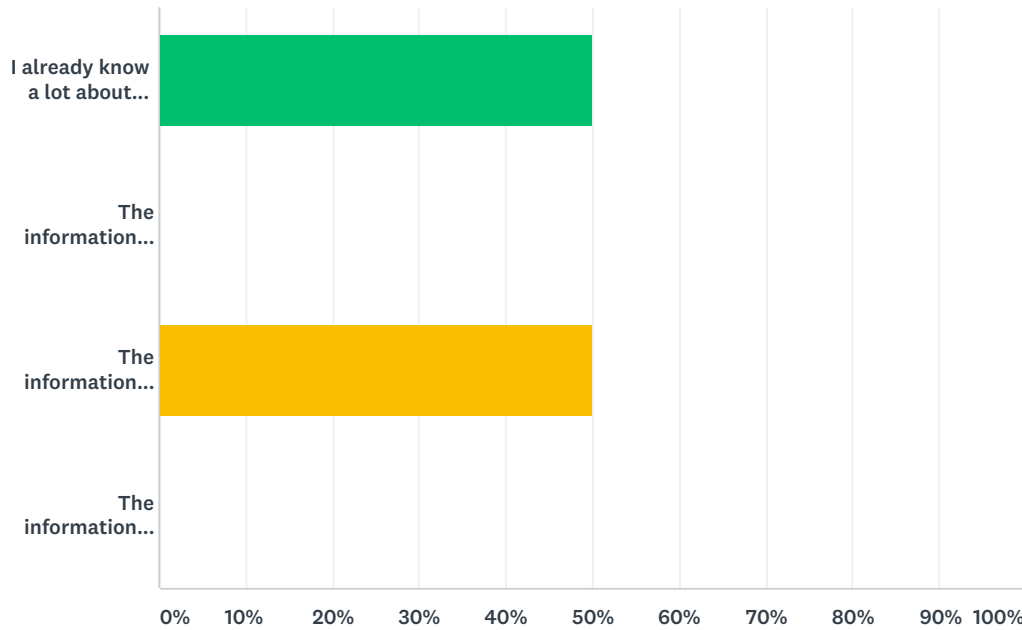

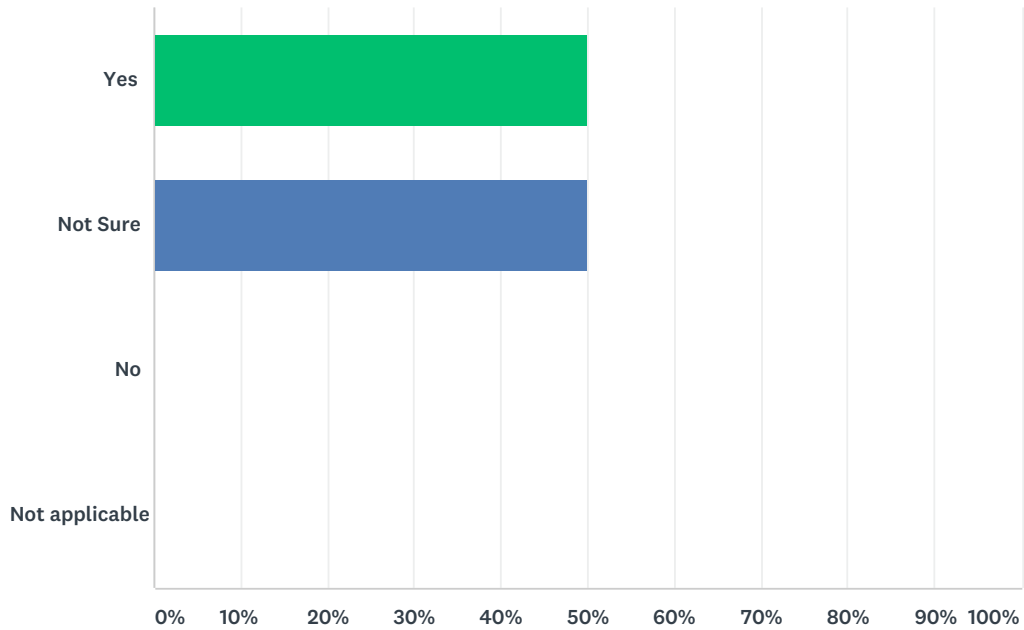

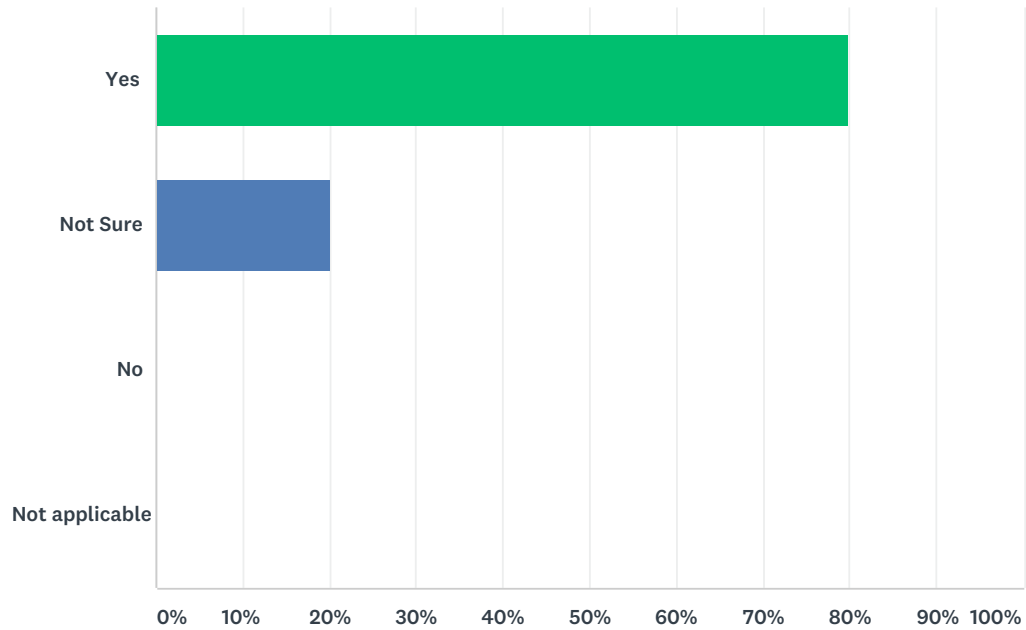

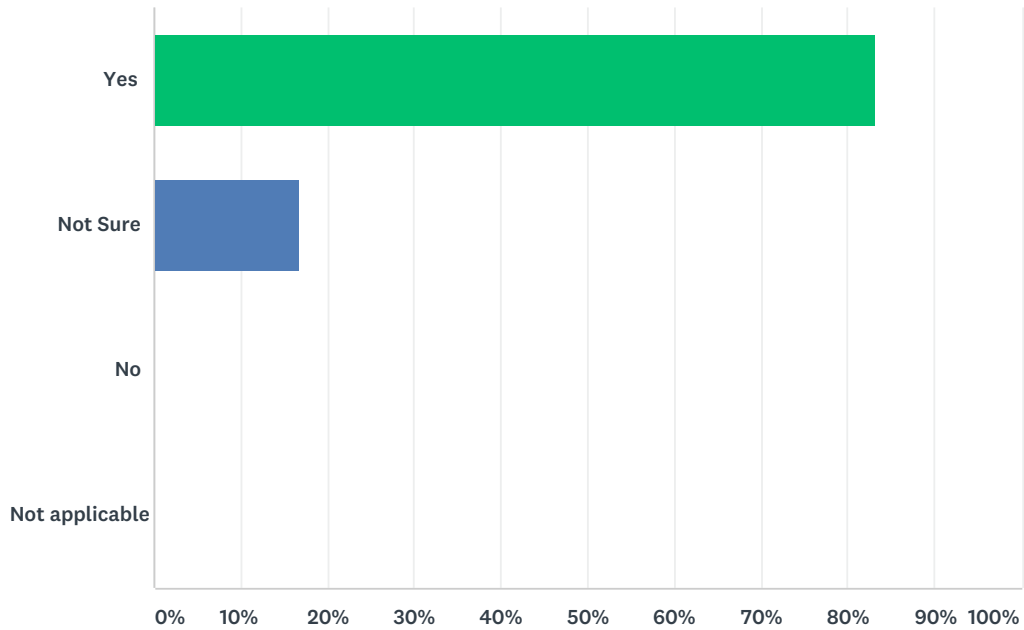

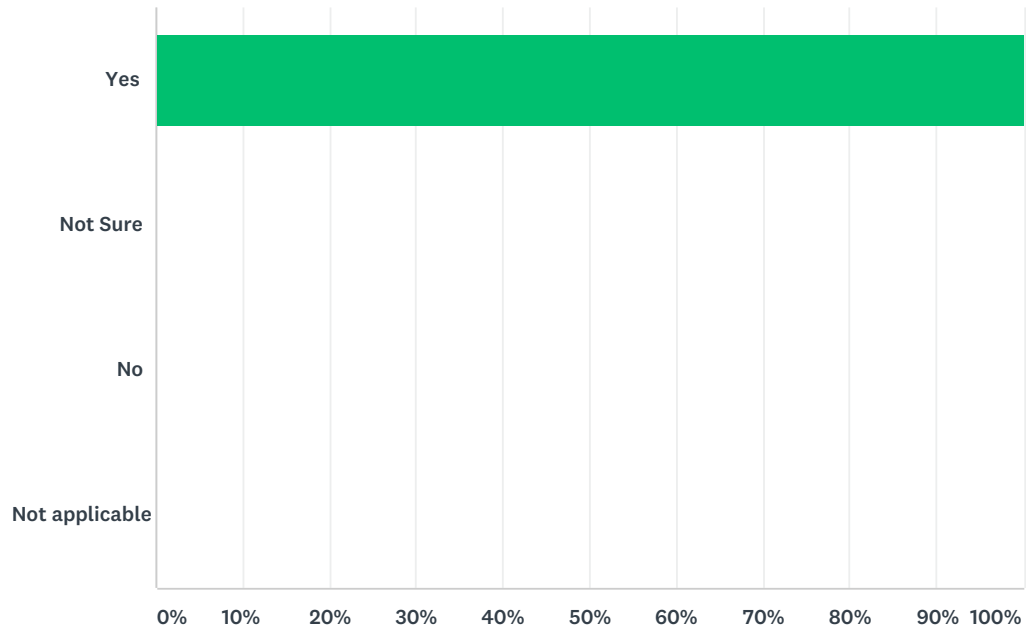

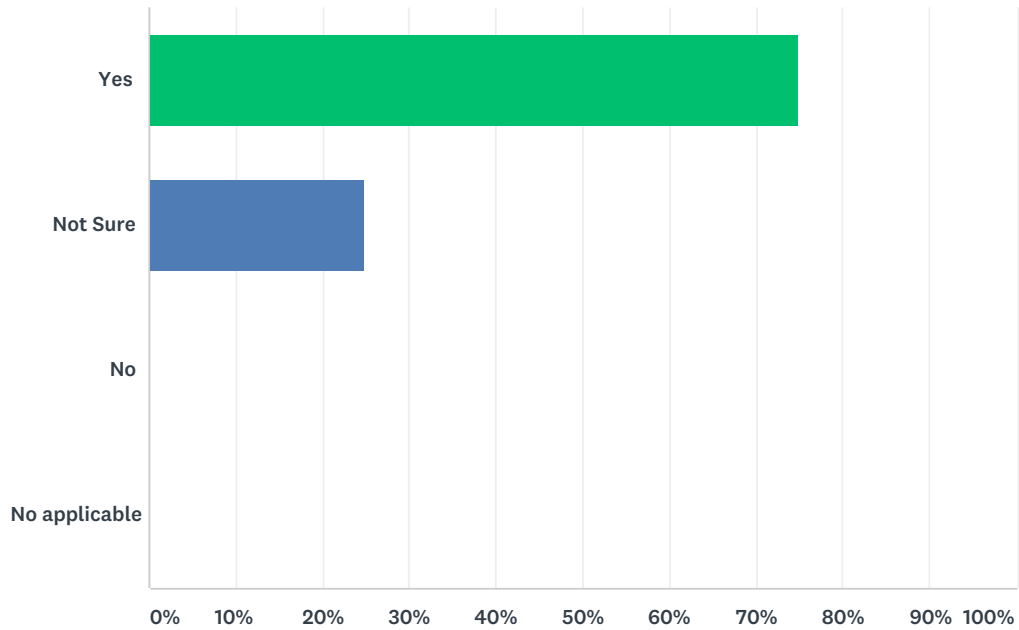

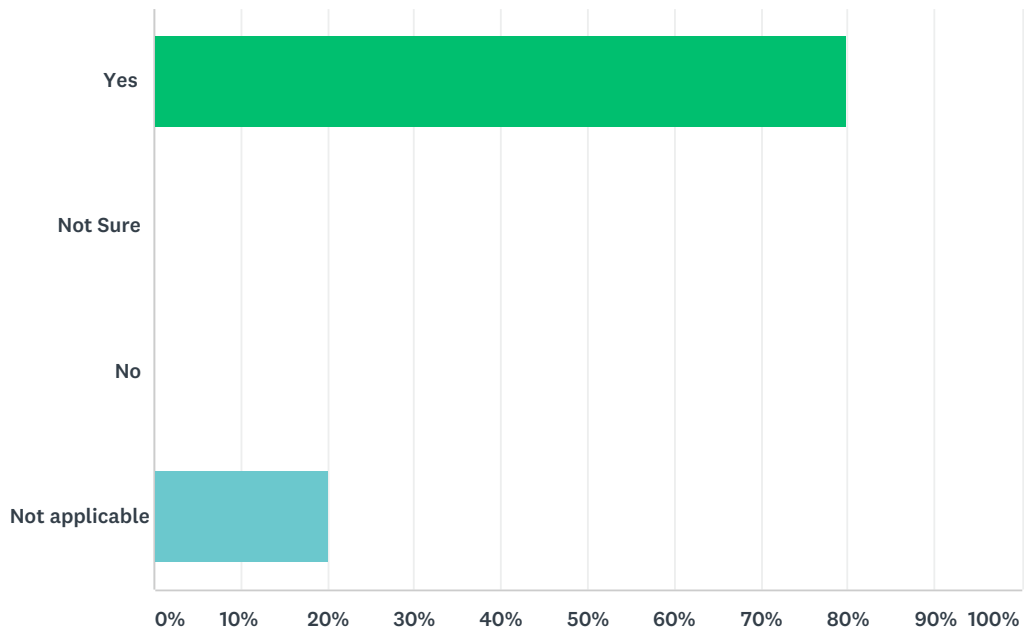

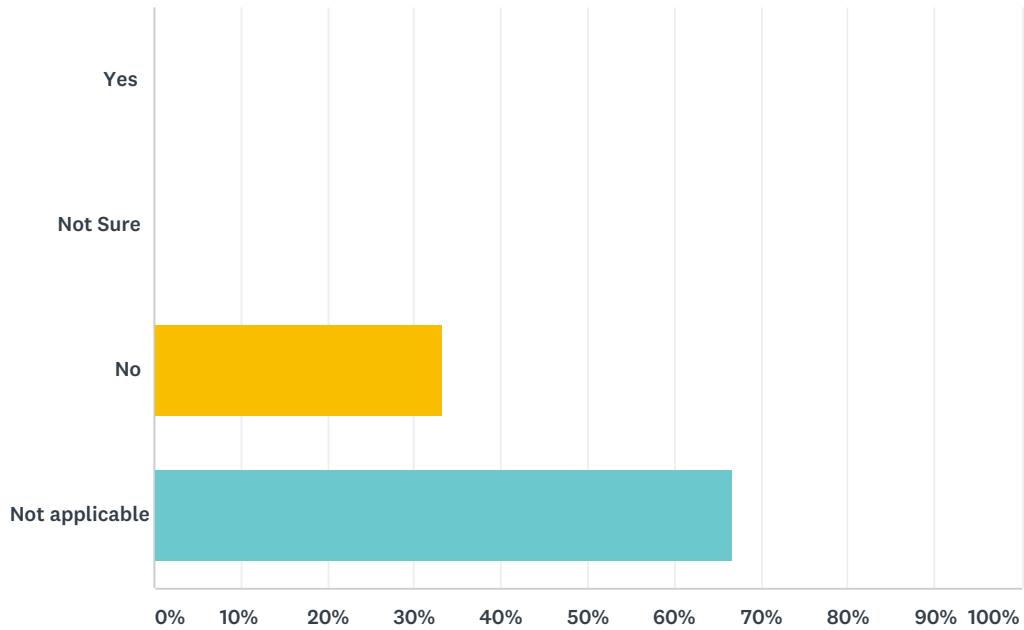

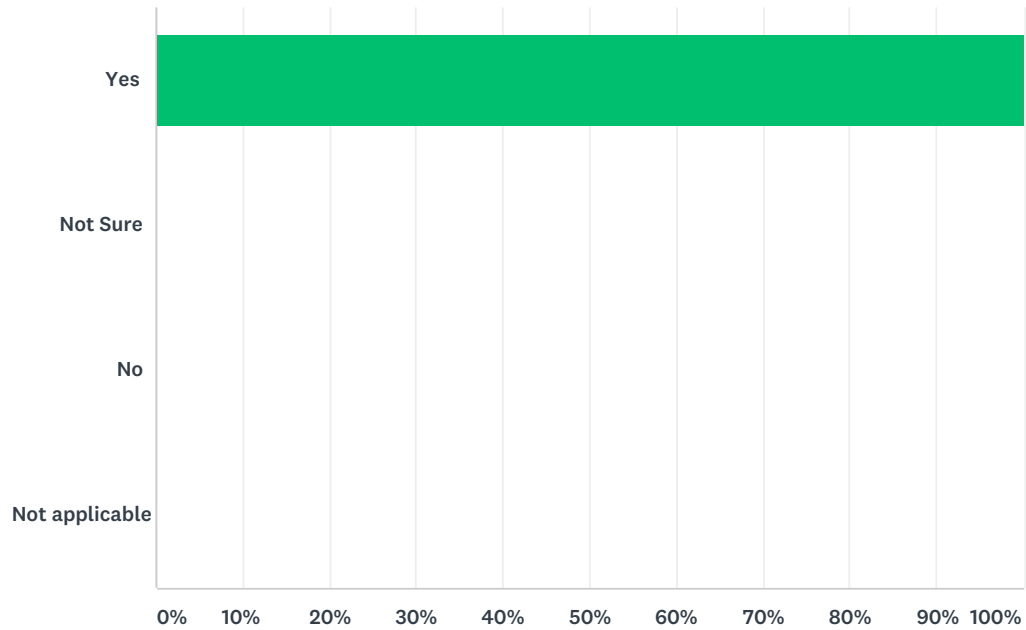

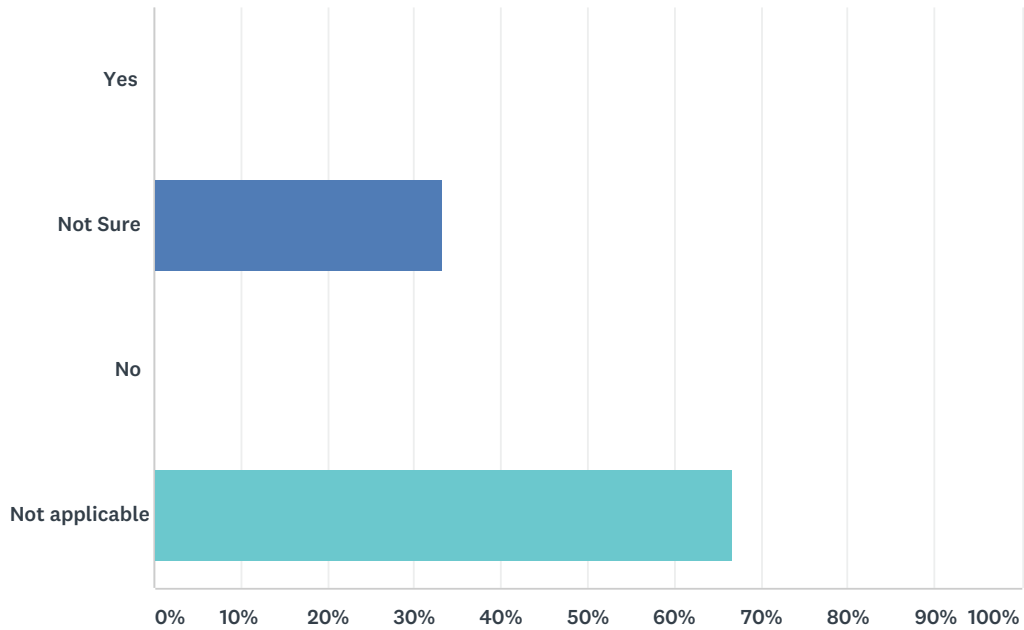

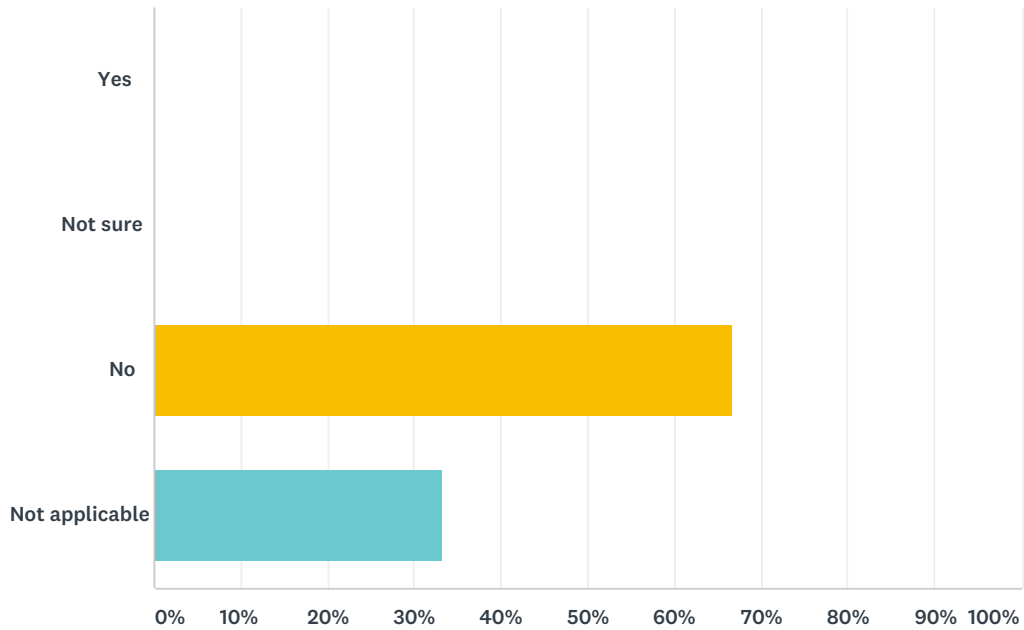

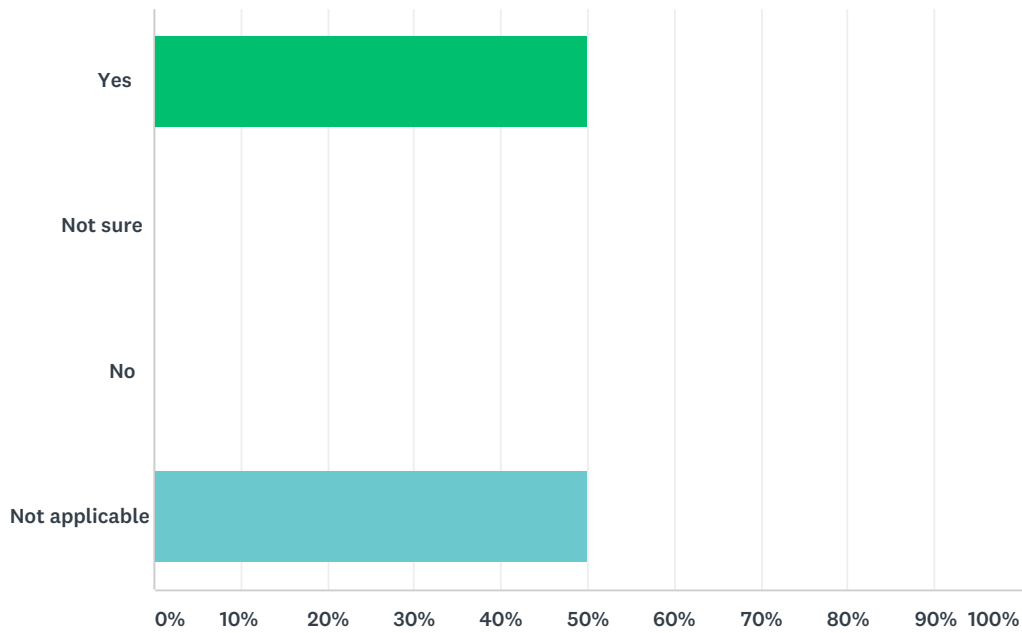
