PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

West End Neighborhood House Inc. (710 North Lincoln Street Wilmington, Delaware 19805) maintains a program for foster care of youth. The proposed activity includes acquisition of the Shawnee Inn with 15 acres of surrounding land and placement of 10 youth aging out of foster care in 10 individual rooms with a total of 11.5 bathrooms. Minor maintenance, rehabilitation and improvements shall be made to the structure as needed to accommodate the youth aging out of foster care. On July 25, 2023 William Baldwin and Edward Baldwin of Action Environmental Service Corp. (501 Silverside Road Wilmington, Delaware 19809) visited the Shawnee Inn for the purpose of conducting an Environmental Review Record. Subject site is classified commercial property. Subject site consisted of the Shawnee Inn structure, an out building (barn) containing amenities for the Inn and 15 acres of grassed lawn surrounding the Inn. An ephemeral earthen ditch is located on subject site draining stormwater flow to an off-site jurisdictional tax ditch. The tax ditch discharges to a tributary of the Nanticoke River. Interviews were conducted with Diane Eby (Shawnee Inn Manager) and her cousin T.J. Tennefoss. A family history of farm and Inn was provided by these sources.

PROJECT ACTIVITIES:

- 1. Acquisition of the Shawnee Inn and 15 acres of surrounding grounds.
- 2. Minor maintenance, rehabilitation and improvements to accommodate foster youth.
- 3. Placing youth aging out of foster care in existing 10 rooms of the Shawnee Inn.

ENVIRONMENTAL REVIEW:

In accordance with the Environmental Review Procedures of 24 CFR Part 58 Programs, the following referenced project is a 58.35 categorical exclusion, which states that the following activity is categorically excluded under NEPA, but may be subject to review under authorities listed in Sec. 58.5:

- (a)(3) Rehabilitations of buildings and improvements when the following conditions are met:
- (a)(iii) in the case of non-residential structures, including commercial, industrial, and public buildings:
- (a)(B) The activity does not involve a change in land use, such as from non-residential to residential, commercial to industrial, or from one industrial use to another.

William C. Baldwin & Edward J. Baldwin reviewed subject site for the purpose of conducting an Environmental Review Record. The following environmental issues were identified:

- Federal Law (LBPPPA) requires lead-based paint (LBP) inspection screening in housing constructed before 1978. A LBP inspection is required on any modification of existing housing where LBP is suspected. LBP is suspected present.
- Asbestos containing material (ACM) is known to exist in linoleum floor tile, plaster, insulation, roofing felt, textured coatings & caulking putty. This structure requires an asbestos inspection in accordance with NESHAP regulation (40 CFR 61 Subpart M).
- A noise assessment was deemed unnecessary. Noise levels were deemed acceptable in accordance with HUD noise assessment guidelines.
- 4. Subject site is outside of airport accident potential zone 1.9 miles +/- from Willaview Airport (Farmington, Delaware).
- 5. Research of historic Harrington structures confirmed subject site is outside the Harrington historic zone.
- AESC observed utilities to include electric, concrete sidewalk and paved street infrastructure available. Water is supplied by an onsite groundwater well. Sewage disposal is to an on-site septic system.
- An ephemeral, non-jurisdictional earthen ditch was located on-site and discharging to an off-site jurisdictional tax ditch. On-site
 wetlands and subaqueous lands were absent from regulatory mapping.
- An environmental database search, included in "Appendix A", indicates an absence of hazardous facilities and site contamination.
 Subject site is located on 15 acres of commercially identified property. Subject site has not been classified agricultural (farmland) since ca 1993.







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SG-2 Sole Source Aquifer Map



The Delaware State Historic Preservation Office has reviewed the initiation sent on August 30, 2023. Funds provided by the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD), are being applied for acquisition and rehabilitation of the Shawnee Inn, located at 1116 Shawnee Road, Sussex County, DE. As federal funds are being proposed for the undertaking, the project is therefore subject to compliance with Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act of 1960 (as amended).

A review of this site in conjunction with the submitted materials the DE SHPO has determined that this undertaking will have no direct or indirect effect on historic architectural resources eligible for listing to the National Register. Furthermore, based on the nature of the proposed work, which does not include ground disturbance, the DE SHPO has determined that there will be no direct effect to unidentified archaeological resources that could remain within the parcel. Based on the assessment of the area and the materials submitted, **The DE SHPO would concur with the determination of No Historic Properties Affected and would additional agree that no additional cultural resource survey be required.** However, if future work in the parcel will include ground disturbance, the DE SHPO would respectfully request that we be consulted further.
